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## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>BOSTOCK NEW ZEALAND SPRING CARNIVAL OPENER</b>
<b>ROCK ON</b> (D Bradley) - Slow away, bumped near the 150 metres.	

**WAIT A SEC** (L Allpress) - Slow away, shifted outwards to obtain clear running near the 150 metres making contact with ROCK ON.

**ZORRALI** (S MacNab) - Raced keenly in the early stages, raced wide without cover throughout.

**NYMPH MONTE** (R Myer) - Had a tendency to over-race for a distance passing the 1400 metres

**LONGCHAMP** (R Jones) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages, when questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion the gelding may not have seen out the 1600 metres distance of today's race, also advising it had made an abnormal breathing noise on pulling up and may have got its tongue back. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed muscular tension in the left hind rump.

**AMARULA** (S McKay) - Held up early in the home straight bumping with LONGCHAMP passing the 200 metres prior to be angled outwards passing the 150 metres to obtain clear running, bumped by NYMPH MONTE just short of the finish.

**WOODSMAN** (A Jones) - Returned to the enclosure with a small amount of blood in the right nostril which upon veterinary inspection was found to be due to injury consistent with making contact with the starting gates.

Apprentice **H ANDREW** - Fined \$500 by the Judicial Committee after admitting a charge in that she used the whip excessively on her mount KING KROVANH prior to the 100 metres.

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>REDWOOD TROPHY</b>
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**ZED LEPPÉLIN** (R Jones) – Slow away, raced ungenerously in the early stages before improving forward approaching the 1400 metres to sit outside the leader near the 1200 metres.

**CARNABY** (D Turner) - Slow away, hampered having to be steadied for a distance rounding the home turn near the 500 metres.

**CHECKOUT** (M Cameron) - Made the first turn near the 1700 metres awkwardly, when questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse.

**NOM DU BEEL** (H Tinsley) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

**LOVETOKEEPHIM** (H Andrew) - Had to be steadied abruptly off the heels of the tiring ZED LEPPÉLIN near the 500 metres and in doing so went back onto CARNABY, came together with SOLESEIFEI near the 300 metres.

**SOLESEIFEI** (J Parkes) - Came together with LOVETOKEEPHIM near the 300 metres.

Apprentice **H Andrew** was spoken to regarding her whip use on her mount LOVETOKEEPHIM.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>TELPERION TROPHY</b>
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**STRADIVARIUS** (T Harris) - Jumped away awkwardly.

**BANNOCKBURN** (D Bradley) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**OUR KING SWAY** (A Jones) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of RISING SHOT (K Cowan) passing the 1000 metres. Apprentice **K Cowan** was advised to exercise greater care.

**CHACHAR** (V Colgan) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>VET SERVICES HAWKE'S BAY 1200</b>
<p><b>D Turner</b> - Fined \$200 under the minor infringement schedule after being unable to make the weight on CHARLIE HORSE being replaced by J Riddell.</p> <p><b>NEEDLEPOINT</b> (V Colgan) - Began awkwardly jumping inwards tightening CHARLIE HORSE which settled back.</p> <p><b>T HARRIS</b> - Issued with a warning after angling his mount MEDITERRANEAN STAR inwards when not fully clear of DARK PRINCESS which had to be steadied away from that runners heels shortly after the start.</p> <p><b>DARK PRINCESS</b> (L Allpress) - Hampered shortly after the start having to be steadied to avoid the heels of MEDITERRANEAN STAR.</p> <p><b>CHARLIE HORSE</b> (J Riddell) - Tightened at start and settled back, made the bend near the 850 metres awkwardly.</p> <p><b>KING COUGAR</b> (J Parkes) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>THE MITIGATOR</b> (S McKay) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>GATES TO RIO</b> (A Jones) - Became awkwardly placed inside the heels of THE MITIGATOR near the 800 metres, raced ungenerously when being steadied.</p> <p><b>GLORY DAYS</b> (R Myers) - Held up passing the 250 metres.</p> <p><b>RASPBERRY BERET</b> (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the filly had not felt comfortable in today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed low grade lameness to the left hind with co-trainer Mr A Forsman being advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness is required prior to racing next.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>EL ROCA - SIR COLIN MEADS TROPHY (Listed Race)</b>
<p><b>SUMMER MONSOON</b> (C Lammass) - Jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p><b>IRISH FLAME</b> (H Tinsley) - Slow away.</p> <p><b>SHORT FUSE</b> (R Myers) - Crowded leaving the barriers between I GOT YOU and SOPHIES CHOICE which both began awkwardly and shifted ground, wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>I GOT YOU</b> (M Cameron) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>SOPHIES CHOICE</b> (D Johnson) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>BOSTONIAN</b> (L Innes) - Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p><b>GRIFFIN</b> (M Coleman) - Over-raced middle stages.</p> <p><b>LA MIA STELLA</b> (L Allpress) - Briefly inconvenienced passing the 100 metres when GRIFFIN shifted outwards.</p> <p><b>SACRED REBEL</b> (V Colgan) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding had not felt entirely comfortable in today's track conditions and had raced greenly.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>HASTINGS - HEART OF HAWKE'S BAY 1300</b>

**TEMPLE TIGER** (J Fawcett) - Slow away before being further hampered when HOLLYWOOD LASS shifted outwards.

**FLAMINGO** (R MYERS) - Tightened and bumped at the start between FORTUNE PATCH and DANGER DEE.

**FORTUNE PATCH** (T Johnson) - Began awkwardly.

**DANGER DEE** (S McKay) - Bumped at the start.

**PROFILE** (K Cowan) - Slow away before being further hampered when JESSIEGEE was taken inwards by DEALS IN HEELS.

**M CAMERON** - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards shortly after the start when not sufficiently clear of JESSIEGEE which was hampered and forced inwards onto PROFILE which was checked losing ground. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended M Cameron's licence to ride in races from the close of racing on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September up and including Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> September (4 riding days).

