Race 1	WAIPA RACING CLUB MEMBERS 1150
FULL OF TALENT (A Jones) – Slow To begin.	
KALLESKE (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly.	
NOPELE (R Scott) – Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of GIN SLING (J Fawcett) which improved to the inside of CULZEAN which was shifting in near the 1000 metres. Also hampered was INCASEITEL. Rider J Fawcett was reprimanded by Stewards and issued with a warning.	

INCASEITEL (L Satherley) - Hampered 1000 metres.

IN THE CLEAR (S Spratt) – Held up rounding the bend into the final straight obtaining clear running passing the 200 metres.

KRAKUSY (T Allen) – Had to steady when in restricted room near the 300 metres when under pressure.

COPPER XPRESS (J Fawcett) - Slow away.

MI GOLD CARD (S Weatherley) – Slow away.

SO MUCH MOUR (S Spratt) – Briefly held up rounding the final bend.

HEAD RUSH (J Nason) – Had to briefly steady near the 800 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of MASTAPLAZA.

FEEL THE BEAT (A Collett) – Was inclined to lay in throughout.

HAPPINESS IS (B Morgenrood) – Slow to begin (5L). A warning was placed on the mare's barrier manners.

RENMINBI (B Jones) – Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels of LEONARDO which shifted in shortly after the start.

MOUNT MIDORIYAMA (S Collett) – Commenced to give ground passing the 400 metres and was not persevered with over the final 200 metres. When questioned, rider S Collett was unable to offer any reason for the gelding's performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

VITTACHI (J Riddell) – Lay out under pressure in the final straight.

PIERROCITY (D Johnson) – The start of this was delayed approximately four minutes due to the filly being reluctant to be led up to the barriers.

WAYOFLIFE (A Jones) – Escaped riderless for a short distance after dislodging its rider in the preliminary. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was declared fit to start. Bumped for a distance shortly after the start

Fontelina (M Cameron) - Began awkwardly and shifted in making firm contact with WAYOFLIFE for a distance. Steadied passing the 250 metres when becoming awkwardly on heels.

SOUL SERENADE (J Riddell) - Crowded shortly after the start.

VERDANT (S Weatherley) - Stumbled passing the 600 metres.

WOODEN EDGE (V Gatu) - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.

<p>WORTHITSWAITNGOLD (J Nason) – Began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>HIGHLAD (M Cameron) – When questioned into the performance of the gelding rider advised the gelding failed to handle today’s testing track conditions.</p> <p>SHONALI (S Spratt) - When questioned into the performance of the mare rider advised the mare failed to handle today’s testing track conditions.</p> <p>D Hain admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used the whip excessively prior to the 100 metres and was fined a sum of \$300.</p>	
Race 8	IRWIN’S TRUCKS & BUSES 1400
<p>SINGLE SHOT (E Smith) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>SALTED CARAMEL (A Sims) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>NATIONAL ASSET (R Jones) – Commenced to race ungenerously shortly after the start having to steady after becoming awkwardly placed on heels. Stumbled near the 700 metres.</p> <p>SUMMER DALE (T Allan) - Began awkwardly shifting in crowding LADDIE OF OAKVIEW. Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels near the 500 metres.</p> <p>ENJOY THE RIDE (J Fawcett) - Lay in passing the 500 metres making contact with DON’T BE CHEEKY with that runner shifting in forcing SUMMER DALE inwards who became awkwardly placed on the heels of LADY OF OAKVIEW having to be steadied.</p> <p>SPRING SHOW (M Hills) – Commenced to give ground passing the 400 metres and was not persevered with over the final 300 metres. Rider was unable to offer any reason for the mare’s performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia and will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing again.</p>	
Race 9	WAIPA HOME OF CHAMPIONS 1400
<p>DOUGIE (D Johnson) and PASBACHE (C Lammas) had to steady when crowded between MOSSOMAK and HUNGRY EYES when both these runners shifted ground under pressure near the 150 metres.</p> <p>DOUGIE (D Johnson) – Steadied passing the 150 metres losing ground. When questioned into the performance of the gelding the rider was unable offer any tangible excuse.</p> <p>PASABACHE (C Lammas) - Steadied when crowded passing the 150 metres losing ground.</p>
