<u>Avondale Jockey Club - 27 September 2017</u> Race 6 - AVONDALE SUNDAY MARKETS 1200 ELUSIVE METEOR (T Thornton) – Trainer T Cruz advised Stewards that in his opinion the mare had failed to handle the track conditions, adding that he was satisfied with its recovery and would look to continue on with its current preparation when the track conditions improve.
<u>Auckland Racing Club - 30 September 2017</u> Race 1 - FATHERS F & J SHANAHAN TRUST & ZHOU FAMILY 1100 MATHIEU (M Cameron) – Trainer G Rogerson advised Stewards that the gelding has now been sent for a spell.

YOUWANTMORE (S Weatherley) – Trainer R Priscott advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the mare and it is his intention to freshen her prior to racing next.

Race 7 - FASTTRACK INSURANCE 3210

NOTHING TRIVIAL (T Thornton) – Trainer W Hillis advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding and it is his intention to freshen the gelding prior to racing next.

Auckland Racing Club - 30 September 2017

Race 6 - NONIE KIELY MEMORIAL 1400

KAMIKAZE REBEL (C Lammas) – Trainer T Lammas advised Stewards that the gelding has now been sent for spell.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Tavistock Owners Syndicate 2YO (900 metres)
MEXICAN TYCOON (M Cameron) – Raced ungenerously when linking on to the Course Proper approaching the 600 metres and shifting out inconveniencing CASSIUS CLAY. Continued to race ungenerously rounding the final bend.	
CASSIUS CLAY (S McKay) – Inconvenienced 600 metres and again near the 100 metres when in restricted room for a short distance.	
OUR PROM KING (A Collett) – Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight shifting in near the 100 metres inconveniencing CASSIUS CLAY.	
Race 2	Redwood @ Westbury Stud (2100 metres)
RAY'S LEGACY (D Prastiyou) – Began awkwardly shifting out hampering MR BIG which lost ground. Lost the left front plate during the running.	
MR BIG (C Dell) – Hampered leaving the barrier losing ground. Raced ungenerously through the early stages.	
MASTERS CHOICE (A Collett) – Made the bend awkwardly leaving the straight on the first occasion.	
RAISON D'ETRE (S Collett) – Raced ungenerously passing the 1700 metres when in restricted room to the inside of MASTERS CHOICE.	
DEBATABLE (J Fawcett) – Hung outwards throughout and ran wide making the final bend.	
AONGATETE EXPRESS (B Morgenrood) – Lay in under pressure in the final straight having to be corrected by its rider passing the 100 metres.	
B Morgenrood (AONGATETE EXPRESS) – Admitted a breach in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.	
Race 3	United Security Northland (1600 metres)
KINGTIDE (A Sims) – Began awkwardly losing ground.	
DRAGON STORM (L Innes) – Slow away.	
RAISE THE PHANTOM (S Spratt) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Contacted 300 metres becoming unbalanced.	
ORACLE OF OMAHA (J Riddell) – Raced wide without cover throughout.	

VERBAL COMMAND (C Lammas) – Held up rounding the final turn and when shifting out approaching the 300 metres made contact with the hind quarters of XTRAPENNY which became unbalanced making heavy contact with RAISE THE PHANTOM which also became unbalanced. As a result VERBAL COMMAND blundered and lost ground. **C Lammas** was issued with a warning with Stewards taking into account the racing manners of VERBAL COMMAND which over-reacted when being angled out.

XTRAPENNY (A Collett) – Contacted 300 metres becoming unbalanced. Became awkwardly placed passing the 200 metres and steadied.

MONGOLIANCONQUEROR (M Coleman) – Shifted out passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

Race 4	Lion Red (1400 metres)
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BLUE BREEZE (M Du Plessis) – Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground.

KARISTO (M Cameron) – Contacted leaving the barrier becoming unbalanced.

HELLO IT'S ME (S Collett) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early to middle stages.

RIGHT SAID FRED (T Thornton) – Raced in restricted room approaching the 400 metres.

GOOD SUNSHINE (C Lammas) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 300 metres.

