DEE AND GEE (T Jonker) – Raced keenly into the first bend and had to be steadied. Continued to race keenly through the middle stages. Raced wide from the 800 metres.

HE AIN'T HEAVY (L Callaway) – Crowded near the 1500 metres.

MASTER KARSTEN (S Wahab) – Slow to begin. Hampered momentarily near the 1500 metres. Lay in passing the 200 metres and had to be straightened.

BLACK LIZZIE (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide through the early stages.

JUMEIRAH (C Johnson) – Crowded shortly after the start and lost ground when KOTOTAMA which began awkwardly, shifted out dictating PAYMENT PENDING outwards on to JUMIERAH. Made the bend by the 1500 metres awkwardly, shifting out and crowding HE AIN'T HEAVY who was obliged to shift outwards. This resulted in MASTER KARSTEN being hampered momentarily. Raced keenly for some distance passing the 1200 metres and continued to race keenly through the middle stages. Held up passing the 150 metres and could not be ridden to full advantage.

SHARP ELLE (T Moseley) – When spoken to regarding the performance rider T Moseley could offer no tangible explanation.

KOTOTAMA (H Bennet) – Began awkwardly.

ROCK SOLID (K Mudhoo) – Shifted outwards over the concluding stages. When spoken to regarding the improved performance trainer J Gordon advised the mare had been tying up in its recent racing and had been treated for this issue, which had led to the improved performance today.

BELLE BOY (S Olney) – Crowded at the start losing ground when MYSTIC POWER shifted outwards and when being further restrained lost another twenty lengths. Attempted to improve wide from the 500 metres. Stewards spoke with Apprentice S Olney and her employer Mr K Tyler regarding her ride and after viewing replays and taking into account Miss Olney's explanation, a charge of breaching Rule 638(1)(e) in that she rode incompetently, was issued and admitted. After viewing replays and hearing submissions on penalty the JCA imposed a suspension of Miss Olney's riding licence from the 30th September up to and including the 1st November (4½ weeks). Miss Olney will also be referred to the NZTR Jockey Mentor.

MYSTIC POWER (K Williams) – Raced greenly and lay inwards in the final straight.

DOPPELGANGER (L Callaway) – Bumped with COURTE ZARINDI at the start.

OPIO ROSE (T Moseley) – Crowded passing the 175 metres when BOW DOWN lay out despite the efforts of its rider.

NIGHT LADY (S Wynne) – Over-raced in the early stages.

BOW DOWN (R Bishop) – Raced wide in the early stages. Lay out throughout the run home and had to be straightened passing the 150 metres. Trainer advised gear changes to be considered prior to racing next.

COURTE ZARINDI (T Comignaghi) – Shifted in at the start and bumped with DOPPELGANGER. Held up rounding the final turn and early in the run home, only gaining clear racing room inside the final 125 metres.

LET HER RIP RILEY (R Firdhaus) – Lay out passing the 200 metres and had to be straightened.

THE LUSTRE (C Barnes) – Raced wide throughout. Rider C Barnes reported that the filly had been trapped wide throughout and had raced greenly throughout as well. Miss Barnes added that in her opinion the filly may appreciate a step up in distance, however would derive natural benefit from today's outing.

Following the running of this event rider R Bishop reported to the Stewards he was feeling unwell and after being examined by the on-course Paramedics was found to be suffering the effects of dehydration and stood down for the remainder of the day. Mr Bishop was replaced for his remaining engagements as in the Summary above and was advised a medical clearance would be required prior to him riding next.

VINO TINTO (T Comignaghi) – Blundered at the start losing ground then when recovering shifted out abruptly. Over-raced through the middle stages.

IT'S PANDEMONIUM (S Wynne) – When spoken to regarding the performance rider S Wynne advised in her opinion the mare had only battled today and would appreciate further distance.

ALWAYS ON CALL (S Wahab) – Shifted out abruptly at the start hampering MINNIE PINS.

GOLDEN TUI (A Bohorun) – Slow to begin and had to be restrained shortly after the start when VINO TINTO shifted out abruptly. Obligated to improve very wide rounding the final bend.

MISSING HAZARD (A Sharpe) – Raced wide throughout.

MINNIE PINS (L Callaway) – Bounded at the start and was further hampered losing ground when ALWAYS ON CALL shifted out abruptly. Crowded and buffeted, losing momentum passing the 900 metres by THE SPARKLE which was racing erratically and shifted in.

