Race 1	L.J. HOOKER GROUP GERALDINE MAIDEN (1200m)
<p>LA ROCSETTA (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly making contact with TEEGEEVEE, raced wide throughout.</p> <p>SMOKE 'EM WILSON (C Johnson) – Over raced for some distance passing the 1000 metres, lay outwards rounding the final bend.</p> <p>ON POINT (S Wynne) – Made the bend at the 900 metres awkwardly, inconvenienced 200 metres.</p> <p>FIVEWAYEIGHT (T Moseley) – Got its head up when making the bend awkwardly at the 800 metres.</p> <p>AQUAZURRA (A Morgan) – Lay out rounding the final bend.</p> <p>LADY AMADEUS (S Collett) – Held up passing the 300 metres before shifting outwards across the heels of FEISTY JANE to obtain clear running approaching the 200 metres inconveniencing ON POINT which then shifted away from LADY AMADEUS making contact with GALISINI.</p> <p>GALISINI (L Hemi) – Bumped 200 metres</p> <p>S Collett (LADY AMADEUS) – Warned for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>A Morgan (AQUAZURRA) – Reminded of her obligations regarding whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 2	D'CASH DASH (1200m)
<p>THOM BROWN (L Allpress) – Hampered when crowded leaving the barriers losing ground.</p> <p>ZENTESEA (S Collett) – Hampered when crowded leaving the barriers losing ground.</p> <p>SKEDADDLE SKEDOO (T Jonker) – Slow away, raced wide throughout.</p> <p>MAMMA SANS (C Johnson) –Jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>THE DE BOY (K Williams) – Raced keenly in the early stages with the bit coming through the mouth and proving difficult to control, raced wide throughout. A post race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities. The connections advised it was their intention to make gear changes.</p>	

<p>BENEFICIAL (K Kwo) – Over raced when being steadied approaching the 1000 metres continuing to over race through the middle stages, tended to lay in in the home straight and had to be straightened.</p> <p>YOUSEEMENOW (S Wynne) – Held up in the early stages of the home straight shifting inwards near the 200 metres to obtain clear running.</p>	
Race 3	ASCOT SPORTSHOUSE & EATERY MAIDEN (1200m)
<p>MAYFAIR MADAM (C Johnson) – Began awkwardly and shifted outwards hampering PRODUCER.</p> <p>PRODUCER (S Wynne) – Hampered at the start losing ground.</p> <p>DON'T SHUFFLE ME (A Morgan) – Restrained shortly after leaving the barriers, raced keenly for a distance passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>JEWELL OF JUMERIAH (A Collett) – Got its head up when being restrained passing the 1000 metres, hung outwards throughout.</p> <p>SPLENDIOR (T Moseley) – Placed in restricted room passing the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of AKOYA PEARL, continued to over race for a distance again becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of FRAZZLE near the 800 metres, raced greenly passing the 200 metres when reluctant to race between horses.</p>	
Race 4	EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES SPRINT (1200m)
<p>Trainers M and M Pitman were issued with a warning under Rule 616(4) after presenting SON OF MAHER without an item of notified gear (side winkers).</p> <p>FASCINATE (C Campbell) – Jumped away awkwardly making solid contact with OPIHI RANGER which was forced onto MR TYPHON with FASCINATE and OPIHI RANGER then racing in restricted room for a distance, continued to over race passing the 1000 metres for some distance when laying outwards.</p> <p>OPIHI RANGER (J Morris) – Bumped at the start and then raced in restricted room for a distance, placed in restricted room and checked passing the 1000 metres when RESIDENTIAL (G Jogoo) shifted in when not clear. G Jogoo admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 2 days effective 16 October to 25 October inclusive. Got its head up for some distance when having to be steadied off the heels of RESIDENTIAL passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>MR TYPHON (P Shaikh) – Bumped at the start.</p> <p>ASTRID (S Collett) – Slow away.</p> <p>SON OF MAHER (C Johnson) – Raced wide in the early stages, raced keenly for a distance passing the 800 metres.</p>	
Race 5	MAURICE SMITH 1200 (1200m)
<p>SILVERMIST was declared a late scratching at 2.30 pm after proving reluctant to proceed to the start and dislodging rider L Hemi who was uninjured after initially being winded.</p> <p>CANTILENA (S Wynne) – Slow away.</p> <p>OPIHI JADE (R Cuneen) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>WHY ME (P Shaikh) – Inclined to lay outwards rounding the turn and held up momentarily when on heels approaching the 140 metres.</p> <p>SENSEI (C Johnson) – Held up for a distance passing the 300 metres before obtaining clear running approaching the 200 metres.</p>	