ROYAL RULER (O Bosson) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding would be better suited to more rain affected footing.

Race 5	Adams Trimmer Insurance (1400 metres)
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BRIGHTLIGN (J Nason) – Slow away. Inconvenienced 1000 metres and raced wide for a distance.

THE MITIGATOR (S McKay) – Began awkwardly. Commenced to race keenly when being restrained shifting out off heels passing the 1000 metres inconveniencing BRIGHTLIGN which ran wide.

PRIOR ENGAGEMENT (A Collett) – Crowded when leaving the barriers.

SHOCKWAVE (C Lammas) – Crowded approaching the 1300 metres to the inside of KYRIE ELEISON (S Collett) which shifted in before being corrected by its rider. SHOCKWAVE was then steadied. **S Collett** was issued with a warning.

S Collett (KYRIE ELEISON) – Issued with a warning regarding her whip use in the final straight.

Race 6	Northland Business Systems (1200 metres)
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PIRATE (L Satherley) – Slow away.

WARSET (A Collett) – Slow away losing ground.

SHE'STOOHOTTOTROT (E McCall) – Raced in restricted room passing the 1000 metres. Became awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 800 metres and then shifted out racing wide for the remainder of the race. Apprentice E McCall was shown film footage in the presence of the Riding Master and advised that she would be expected to show better judgement.

SPEEWAH (S McKay) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight until passing the 200 metres.

HONNEUR NOIR (S Spratt) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight until passing the 200 metres.

Race 7	Christmas at the Races Ruakaka 19 Dec (1200 metres)
<p>OWEN PATRICK (O Bosson) – Bucked early in the preliminary dislodging Rider O Bosson who other than being shaken by the fall was attended to by Ambulance personnel and found to be uninjured. OWEN PATRICK was declared a late scratching at 3.28pm.</p> <p>The start of this race was delayed 8 minutes due to HUNUA HANK requiring farrier attention. As the plate was unable to be replaced the gelding raced minus the right fore leg plate.</p> <p>SISTABEEL (L Innes) – Proved difficult to load into the barriers. Raced ungenerously in the middle stages becoming awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 600 metres and shifted out forcing BAHAMAS wider on the track.</p> <p>PEACEFUL FALLS (J Waddell) – Made contact with the front gate of the starting stalls and was removed undergoing a veterinary inspection before being cleared to run.</p> <p>HUNUA HANK (M Du Plessis) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied passing the 900 metres and continued to do so for a distance making the bend awkwardly and continued to race ungenerously throughout.</p> <p>BAHAMAS (S Spratt) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Forced wider on track 600 metres.</p>	
Race 8	Lion Red (1200 metres)
<p>DAMA ZORRO (M Coleman) – Hampered on jumping away losing ground. Commenced to over-race making the 800 metre bend awkwardly.</p> <p>HANGER (L Innes) – Slow away. Held up early in the final straight shifting out approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>LIL' ROKA (A Collett) – Hampered and steadied approaching 200 metres when HANGER (L Innes) shifted out to obtain clear running when not fully clear. L Innes was issued with a warning</p> <p>MIRAZUR (T Thornton) – Hung out when making the bend near the 900 metres and continued to do so for a distance.</p> <p>Following the race J Riddell was stood down after becoming dehydrated.</p>	
Race 9	Interislander Summer Festival Ruakaka 6 Jan
<p>KACHHI (J Fawcett) – Slow away. Made the 800 metre bend awkwardly. Lay out under pressure over the final 200 metres.</p> <p>O'CAROL (M Cameron) – Commenced to give ground passing the 600 metres and was not persevered with over the final 200 metres. A post-race veterinary inspection found the mare to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia with the connections being advised that a veterinary clearance including an ECG will be required prior to racing next.</p>	
Race 10	Racing @ Ruakaka Friday 17 Nov (1400 metres)
<p>SPIDER (T Thornton) – Slow away. Briefly held up passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>PRINCE MAMBO (A Schwerin) – Slow away.</p> <p>SWISSTA (A Collett) – Held up for clear running early in the final straight.</p>
