| EDWARD (T Moseley) – When asked to comment on the performance of the favoured runner rider T Moseley could offer no tangible explanation. |  |

**BLUEY'S CHANCE** (K Kalychurun) – Restrained to the rear on jumping.

**DREAM START** (R Bishop) – Raced wide in the early stages.

**Race 2** | **THE BIOFEED COMPANY / COVERTONE MAIDEN (1200m)**

**DOPPELGANGER** (K Kalychurun) – Began awkwardly and got back. Severely hampered near the 900 metres.

**GET RYTHM** (A Bohorun) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 700 metres and had to be angled wider on the track hampering **MISS CATHERINE**. A Bohorun was shown a replay of this incident and advised he must exercise greater care when shifting ground. Improved wide from the 600 metres.

**RUNNINGTHEGAUNTLET** (L Callaway) – Inconvenienced near the 900 metres.

**MISS CATHERINE** (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin. Hampered at the 800 metres. Forced wider on track passing the 700 metres.

**SHE'S FUN** (K Kwo) – Crowded and checked passing the 900 metres when **THE LUSTRE** (C Johnson) shifted in when insufficiently clear, resulting in **SHE'S FUN** clipping a heel, blundering and dislodging apprentice rider K Kwo who was uninjured in this incident. Apprentice Kwo was examined by the St John Ambulance Paramedics and cleared to fulfill his remaining riding engagements today. **RUNNINGTHEGAUNTLET** was inconvenienced in this incident and **DOPPELGANGER** was severely hampered, having to shift wider on the track to avoid the fallen rider. Rider C Johnson admitted a resultant breach of Rule 638(1)(d) Careless Riding and after viewing replays and hearing submissions on penalty the JCA imposed a suspension of Mr Johnson's licence to ride from the 27th October up to and including the 8<sup>th</sup> November (8 riding days). **SHE'S FUN** underwent a post-race veterinary examination after making contact with a gate and was found to have suffered some minor abrasions to the chest area and near fore leg.

**THE LUSTRE** (C Johnson) – When questioned regarding the apparent improved performance connections advised the filly had raced greenly and wide at its previous start and today had benefitted from a stronger rider and more economical run.

**Race 3** | **COUNTRY JEWEL MAIDEN (1200m)**

**MAKS LEGEND** (S Wynne) – Held up for a short distance rounding the final bend.

**NAPOLEON DYNAMITE** (K Kalychurun) – Slow to begin and was very awkward in its action through the early stages when attempting to buck, losing considerable ground, then tailed the field throughout. Connections were advised the gelding would be required to trial to the Stewards satisfaction prior to racing next. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a minor abrasion above the eye.

**FITSANDGIGGLES** (R Bishop) – Raced wide throughout.

**COURTE ZARINDI** (T Moseley) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.

**MY SOPRANO** (R Beeharry) – Raced wide throughout.

**Race 4** | **NIGHTCAPS CONTRACTING HANDICAP (1200m)**

**ROBIN CHARLES** (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

**WAIMATE BILL** (A Bohorun) – Raced wide throughout.

**BURWOOD** (R Bishop) – When questioned regarding the performance rider R Bishop advised that in his opinion the mare would prefer more moisture in the ground and further distance.

**HIGHER AUTHORITY** (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Crowded and had to steady passing the 1000 metres when **POLLY'S SISTER** (G Jogoo) shifted in. G Jogoo was issued with a warning for the manner he shifted ground. Had to change ground passing the 150 metres to find clear racing room.

**OH SO SMART** (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin. Apprentice rider R Beeharry was issued with a warning for the manner he used his whip prior to the 100 metres.

Riders C Johnson and K Kalychurun were both advised they must ensure to ride their mounts out fully to the finish line where circumstances permit.

**Race 5** | **AB LIME CENTRAL SOUTHLAND CUP (1200m)**

**SECRET POWER** (C Johnson) – Held up momentarily passing the 400 metres. Lay out over the concluding stages and could not be ridden to full advantage.

**THYME ZONE** (T Moseley) – Momentarily crowded by **SHOWEMUP** (D Bradley) passing the 1100 metres. D Bradley was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground. Crowded again passing the 225 metres when **MAGIC EPIC** which was laying out, shifted out.

**SHOWEMUP** (D Bradley) – Momentarily hampered at the 200 metres and forced wider on track. Rider D Bradley advised that in his opinion the mare was looking for tracks with more moisture.

**MR CONDUCTOR** (T Newman) – Shied and shifted out abruptly at the 200 metres momentarily hampering **SHOWEMUP** which was forced wider on the track.

