RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	LOWE SCHOLLUM & JONES (1100 metres)			
SPIRITED LADY (R Myers) - Began awkwardly losing ground, then commenced to race greenly throughout.				
HARTLEY (H Tinsley)- Over-raced near the 600 metres and when improving shifted DU'BLUES wider on the track. H Tinsley reported that HARTLEY raced greenly throughout and would improve with experience.				
DU'BLUES (J Parkes) - Made the final bend awkwardly, shifting wide.				
Race 2	MERRYLEES HOTEL (1100 metres)			

CHARLIE HORSE (D Turner) -Slow away, then raced greenly. Held up for some distance rounding the turn and home straight and had to be angled wide near the 200 metres to improve.

MIGHTY MOUSE (H Andrew) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

SWISS D'MEANOUR (K Cowan) - Raced greenly rounding the turn and into the home straight and inclined to get its head in the air when being restrained. Briefly held up passing the 400 metres having to be angled off heels early in the home straight to obtain clear running.

Race 3 SCALETEC WEIGHING TECHNOLOGY (1400 metres)

SHADY LADY (M Tanaka) – Jumped outwards at the start bumping NASHEETA.

NASHEETA (R Myers) – Bumped at start.

BARE WITH (D Hirini) – Slow away.

GALAPAGOS – Slow away.

HILLBILLY (S MacNab) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

STORYLINE (L Allpress) – Ran greenly in the home straight under pressure.

Race 4 SUE LAWRENCE & DEBS PERRY (1400 metres)

GERARDSASUN (L Allpress) – Slow away. Raced ungenerously in the early stages. When questioned rider advised the gelding would improve with the run and extra ground.

BLAME DE ANGELS (M Singh) – Awkwardly away.

JUMP FOR JOY (S MacNab) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LA MONNOYE (J Parkes) – Briefly held up approaching the 400 metres.

Race 5 CENTRAL WOOL TRANSPORT (1600 metres)

KING MAX (C O'Beirne) – Slow away. Had to be restrained when running up on to the heels of GET SCHROEDER passing the 1500 metres, losing several lengths. When questioned, apprentice jockey O'Beirne advised the gelding had over-raced early. Rider C O'Beirne was advised of her obligations with regard to the use of her whip on a horse out of contention.

LOOK OUT (C-M Waddell) - Three wide without cover throughout.

DAL KILCHOAN (T Johnson) – Bumped passing the 500 metres when MAGIC IVAN improved to the inside.

MAGIC IVAN (K Cowan) – Bumped passing the 500 metres.

Race 6 MURRAY CONTRACTORS (2100 metres)

MASTER THOMAS – T Johnson replaced J Nason. Awkwardly away.

DIGNIFY (K Cowan) – Underwent a veterinary examination prior to the start and was cleared after becoming fractious in the barriers.

CARNABY (D Turner) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

NOM DU BEEL (H Tinsley) - Had to steady near the 800 metres when KINGIESSTAR (J Riddell) shifted in when not clear. J Riddell was advised to exercise greater care when in similar circumstances.

CRAFTY LADY (R Myers) - Finished some distance last. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormalities. Connections advised the mare's future would be considered.