THE SPARKLE (C Johnson) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced fiercely through the early stages and shifted in abruptly crowding an inside runner despite the efforts of its rider passing the 900 metres. The connections were advised the filly was on a racing manners warning. Held up for several strides passing the 400 metres. Lay outwards throughout the final straight and had to be straightened.

KRUGER RAND (T Moseley) – Held up for several strides passing the 175 metres when WHACKOMACO which was laying in, shifted in.

BAKELA (C Johnson) – Held up for several strides passing the 200 metres.

SQUIZZY (J Morris) – Bounded at the start and was very slow into stride. Tailed the field throughout despite the efforts of rider J Morris who reported the gelding had raced greenly throughout and in her opinion would appreciate a step up in distance.

PINZANO (S Wahab) – Raced wide throughout. Reported by trainer to have lost its right front racing plate during the running.

WAIMATE BILL (A Bohorun) – Lay inwards and had to be straightened passing the 200 metres, momentarily crowding KNUTQUACKER.

KNUTQUACKER (S Wynne) – Held up early in the run home. Momentarily crowded passing the 200 metres.

WHACKOMACO (K Williams) – Raced wide for the majority of the event. Lay in passing the 175 metres.

DOUBLE CHOICE (T Comignaghi) – Placed in restricted room and had to steady passing the 750 metres when taking a marginal run between DOCTOR EDEN and KNUTQUACKER.

LOCHAN ORA (S Olney) – Began awkwardly and lost ground. Obligated to improve wide rounding the final bend and lay out throughout the run home, shifting wider on the track.

SECRET POWER (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly and lost ground.

FAIRLIGHT (C Johnson) – Knuckled at the start. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Rider C Johnson reported he was disappointed with the effort of the mare with Stewards requesting a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

C Johnson was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>BEETHOVEN (S Wahab) – Bounded at the start and got back.</p> <p>HANK MARVIN (J Morris) – Momentarily crowded passing the 225 metres.</p> <p>SHOTGLASS (J Lowry) – Rider reported the gelding had held its breath during the running.</p> <p>PRETTY WHAIHINE (L Callaway) – Raced wide for the majority of the event.</p> <p>RUBY MARIE (T Moseley) – Shifted in at the start and bumped heavily with POLKA DOT. Placed in restricted room passing the 50 metres when NESTA lay in under pressure.</p> <p>ZABAY (C Barnes) – When spoken to regarding the performance rider C Barnes could offer no tangible explanation.</p> <p>POLKA DOT (H Bennet) – Began awkwardly and was further hampered when bumped heavily by RUBY MARIE which shifted in, then tailed the field throughout.</p> <p>FULLY PUMPED (R Firdhaus) – When spoken to regarding the improved performance trainer P Rudkin advised the mare was having its first start from his stable and after trialing well recently a forward showing had ben expected.</p> <p>Following the running of this event the official track conditions were downgraded to Slow 7.</p> | |

| <p>CENTAVADA (C Barnes) – Raced wide from the 800 metres.</p> <p>CAVALUCCI (J Lowry) – Raced wide in the early stages. Crowded and had to steady passing the 500 metres when PAW PATROL (S Wahab) improved quickly into a marginal run between CAVALUCCI and CENTAVADA. Apprentice rider S Wahab was advised he must not anticipate runs until they are fully established.</p> <p>COUNTESS RUBY (C Johnson) – Bumped at the start. When spoken to regarding the performance of favoured runner, rider C Johnson advised the mare had only battled fairly in the Slow track conditions.</p> <p>MISS TUSCAN (A Sharpe) – Began awkwardly and shifted in, making firm contact with COUNTESS RUBY. Had to steady in the shadows of the post when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of TRAVEL WISE.</p> <p>THE QUIET MAN (A Bohorun) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> | |

Jostled with RAISE YOU TEN over the concluding stages.</p> <p>LORD BEAVER (A Sharpe) – Raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>FLICKA OF GOLD (R Firdhaus) – Raced wide for the majority of the event. Returned to the birdcage with blood present in the mouth with a post-race veterinary examination revealing the gelding to have bitten its tongue.</p> <p>GOLD'NGURU (S Wynne) – Held up for some distance when improving up on to heels near the 600 metres. Held up when improving quickly on to the heels of FLICKA OF GOLD passing the 200 metres then had to steady and shift ground outwards passing the 150 metres to find clear racing room.</p> <p>IRISH EXPRESS (C Johnson) – Slow to begin. Raced keenly for a short distance passing the 1000 metres. When spoken to regarding the performance rider C Johnson advised the gelding was not comfortable in the prevailing Slow 7 track conditions.
