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## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>Fairview Motors 2000</b>
<b>MUELED</b> (L Satherley) - Began awkwardly losing ground.	
<b>TED WILLDOIT</b> (A Collett) - Raced wide throughout.	
<b>BARB DWYER</b> (T Thornton) - Inconvenienced near the 150 metres when placed in restricted room.	
<b>AONGATETE EXPRESS</b> (R Elliott) - Was inclined to lay out throughout and ran wide passing the 600 metres being eased down by its rider. Stewards advised connections that the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.	

**SLY DOG STUD** (S Spratt) - Steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 450 metres.

**DON'T LIE TO ME** (M Coleman) - When questioned regarding the performance, rider M Coleman could offer no tangible excuse.

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>Waharoa Industrial Park 1200</b>
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**DEBATABLE** (A Jones) – Slow to begin.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>Waharoa Transport Bulk &amp; Liquid 1200</b>
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**SAIGNON** (T Wenn) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**SMOOCHY** (S Weatherley) – Slow away.

**DRAGON RIO** (A Jones) – Lay out throughout.

**DOUGIE** (R Elliot) – Steadied losing ground when awkwardly placed on heels shortly after jumping away. When questioned regarding the performance Apprentice R Elliot advised Stewards that in his opinion the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

**SHE'S PRISMATIC** (T Newman) – Had to steady near the 700 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

**IMPULSIVE HABIT** (T Thornton) - Inconvenienced when FLYING MASTER (J Fawcett) shifted in approaching the 100 metres. Apprentice J Fawcett was advised to exercise greater care.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>Oilseed Products NZ Ltd 1400</b>
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**SUFFICIENT FUNDS** (A Collett) - Shifted out on jumping away forcing FONTELINA out onto heels.

**WHATA POSTAGIRL** (S Collett) - Lay out after jumping away inconveniencing DIAMOND HEIST. Placed in restricted room near the 1300 metres having to be steadied when DIAMOND HEIST (T Thornton) shifted in when not fully clear. Rider T Thornton was advised to exercise greater care.

**DIAMOND HEIST** (T Thornton) - Inconvenienced at the start. Lost a left front plate during the running.

**FONTELINA** (C Lammas) - Crowded shortly after the start then blundered losing ground.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>The Clothier Family 1400</b>
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**BRANSOME** (J Fawcett) - Steadied when in restricted room shortly after the start losing ground.

**CLASSIC WARRIOR** (J Riddell) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

**GUMBOOTS** (D Bradley) - Knuckled shortly after the start.

**LUCY LIU** (S Weatherley) - When questioned regarding the mare's performance, Apprentice S Weatherley could offer no tangible excuse.

**KEEPING TOM** (H Marzuki) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a minor laceration in both the left and right nostril.

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>ADM Feeds Ltd 1600</b>
<b>REILLY CENTRAL</b> (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding performance, rider M Cameron advised that the mare had tended to over race early and had hung out throughout, but could otherwise offer no other excuses. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow recovery rate.	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>Waharoa Transport Container Division 1600</b>
<b>WANNABE ROYALE</b> (M Cameron) – Was crowded at the start losing ground. Lost a left front plate during the running.  <b>L Satherley</b> (SUGGESTIVE HEIGHTS) - Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>RBS Racing 2000</b>
<b>MR KANTON</b> (E Smith) – Slow away. Over raced in the early and middle stages.  <b>ROGER THAT</b> (A Jones) – Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with the hind quarters of REPO SUN which became briefly unbalanced.  <b>REPO SUN</b> (M Du Plessis) - Bumped becoming unbalanced shortly after the start.  <b>MASTER POET</b> (J Fawcett) - Raced keenly in the early stages having to shift out when becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 1600 metres dictating SAKHEE’S STAR wider on the track.  <b>SAKHEE’S STAR</b> (A Collett) - Dictated over extra ground near the 1600 metres.  <b>ON PAROLE</b> (S Weatherley) – Had to be steadied when crowded to the inside of MASTER POET which was racing keenly near the 1800 metres.  <b>SPAWN OF ELAIA</b> (S Collett) - Commenced too race ungenerously near the 1600 metres shifting out.
