KEEP ON COMING (V Colgan) – Trainer P Gerard advised Stewards that she was satisfied with the recovery of the mare, adding that the connections would be assessing its racing future in the coming days.

RAYAS (M Coleman) – Trainer J Shaw advised Stewards that she was satisfied with the recovery of the mare and it is his intention to carry on with the current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE
<p>FLAUNT IT GIRL (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly. Steadied and hampered 900 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of CASSIUS CLAY (S McKay) which lay in and away from JON WICK which shifted in slightly. S McKay was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances. FLAUNT IT GIRL clipped a heel and blundered passing the 650 metres when racing in restricted room between OUR BEESKEES and POWER OF STRENGTH which had both made the bend awkwardly and shifted ground.</p> <p>POWER OF STRENGTH (R Elliot) – Hampered leaving the barrier.</p>	
Race 2	NOTTINGHAM CASTLE 2200
<p>HERE TO STAY (D Johnson) – Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground.</p> <p>AONGATETE EXPRESS (B Morgenrood) – Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground. Inconvenienced 400 metres. Lay in approaching the 200 metres making contact with FOUR DAY HIGH for a short distance.</p> <p>B Morgenrood (AONGATETE EXPRESS) - Reprimanded for making a celebratory gesture prior to the winning post.</p> <p>THE OTHER HALF (T Thornton) – Checked 2100 metres and then hampered for a distance when commencing to over-race. Continued to over-race through the middle stages and as a result was obliged to race wide.</p> <p>V Colgan (NEDDY NADEEM) – Admitted a breach in that he allowed NEDDY NADEEM to shift in when not sufficiently clear of THE OTHER HALF which was checked passing the 2100 metres and then hampered for a distance, with the Judicial Committee suspending his license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 23 October up to and including 4 November, 4 riding days.</p> <p>NEDDY NADEEM (V Colgan) – Commenced to over-race for a distance in the early stages becoming awkwardly placed passing the 1700 metres having to be restrained heavily. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 250 metres.</p> <p>AMAZING LADY (J Waddell) – Raced in restricted room passing the 400 metres to the outside of TAMA AKARANA (J Nason) which shifted out under pressure. As a result AMAZING LADY made brief contact with FOUR DAY HIGH which shifted out inconveniencing AONGATETE EXPRESS. AMAZING LADY then again raced in restricted room approaching the 200 metres to the outside of TAMA AKARANA which again shifted ground. J Nason was reprimanded by Stewards and issued with a warning.</p> <p>FOUR DAY HIGH (M Cameron) – Briefly crowded 400 metres and 200 metres.</p> <p>RAISON D'ETRE (C Lammas) – When questioned regarding the performance, Rider C Lammas advised that the mare had travelled comfortably until placed under pressure where it had failed to respond and had been making abnormal breathing noises. A post-race veterinary inspection including an endoscopic examination found mild mucopurulent matter in the trachea.</p>	
Race 3	MAINFREIGHT 1400
<p>BOUNDARY (S McKay) – Hampered leaving the barrier losing ground. Commenced to over-race when being steadied through the early stages. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>KANUMISS (M Cameron) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>IAGO (L Innes) – Commenced to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing ENGLISH ROSE passing the 250 metres.</p> <p>ENGLISH ROSE (C Lammas) – Inconvenienced 250 metres.</p>	

Race 4	DONAGHYS PUREFLUSH 1400
<p>THE BOY WONDER (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>MADAM MONICA (C Lammas) – Slow away. Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>CARSON RIVER (M Du Plessis) – Over-raced for a distance from near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>RUBY CHOUX ROSE (T Wenn) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>INCOGNITO (T Abel) – Apprentice rider T Abel was questioned regarding the tactics adopted during the race with T Abel advising that she had been instructed to ride the horse quietly in the early stages in an attempt to settle the mare, with T Abel further advising that INCOGNITO had raced fiercely when attempting to do so and had not responded to urgings in the final straight. Trainer I Marks confirmed the riding instructions.</p>	
Race 5	DONAGHYS TASMAN TIM 1400
<p>FAME SEEKER (S Collett) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>LATE DECISION (C Lammas) – Slow away. When questioned regarding the performance, Rider C Lammas advised that the gelding had hung and changed stride on numerous occasions during the running feeling indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>DOUGIE (D Johnson) – Slow away.</p> <p>BREAK MY STRIDE (O Bosson) – Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>I'M BRONSON (A Schwerin) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 6	DONAGHYS PRO-EQUINE 1400
<p>HAPPINESS IS (B Morgenrood) – Very slow away (8L), and will be required to trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.</p> <p>MASKOBI PEARL (J Fawcett) – Shifted out abruptly leaving the barrier.</p> <p>GUNDOWN (M Cameron) – Hampered leaving the barrier.</p> <p>TOODALOO (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced ungenerously in the early stages.</p> <p>ROCETTE LADY (S Weatherley) – Bumped on three occasions shortly after the start losing ground. Briefly crowded and steadied approaching the 400 metres by MASKOBI PEARL which was dictated out by CURRAHEE LAD (T Wenn) which shifted ground when placed under pressure. Apprentice rider T Wenn was reprimanded by Stewards and advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>T Wenn (CURRAHEE LAD) – Severely reprimanded regarding her use of the whip in the final straight and further advised a warning would be placed on her record.</p>	
Race 7	DONAGHYS UDDERMAX 1200
<p>SALLY LUNN (S Weatherley) – Slow away. Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>THE GREAT SOUTHERN (S Collett) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>RETORT (B R Jones) – Hampered leaving the barrier.</p> <p>SANTA MONICA (S Spratt) – Over-raced in the early stages when being restrained. Raced wide without cover.</p>	

DRAGON (D Johnson) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1000 metres when being steadied shifting back on to **COMMENDED** which also over-raced for a distance.

COMMENDED (M Du Plessis) – Over-raced for a distance through the middle stages.

SACRED DAY (L Innes) – Raced greenly laying out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

UJUMPIJUMP (D Hain) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

Race 8

DONAGHYS PRO-DAIRY 1400

CLASSIC WARRIOR (S McKay) – Slow away. Hampered approaching the 200 metres when crowded by **KORAKONUI** (V Colgan) which shifted out to obtain clear running when not fully clear. Rider **V Colgan** was severely reprimanded by Stewards and advised he must ensure he is fully clear when shifting ground, further being advised that a warning would be placed on his record.

HOT SAKI (B Hutton) – Began awkwardly and when being corrected shifted out hampering **FASHIONABLY**.

FASHIONABLY (O Bosson) – Hampered start. Lost the off fore plate during the running.

BLACKJACK MAN (D Prastiyoun) – Over-raced in the early stages.

MYLADYACHIEVER (R Elliot) – Held up early in the final straight.

MAENOHA (T Thornton) – Lost the off fore plate during the running. When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer R Priscott advised that the addition of blinkers had helped the mare, and she had worked well leading into today's race. R Priscott further advised he had been confident of **MAENOHA'S** chances at Taupo on 11 October with the rider advising that the mare would benefit from the application of blinkers, further advising that he believed the mare was also better suited by today's right handed track.
