## **RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1 VESPA STANDING AT WELLFIELD LODGE 2YO JUVENILE PLATE 790m

**MAKABAR** (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly and raced greenly in the home straight making contact with the rail passing 350 metres.

Due to there being a malfunction in the equipment no time was taken.

Race 2 WANGANUI CHRONICLE 2040m

**GO TO MAN (S McKay)** – Dropped its head as the start was activated and was slow away. Had to be angled outwards across heels to obtain clear running in the home straight.

**ITSALLBELT (H Andrew)** - raced keenly in the middle stages

**CARNABY (M Tanaka)** - Raced wide without cover from the 800 metres. Dictated wider on the track when **DOUBLE O SEVEN** improved on the inside passing the 600 metres. When questioned M Tanaka advised that despite improving wide rounding the home turn he had no real excuse.

NITRO TED (T Johnson) – held up passing the 600 metres

**ASH PALACE (D Bradley)** - held up passing the 600 metres

HAMILTONIAN (L Allpress) - held up early in the home straight

LADY ECHEZEAUX (A Jones) - tightened passing the 200 metres when weakening

**S McKay (GO TO MAN)** admitted a breach of Rule 638 (3) (b) (ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres and was fined the sum of \$500.

Race 3 TAKE IT EASY TOURS 1200m

**POPCORN (A Chan)** – Began awkwardly dictating **JUSTA SMALL RANSOM** outwards contacting **THATZ LOUIE**, then recovered quickly to lead.

**JUSTA SMALL RANSOM (L Allpress)** – Lay inwards in the home straight under pressure having to be restrained approaching the 100 metres. L Allpress reported the mare hung throughout and may have got its tongue over the bit.

**THATZ LOUIE (C Waddell)** - raced keenly in the middle stages having to be steadied off heels passing the 700 metres

RAWINIA (M Singh) - raced in restricted room near the finish when THATZ LOUIE shifted in under pressure

Race 4 CORO ANGEL SYNDICATE OPN 1200m

SIR KINGWOOD (S Collett) - raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages

**BROTHER ONE (A Chan)** – slow away

SCAPOLO (S MacNab) - had to be restrained when running up on to the heels of ENDURE passing the 800 metres

**T Johnson (HEAVENS KEEP)** was given a warning under Rule 638 (3) (b) (ii) regarding his use of the whip prior to the 100 metres

Race 5 THE O'LEARYS FILLIES STAKES 1200m

**VEUVE CLICQUOT (S McKay)** - raced three-wide without cover throughout

**NUCLEAR FUSION (L Allpress)** – Slow away. When questioned L Allpress was of the opinion the filly was unsuited to the heavy going. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

**DIJON BLEU (J Riddell)** – Tightened passing the 1,100 metres when **VEUVE CLICQUOT** lay in dictating **SAINTED PEARL** inwards. DIJON BLEU then raced keenly. Held up for a short distance passing the 800 metres. Held up again approaching the 400 metres.

BLANCO BELLE (S MacNab) - made the bend awkwardly passing the 800 metres

**STYLE BY DESIGN (R Elliot)** - Restrained when racing in restricted room passing the 800 metres when **VEUVE CLICQUOT** lay inwards dictating **SAINTED PEARL** inward.

Race 6 STEELFORM ROOFING GROUP FOXTON CUP 2040m

**PENCURI (H Andrew)** – Made contact with the front of its stall prior to the start when unsettled in the barrier.

DR WATSON (A Chan) - reared at the start losing ground and was then ridden forward

**ZARTAN (S Collett)** - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages being allowed to roll forward to sit outside the leader approaching the 1,200 metres.

**ZENTANGLE (S MacNab)** - raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained

**OUR BANDIT (L Allpress)** – tightened approaching the 1,200 metres when **DR WATSON** lay in and again passing the 800 metres

**JOCHEN RINDT (J Parkes)** – When questioned Rider J Parkes was of the opinion the gelding was unsuited to the Heavy 10 going. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

#### Race 7 HS DYKE WANGANUI GUINEAS 1340m

VINCENT (D Turner) – awkwardly away

**OZIL (R Myers)** – slow away

**ALLURE (S Collett)** - had to be briefly restrained passing the 700 metres

**KIRKLAND (L Allpress)** – momentarily hampered having to be angled off the heels of **SOCIALLY EXCITED** to obtain clear running passing the 250 metres

#### Race 8 DAVE HOSKIN CARRIERS 1600m

**THE GREAT GURU (M Tanaka)** – Slow away. Held up early in the home straight having to be angled across heels to gain clear running approaching the 150 metres.

CHELA CHOI (D Hirini) - raced three-wide without cover throughout

**SEA PRINCESS (L Allpress)** – Finished last and when questioned Rider L Allpress could offer no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.
