HONEY RIDER (M Coleman) – Trainer A Forsman advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the mare, adding that the connections were still considering her racing future.

MOUNT MIDORIYAMA (S Collett) – Trainer N Tiley advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding and it is his intention to continue with its current preparation.

Race 6 COLOUR PLUS TE AWAMUTU 1580

WOODEN EDGE (V Gatu) – Trainer C Wood advised Stewards that gelding underwent blood tests on return to his stable which did not reveal any abnormality, adding it is his intention to continue with its current preparation.

Race 1	MILLS REEF WINERY 1800
<p>LA ACHIEVER (R Elliot) – Slow to begin. Held up rounding the final bend and early in the final straight.</p> <p>SHADY LADY (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly, then commenced to over-race in the early stages. Lay out under pressure in the final straight. When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion that the mare may be feeling the effects of recent racing, with co-trainer G Lowry confirming that the mare was now likely to be spelled.</p> <p>ROYAL DIAMOND (C Johnson) – Over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p>R Elliot – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 2	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE
<p>CARILLION – Rider O Bosson was unable to make the weight and was fined \$200 under the Minor Infringement Schedule. The replacement rider was S Collett.</p> <p>NEEDLEPOINT (V Colgan) – Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages, and continued to do so in the middle stages. When questioned into the performance rider was unable to offer any reason for the mare’s performance. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any apparent abnormality.</p> <p>UNUSUAL ACHIEVER (L Innes) – Raced three wide without cover. When questioned as to relaxing his ride over the concluding stages rider advised that the mare had felt indifferent in its action. L Innes was reminded of his obligations to ride his mounts out to the finish of the race whenever circumstances permit. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any apparent abnormality.</p>	
Race 3	KIWI KONTRACTORS 1300
<p>Trainer J Collett – Issued with a warning after presenting SWITCH PITCHER with an item of gear which had not been notified (ear covers).</p> <p>IFFRAAJINATOR (A Jones) – Slow to begin. Had to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly placed on heels 950 metres. Steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of the weakening TOUGH KID passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>SWITCH PITCHER (S Collett) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1200 metres badly for a distance.</p> <p>IVY’S COURT (A Collett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>TOUGH KID (C Johnson) – Commenced to give ground passing the 150 metres. Rider C Johnson was unable to offer any reason. A post- race veterinary inspection revealed a poor recovery.</p>	
Race 4	ASCOT FARM 1200
<p>RIPPIN (L Allpress) – Slow away.</p>	

CINNAMAN (S Weatherley) – Jumped away awkwardly from the outside barrier stall and commenced to race ungenerously before running off rounding the bend and not being persevered with by its rider finishing a distant last. Trainer D Guy was advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial satisfactorily to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing again.

BRIDE TO BE (V Colgan) – Had to be checked to avoid the heels of AGENT PROVOCATEUR near the 900 metres when AGENT PROVOCATEUR which was racing fiercely shifted inwards away from TROIS VALLEES then having to be corrected by its rider and shifting back out into the line of BRIDE TO BE. Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels near the 100 metres.

AGENT PROVOCATEUR (S McKay) – Over-raced badly through the early and middle stages.

VERSES (J Nason) – Raced wide without cover.

ANEVAY (C Lammas) – Had to steady when weakening after being placed in restricted room passing the 150 metres.

ATTIMO (D Johnson) – Lay out under pressure over the final 150 metres.

MORE THAN FAST (O Bosson) – Shifted out under pressure over the final 100 metres.

VINO BLANCO (S Collett) – When questioned regarding improved performance co-trainer G Lowry advised that the mare had taken considerable benefit from its debut race, and was further of the opinion that the mare was suited by today's track conditions.

Race 5	GENERATION HOMES TAUPO 1200

PEARLESCENCE (L Satherley) – Was very fractious in the barriers having to be removed and re-loaded. Co-trainer A Forsman was advised that a warning would be placed against the mare for its barrier manners. Began awkwardly losing ground.

RAINBOW SONG (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly then was crowded shortly after having to be steadied. Had to briefly steady when awkwardly placed on the heels of SELOUS which was taken out by SCARLET'S SECRET when shifting out to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

WONDER WOMAN (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

SCARLET'S SECRET (D Johnson) – Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly. Was not persevered with over the final 150 metres. When questioned the rider could offer no reason for the mare's performance.

BOBO SO GOOD (S Collett) – Held up for a distance entering the final straight.

RICKY BAKER (J Fawcett) – Slow to begin. Had to steady when in restricted room to the inside of SHADOW DANCER which shifted in to obtain clear running near the 250 metres. Lay out under pressure passing the 150 metres crowding SHADOW DANCER.

ELECTRODE (M Cameron) – Made the 800 metre bend awkwardly running wide.

SHADOW DANCER (D Johnson) – Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres. Shifted in to obtain clear running 250 meters. Crowded 150 meters

CASCATA (M Du Plessis) – Held up when awkwardly placed on heels until passing the 200 metres having to shift out to obtain clear running.

Race 7

ITM/G F GALBRAITH MEMORIAL 1000

THE LAST TSUNAMI – Rider G Swann was unable to make the weight and was fined \$100 under the Minor Infraction Schedule. The replacement rider was S Collett. Slow to begin.

TATTLE (M Coleman) – When jumping away rider M Coleman lost the use of his left stirrup iron when the buckle came undone with TATTLE then shifting out abruptly hampering ESTEFANIA, RIO STAR and FAST FINANCE. M Coleman was severely disadvantaged for the remainder of the race. M Coleman’s gear was checked and found to be in good condition.

ESTEFANIA (J Bassett) – Hampered start losing ground.

RIO STAR (L Allpress) – Hampered start losing ground.

FAST FINANCE (J Fawcett) – Hampered start losing ground.

SCORCHED EARTH (D Johnson) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres.

L Satherley – Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 8

STARLIGHT CINEMA HANDICAP 1000

LIGHT SHADOW (S McKay) – Slow away.

JUSTACANTA (M Coleman) – Slow away.

CONJURING (J Nason) – Began awkwardly making contact with LUCKY EDIE. Raced ungenerously when being steadied passing the 600 metres. Lost the off fore plate during the running.

LUCKY EDIE (R Elliot) – Bumped start losing ground.

SLEEK SECRET (C Johnson) – Held up approaching the 150 metres.
