## **RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1 FATHERS F & J SHANNAHAN TRUST & ZHOU FAMILY 1100

IFNOT WAINOT (C Dell) - Slow away.

JOYFULL ACE (J Whiteside) - Slow away.

**COMMENDED** (L Innes) - Slow away.

PEGASOI (M Du Plessis) - Held up rounding the final turn from the 500 metres to near the 350 metres.

**MATHIEU** (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after travelling comfortably enough the gelding had struggled in today's testing track conditions once placed under pressure and had felt indifferent in its action over the final stages. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

### Race 2 SWISS BELSUITES 1200

SALTED CARAMEL (A Sims) – Jumped away awkwardly then raced wide without cover.

#### Race 3 LT MCGUINESS CONSTRUCTION 1600

**DELUXE EDITION** (J Fawcett) - Slow away.

BRANSOME (M Coleman) - Slow away.

**NO NEED** (S Spratt) - Over-raced when being restrained to avoid the heels of CRITICS CHOICE which shifted inwards away from BIG BEN passing the 1400 metres. When being restrained NO NEED shifted outwards placing HIGH CLASS IN restricted room having to be steadied near the 1300 metres. Shifted outwards under pressure over the final 100 metres.

HIGH CLASS (S Weatherley) - Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1300 metres.

**STACCATO** (O Bosson) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

## Race 4 HAROLD PLUMLEY MEMORIAL MITCHELSON CUP

**BANBURY LAD** (L Satherley) - Was inclined to over-race in the middle stages.

**ARITE GURU** (R Scott) - Stumbled near the 800 metres, lost the right hind plate during the running, a post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any significant abnormality.

**YOUWANTMORE** (S Weatherley) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had been disappointing and was unable to offer any excuses other than possibly feeling the effects of recent racing. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**MANGAROA FLO JO** (M Cameron) - Rider advised that in his opinion the mare would be better suited by looser track conditions than those encountered today.

### Race 5 QUEENSTOWN HOUSE 2100

**FREEWHEELER** - Declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 1.10pm as it was lame in the left hind leg after being injured when being transported to the racecourse.

**MASTER GENIE** (C Lammas) - Lay outwards under pressure in the final straight having to be straightened on a number of occasions inconveniencing COOLIBAH near the 250 metres and again near the 50 metres.

**COOLIBAH** (G Cooksley) - Inconvenienced 250 metres and again near the 50 metres.

**BASIL BRUSH** (L Satherley) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any apparent abnormality.

M Du Plessis - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

#### Race 6 NONIE KIELY MEMORIAL 1400

**KAMIKAZE REBEL** (C Lammas) - Over-raced for a distance passing the 1200 metres, bumped by CALL ME BOB rounding the bend near the 375 metres then being briefly steadied when placed in restricted room to the outside of CALL ME BOB, required veterinary treatment post-race as it was mildly lame in the left foreleg.

<b>OTABADCRAFTSMAN</b> (J Waddell) - Over-raced for a distance passing the 1200 metres, lost the right front plate uring the running.
