Race 1	TEAM WEALLEANS HDL
<p>BROK BAK (C Studd) - Was slow away then jumped the first fence awkwardly with the rider losing the use of his left stirrup iron briefly with the saddle shifting sideways. BROK BAK then run wide and was pulled up prior to jumping the second fence.</p> <p>LETMEBY (D Turner) - Put in a poor jump at the second fence and jumped indifferently for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>CLAPATHUNDA (I Lupton) - Misjudged the third fence, poor jump final fence.</p> <p>GAME PERCY (M Cropp) – Hit the fence approaching the 1000 metres and blundered, poor jump final fence.</p> <p>EDDIE GILBERT (S MacNab) – Jumped indifferently throughout.</p> <p>DALRIADA (H McNeill) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences.</p> <p>MEXICAN (M Roustoby) – Knuckled on landing after jumping the final fence dislodging its rider who was uninjured.</p>	
Race 2	SWEENEY TOWNSEND INSURANCE BROKERS ROTORUA & BOP HUNT CUP
<p>PUKEAKE SAM (M Cropp) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>BIG BROWNIE (S Karnicnik) – Shied at the wing prior to jumping the second fence. Hit the fifth fence. Misjudged the fence near the 1700 metres losing momentum.</p> <p>ALL ZEDIN DONE (D Turner) – Misjudged the fourth fence.</p> <p>KOKANAE GOLD (C Studd) – Hit the fence near the 950 metres. Was retired from the race prior to the second to last fence when well beaten.</p> <p>BAD BOY BROWN (I Lupton) – Retired from the race prior to the fence near the 1800 metres as the saddle had shifted forward badly.</p> <p>NGARIO (S MacNab) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to be lame in the left foreleg with a suspected tendon rupture. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance will be required prior to racing next.</p>	
Race 3	T.W. MOORE LTD HWT
<p>BLAZING OPAL (I Lupton) – Raced keenly in the early stages before being allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader passing the 1200 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormality.</p> <p>JUST GOT HOME (M Roustoby) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.</p>	
Race 4	TERRY FITZPATRICK MAIDEN SPRINT
<p>BUFFALO BUCK (S McKay) -Jumped in the air at the start and was slow away (4L)</p> <p>HAPPINESS IS (R Norvall) – Slow away (4L). Inconvenienced near the 150 metres when SUFFICIENT FUNDS shifted out under pressure.</p> <p>SUFFICIENT FUNDS (A Collett) – Shifted away from OTTAVIO (T Thornton) which was shifting outwards then having to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of MATHIEU near the 1100 metres. T Thornton was advised to exercise care.</p>	

NATURAL ATHLETIC (A Jones) – lost the left hind plate during the running.

Race 5

ROTORUA DISTRICT RIDING FOR THE DISABLED 1950 FLAIR AMATEUR RIDERS SERIES

LONELY BOY (G Duncan) – Jumped away awkwardly getting its head up, then blundering, making contact with ASCOMANNI, almost dislodging its rider who lost the use of a stirrup iron for a distance.

ASCOMANNI (M Northcott) – Bumped start.

MANDALAY (K Asano) - Slow away. K Asano was issued with a warning for his whip action with his arm coming above his shoulder.

CARDON BOY (S Wenn) – Lay out after leaving the barriers crowding ROYAL SCEPTRE on to PESO and IN A MINUTE which made contact with NOAH JON. Crowded when weakening inside the 100 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of MANDALAY which was forced inwards by IN A MINUTE (L Calitz). L Calitz was advised to exercise greater care.

ROYAL SCEPTRE (J McIlroy) – Crowded shortly after the start.

PESO (G Crowe) – Crowded shortly after the start.

IN A MINUTE (L Calitz) – Crowded shortly after the start.

NOAH JON (H Fleming) – Bumped shortly after the start becoming unbalanced.

J McIlroy (ROYAL SCEPTRE) – Admitted a charge in that she used her whip unnecessarily in the final straight when her mount was out of contention and was suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing today, Sunday 17 September until the conclusion of racing on Sunday 1 October 2017 (1 riding day).

Race 6

FARMLANDS CO-OPERATIVE 1400

NIGHT CAPTAIN (S Weatherley) – Reared at the start losing considerable ground. A warning was placed on the mare's barrier manners. Was eased down over the concluding stages. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils which upon veterinary examination was found to be from external trauma.

DIAMOND HEIST (T Thornton) – Slow to begin.

ALL OF THE LIGHTS (J Nason) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

R Elliot (SHANANA) – Warned for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

Race 7

K M STABLES 1230

DON'T BE CHEEKY (R Elliot) – Shifted inwards to avoid the heels of ST REGIS near the 400 metres then having to be steadied near the 350 metres when IMPULSIVE HABIT (T Thornton) shifted outwards. T Thornton was issued with a warning.

SMOOCHY (J Nason) – Slow to begin

ST REGIS (A Jones) - crowded to the outside of IMPULSIVE HABIT when that runner shifted away from TICKET TO RIDE rounding the final turn near the 300 metres after initially being dictated outwards marginally when improving to the outside of that runner. SMOOCHY which was racing to the outside of ST REGIS then shifted outwards to relieve

pressure from ST REGIS hampering LADY SHABEEL which was forced outwards crowding ENJOY THE RIDE. Both Apprentice J Fawcett and T Thornton were advised to exercise greater care.

LADY SHABEEL (H Marzuki) – Hampered 300 metres having to be steadied.

ENJOY THE RIDE (S MacNab) – Crowded 300 metres having to be restrained.

Race 8

CHELTENHAM & DUBAI WITH T. LEE AND A.R.A 1950

BARB DWYER (T Thornton) - Jumped away awkwardly. Rider T Thornton was issued with a warning for her use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

LYCABEE (S MacNab) – When questioned regarding performance Apprentice S MacNab could not offer any excuses. A post-race veterinary examination showed the gelding to have an elevated heart rate.