**KING PIN** (G Jogoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**Race 6** | **SPEIGHT'S HANDICAP (2000m)**

**DREAM DIVINE** (C Campbell) – Held up rounding the final bend.

**THE ENERGIZER** (G Bourke) – Improved wide from the 1200 metres.

**ROCK SOLID** (R Bishop) – Held up from the 400 metres only gaining clear racing room inside the final 200 metres.

**Race 7** | **AON INSURANCE BROKERS WINTON CUP (2000m)**

**LA NOUVELLE VAGUE** (D Bothamley) – When questioned regarding the performance rider D Bothamley advised the gelding had felt indifferent over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have suffered a tendon injury to the near fore leg. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to **LA NOUVELLE VAGUE** racing next.

**STOKERS ROCK** (S Wynne) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Shifted in and brushed with **COME FLY WITH ME** passing the 200 metres and again passing the 75 metres. Rider S Wynne reported the gelding had felt awkward in its action on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a minor injury to the left front fetlock with trainer J McKay advising **STOKERS ROCK** would now be sent for a spell.

**Race 8** | **ADVANCE AGRICULTURE MAIDEN (1600m)**

**LITTLE BOSSING** (L Callaway) – Late scratching at 3.58pm on veterinary advice after being kicked at the start area. A veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have suffered a laceration to the left medial stifle area.

**NESTA** (S Wahab) – Late scratching at 4.05 pm after refusing to assemble into the start area.

**BEETHOVEN** (G Bourke) – Had to be steadied off heels passing the 800 metres when racing keenly. Held up rounding the final bend.

**HOLY MACKEREL** (D Bothamley) – Over-raced in the early stages and had to be steadied passing the 1100 metres when improving onto the heels of **RUBY MARIE** (T Moseley) which shifted in at this point. T Moseley was warned for the manner he shifted ground. Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.

**RIDING HIGH** (J Lowry) – Raced wide throughout.

**SHOTGLASS** (D Bradley) – Slow to begin.

**DREAM RICH** (C Campbell) – Improved wide from the 500 metres.

**RUBY MARIE** (T Moseley) – Raced wide in the early stages.

**BOW DOWN** (C Johnson) – Raced keenly when leading in the early stages.

**MISS TANIRA** (S Wynne) – Late scratching at 4.02pm after refusing to load with connections advised the filly must barrier trial prior to racing next.

**Race 9** | **COMMERCIAL HOTEL HANDICAP (1600m)**

**FIVE KINGS** (R Beeharry) – Lay out over the concluding stages shifting wider on the track.

**ODI ET AMO** (G Bourke) – Raced wide throughout.

**BAKELA** (C Johnson) – When spoken to regarding the performance of favoured runner rider C Johnson advised that the gelding had traveled well during the running however when the pace of the race increased near the 600 metres he had failed to let down when placed under pressure. Mr Johnson added that in his opinion BAKELA may be better suited to rain affected going.

**INDIANA PEARL** (D Bradley) – Reported to have lost its off fore and near hind racing plates during the running.

**DOCTOR EDEN** (S Toolooa) – Raced keenly in the early stages when leading. Stewards spoke with apprentice rider S Toolooa regarding his ride and in particular why he hadn't taken up a position closer to the rail in the early and middle stages when racing 2 to 3 horse width off the rail. Mr Toolooa advised that after studying where the previous winners had come from today, he believed that there was an advantage to be gained by racing wider on the track. Stewards reviewed the films with Mr Toolooa and advised that in their opinion he should have taken a position near the rail in the early and middle stages then shifted out wider during the run home if he believed that was beneficial to his chances. Mr Toolooa was further advised that the Stewards believed he had erred on this occasion and that he would be expected to show better judgement in future.

**Race 10** | **RYAL BUSH TRANSPORT HANDICAP (1600m)**

**WILD JACK** (A Bohorun) – Apprentice rider A Bohorun was spoken to regarding his unnecessary use of the whip over the concluding stages.

**MADAM DE SOIR** (K Kalychurun) – Crowded at the start and lost ground, then tailed the field for the majority of the event despite the efforts of rider K Kalychurun. When spoken to regarding the performance rider K Kalychurun advised the mare had been outpaced through the early and middle stages however had made ground over the concluding stages and in his opinion would benefit from rain affected tracks and a step up in distance.

**FRANCONI** (G Bourke) – Race wide throughout.

**COUNTESS RUBY** (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. When spoken to regarding the performance rider C Johnson advised the mixed pace through the early and middle stages had been detrimental to the mare's chances today.
