RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	CARTERS TAUPO 1800
FUSION (D Hirini) - Began awkwardly losing ground.	

GALAPAGOS (A Collett) - Slow to begin.

FORT KNOX (S McKay) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained rounding the first turn.

RAY'S LEGACY (M McNab) - Had to be firmly restrained after becoming awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 1000 metres.

BATTLE ROYAL (A Jones) - Raced wide throughout.

LA ACHIEVER (R Elliot) - Held up entering the final straight and was unable to obtain clear running until shifting outwards across heels near the 150 metres.

SHACKELTONS EDGE (J Riddell) - Hampered having to be steadied to avoid the heels of AONGATETE EXPRESS (B Morgenrood) which shifted outwards near the 150 metres. When being steadied SHACKLETONS EDGE shifted outwards making contact with FOUR DAY HIGH with FOUR DAY HIGH being further hampered when crowded to the inside of GALAPAGOS (A Collett) which shifted inwards before being straightened. Both **B Morgenrood** and **A Collett** were issued with warnings.

FOUR DAY HIGH (S Weatherley) - Hampered when crowded 150 metres.

Race 2 PETER THOMAS TRANSPORT 1200

HANGER (L Innes) - Bumped leaving the barriers when PIERIAN SPRING began awkwardly and shifted outwards with HANGER blundering then ducking outwards abruptly badly unbalancing its rider who was dislodged. L Innes was uninjured.

PIERIAN SPRING (M Cameron) - Jumped away awkwardly, made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

TOKOROA (L Satherley) - Slow to begin.

QUITOO (S Collett) - Slow to begin.

GRAND DUKE (T Harris) - Commenced to over-race in the early stages continuing to do so for a distance.

A Jones - Spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 3 DPA CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 1300

Trainers **N** Hanley and **K** Whiting were issued with a warning after presenting EL SASKLYA with pacifiers which had not been notified.

EL SASKYLA - Declared a late scratching at 1.20pm with rider L Satherley having concerns over the mares behaviour during the preliminary, connections being advised that the mare is now required to trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing again.

GUGGENHEIM (T Thornton) - Over-raced raced for a distance when being steadied in the early stages.

Race 4 FARMLANDS TAUPO HANDICAP 1300

MAGIC CHAI (L Innes) - Slow to begin.

NAUGHTY KNUCKLES (H Marzuki) - Slow to begin.

SASANOF'S HERO (T Abel) - Crowded shortly after leaving the barriers having to be steadied.

LUCKY EDIE (R Elliot) - Jumped away awkwardly.

VANILLA MOON (M Coleman) - Raced wide throughout.

Race 5 ANNIE HIGGINS 1300

AOTEAROWER (T Harris) - Slow to begin, bumped near the 300 metres when BEAUTY'S ROSE (S Weatherley) shifted outwards when attempting to obtain clear running. S Weatherley was advised to exercise greater care. Again bumped early in the final straight when BEAUTY'S ROSE shifted outwards to obtain clear running approaching the 250 metres, steadied when placed in restricted room near the 50 metres, when questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuses.

ANIMATOR (J Riddell) - Had to be steadied when over-racing after becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of MCCULLUM going into the bend near the 800 metres.

ARCHDUCHESS (D Johnson) - Briefly held up passing the 250 metres.

R Elliot - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 6 NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY 1300

ORANGE SHORE (S McKay) - Slow away.

LADDIE OF OAKVIEW (H Marzuki) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

M Coleman - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 7 TAUPO VETERINARY CENTRE 1000

SHOW BIRD (L Satherley) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground, raced ungenerously middle stages when being inclined to over-race.

R Elliot - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount CULZEAN to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of RETORT which was checked passing the 900 metres resulting in SANTA MONICA and MISS BUMBLEBEE also being checked. After hearing submissions R Elliot's licence to ride in races was suspended from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 27 September until the conclusion of racing on Saturday 7 October, 6 riding days.

RETORT (S Weatherley) - Checked passing 900 metres losing ground.

SANTA MONICA (A Collett) - Checked passing 900 metres losing ground.

MISS BUMBLEBEE (M Du Plessis) - Checked passing 900 metres losing ground, had to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 700 metres.

RICKY BAKER (J Fawcett) - Lay outwards under pressure in the final straight shifting outwards abruptly near the 150 metres hampering CULZEAN. Apprentice J Fawcett was issued with a warning and advised that she is expected to make a greater attempt to keep her mount straight.

CULZEAN (R Elliot) - Hampered 150 metres.

Race 8 TAUPO HIRE 1000

REPLICA (M Cameron) - Slow to begin, raced greenly in the early and middle stages.

OUREINSTEIN (T Thornton) - Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground.

BEVAN STREET (D Johnson) - Commenced to over-race when being restrained shortly after the start continuing to do so through the middle stages.

INCASEITEL (L Satherley) - Raced three wide without cover and was inclined to hang outwards.

I SEE DIAMONDS (T Wenn) - Bumped rounding the turn passing the 400 metres when AMAZING BANKER shifted outwards.

Race 9 MIRAKA 'First at the farm gate' 1800

PALACIO (R Elliot) - Slow to begin.

ROSSO CORSA (D Johnson) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages shifting outwards to avoid heels approaching the 1100 metres making contact with the hindquarters of DELUXE EDITION, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding which was resuming from a spell today had come to the end of its run early in the final straight after racing too keenly.