**HONEY RIDER** (M Coleman) – Raced three wide without cover. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions.

**JESSIEGEE** (J Parkes) – Hampered shortly after the start, held up rounding the turn near the 400 metres and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 250 metres.

**LADY GUINNESS** (L Allpress) - Held up entering the final straight until near the 250 metres

**THATSFORSURE** (J Riddell) - Held up when disappointed for a run near the 250 metres.

**HOLLYWOOD LASS** (L Innes) - When questioned into performance rider reported the mare had not felt entirely comfortable in today's track conditions and was making abnormal respiratory noises. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>TARZINO TROPHY (Group 1)</b>
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**KAWI** (J Waddell) - Slow away, bumped 400 metres.

**UNDERTHEMOONLIGHT** (C Lammas) - Steadied to avoid heels when racing keenly going into bend near the 850 metres.

**RANGIPO** (V Colgan) - Raced wide without cover, near the 450 metres commenced to weaken going back onto VOLPE VELOCE which when becoming awkwardly placed on that runners heels shifted inwards making contact with KAWI which was bumped inwards hampering SOFIA ROSA which was hanging outwards away from the running rail.

**SOFIA ROSA** (T Harris) - Hung outwards rounding bend being checked near the 400 metres to avoid the heels of KAWI, continued to hang outwards under pressure in the home straight.

**EL PESCARDO** (L Allpress) - Raced wide throughout.

**PACKING EAGLE** (T Thornton) - Raced wide throughout.

**C Lammas** - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount UNDERTHEMOONLIGHT to shift outwards near the 350 metres when not sufficiently clear of AUTHENTIC PADDY which was hampered and forced outwards into the line of GINGERNUTS which was checked with AUTHENTIC PADDY clipping a heel of

**UNDERTHEMOONLIGHT.** After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended C Lammas's licence to ride in races from the close of racing on Saturday September 2<sup>nd</sup> up to and including Friday September 22<sup>nd</sup> (10 riding days).

**AUTHENTIC PADDY** (L Innes) – Hampered when crowded passing the 400 metres clipping a heel and blundering.

**GINGERNUTS** (O Bosson) - Checked when crowded passing 400 metres becoming badly unbalanced.

**VOLPE VELOCE** (J Parkes) – Steadied to avoid heels 400 metres shifting inwards making contact with KAWI, lay inwards under pressure having to be straightened passing the 100 metres inconveniencing THE AULD FLOOZIE.

**THE AULD FLOOZIE** (D Johnson) - Inconvenienced passing the 100 metres.

**PERFECT FIT** (M Coleman) – Co-trainer Mr K Kelso advised that the mare had pulled up well after its disappointing performance and would now be retired to stud.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>SWISS ACE TROPHY</b>
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**SWINGING SKIRTS** (M Du Plessis) - Slow away.

**OPHELIA LEE** (S McKay) - Slow away.

**HIGHLAD** (M Cameron) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

**ALMO STREET** (J Riddell) - Steadied off heels passing the 1500 metres

**ITSAGEM** (H Andrew) - Three wide without cover throughout.

**STEPHENSTIHLS** (J Parkes) - Over-raced when being restrained for a distance passing the 1300 metres.

**DE GAULLE** (L Allpress) - Not persevered with in the final straight, rider advising the gelding had been quickly beaten once placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality

**M Cameron** - Issued with a warning regarding his use of the whip on his mount HIGHLAD prior to the 100 metres.

<b>Race 9</b>	<b>RELIABLE MAN TROPHY</b>
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**DECADES** (J Waddell) - Slow away, before being further hampered by BARNABY which began awkwardly and was taken out by SIOUX which had also begun awkwardly.

**BARNABY** (M Coleman) - Began awkwardly, had a tendency to lay in under pressure in the final straight.

**SIOUX** (M Singh) - Began awkwardly, hampered passing the 1200 metres, lay out making contact with ROYAL RUBY near the 200 metres.

**KAMIKAZE REBEL** (C Lammas) - Steadied passing the 1200 metres when crowded for room as a result of DOUBLE DOWN (D Bradley) shifting inwards when not fully clear of SIOUX which forced RURAL RUBY inwards onto RU'MAR which in turn forced ALVINS DREAM into the line of KAMIKAZE REBEL. **D Bradley** was issued with a warning. In coming to this decision Stewards took into account that SIOUX had improved quickly to the inside of DOUBLE DOWN contributing to the incident. Apprentice M Singh was spoken to advisedly in the presence of the national riding master. Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres.

**ROYAL RUBY** (C Johnson) - Forced inwards passing 1200 metres, bumped near the 200 metres.

**RU'MAR** (J Riddell) - Forced inwards passing 1200 metres.

**ALVINS DREAM** (T Harris) - Forced inwards passing 1200 metres.

**FRUITION** (D Hirini) - Raced wide without cover.

**LEADING ROLE** (S MacNab) – Raced in restricted room having to be steadied near the 1100 metres, held up for a distance near the 300 metres.