ELLERSTINA (T Moseley) – Raced keenly when in the lead.	
FLASH SUGGESTION (R Yatim) – Raced keenly outside the leader. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.	
Following this race the track was upgraded to Dead (5).	
Race 6	ONCEUPONATIME HANDICAP (1600m)
SPRITZ (H Bennet) – Stood in the gates as the start was effected and very slow to begin. The connections were advised that a barrier manners' warning would be placed against the mare's record.	
MOBY (R Cuneen) – Restrained to the rear after jumping.	
BLUE PRINT (L Hemi) – Checked passing the 1400 metres when crowded for room by DIRECTOR (C Johnson).	
C Johnson (DIRECTOR) admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of BLUE PRINT which was checked near the 1400 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 4 days effective 15 October to 21 October inclusive.	
DIRECTOR (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages, clipped a heel near the 250 metres and blundered shifting ground inwards to obtain clear running, shifted inwards to obtain clear running near the 150 metres making contact with SWIFT INDULGENCE which in turn bumped SAVANNAH GEM which was momentarily unbalanced.	
C Johnson (DIRECTOR) admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he angled his mount outwards when not sufficiently clear of VERNA AUDREY which was checked when forced outwards onto the heels of BLUE PRINT approaching the 300 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 5 days effective 22 October to 27 October inclusive.	
VERNA AUDREY (S Wynne) – Checked when forced across heels approaching the 300 metres.	
GREY GHOST (A Collett) – Became awkwardly placed on the heels of REDESDALE near the 250 metres and shifted outwards hampering MOBY .	
TRAVEL WISE (T Jonker) – Hampered when dictated outwards near the 250 metres.	
G Jogoo (MYSTERY MAN) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he permitted his mount to shift outwards near the 250 metres when not sufficiently clear, dictating TRAVEL WISE outwards into the line of DIRECTOR which clipped a heel and blundered, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 3 days effective 26 October to 5 November 217.	
ULTRA CHIC (J Morris) Restrained to the rear after jumping, returned to the birdcage with blood present in both nostrils underwent a post race veterinary inspection which revealed the mare to be a bleeder and accordingly it was stood down for the mandatory 3 month period.	
Race 7	SPEIGHTS 1600 (1600m)
WHO DARES WINS (K Williams) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground, raced keenly in the middle stages and was taken forward to sit outside the leader, held up in restricted room over the concluding stages and could not be ridden to full advantage.	
ASPEN LASS (C Johnson) – Held up approaching the 250 metres and when attempting a marginal run made contact with the hindquarters of HOT TEMPO , and was then held up until the 150 metres.	
LOCHAN ORA (C Campbell) - Held up in restricted room over the concluding stages and could not be ridden to full advantage.	
Race 8	DOMINATOR DOORS MAIDEN MILE (1600m)

OUR ROYAL (R Bishop) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground, steadied passing the 500 metres when awkwardly placed on heels and shifted outwards.

ERIN'S BABE (S Muniandy) – Slow away.

PENDLETON (S Collett) – Slow away.

KERRYTOWNCHARLOTTE (L Hemi) – Raced wide throughout.

MACKENZIE COUNTRY (J Lowry) – Gave ground from the 500 metres. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

LEULUAI (R Cuneen) – Checked when crowded near the 350 metres and forced outwards onto PENDLETON.

A Collett admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that she angled her mount outwards when insufficiently clear of LEULUAI which was checked near the 350 metres when forced onto PENDLETON, with the Judicial Committee suspending her licence to ride at race meetings for 4 days effective 16 October to 21 October inclusive.

PENDLETON (S Collett) – Bumped 350 metres.

A Collett (LADY DAVONE) – Reminded of her obligations prior to weighing in.

Race 9	PORT FM MAIDEN 2100 (2100m)
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POLKA DOT (H Bennet) – Ducked outwards abruptly when jumping away from the outside barrier losing considerable ground.

LARRIKIN (K Williams) – Slow away.

JUST (J Lowry) – Slow away.

SEBRING DRAGON (T Jonker) – Hampered leaving the barriers when METASEQUOIA jumped inwards.

PAINTED ANGEL (L Hemi) – Over raced when being restrained in the early stages.

Race 10	CATERING SOUTH CANTERBURY STAYERS (2100m)
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S Muniandy (GALLANT DEFENDER) was unable to make the contracted weight and was replaced by T Moseley. S Muniandy was fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule.

MYSTIC POWER (S Wynne) – Raced keenly in the early stages making the bend near the 1700 metres awkwardly, continued to over race for some distance, gave ground passing the 400 metres. A post race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate. Stewards will follow up with Trainer M Daly in coming days.

ASTROTURF (K Williams) – Raced wide without cover from the 1000 metres,

LIN (G Jogoo) – Raced three wide without cover until near the 900 metres.

GALLANT DEFENDER (T Moseley) – Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 600 metres. Rider T Moseley was reminded of his obligations regarding whip use prior to the 100 metres.

ZARTAN (K Kwo) – Inclined to lay out over the concluding stages having to be straightened.
