RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	DOUG LOCHEAD PAINTING 1200 (1200 metres)
EMPRESS TZU HSI (S Weatherley) – Awkwardly away. Disappointed for a run approaching the 300 metres when BAXSTREETBOY shifted inwards, having to be angled outwards to gain clear running approaching the 200 metres..	

BAXSTREETBOY (J Parkes) – Slow away. Raced wide without cover throughout. Bumped several occasions approaching the 600 metres. Shifted in under pressure passing the 100 metres having to be straightened.

SARDEEN (K Cowan) – Raced in restricted room having to be restrained approaching the 800 metres. Bumped on a number of occasions with BAXSTREETBOY when looking to improve approaching the 600 metres.

CHARLIE HORSE (M Tanaka) - Held up passing the 400 metres having to be angled inwards to gain clear running passing the 300 metres and then raced in restricted room until approaching the 200 metres.

PRAWN STAR (R Myers) - Momentarily hampered passing the 100 metres when BAXSTREETBOY shifted in under pressure.

WHAT THE DEUCE (L Hemi) - Bumped passing the 100 metres when MADAM MAKFI ducked in when struck with the whip.

KAIPAWE (J Bassett) – Lay in when struck with the whip early in the home straight, tightening CHARLIE HORSE.

MADAM MAKFI (C O’Beirne) – Ducked in when struck with the whip passing the 100 metres.

Race 2 | **ZW SYNDICATE 1200 (1200 metres)**

WHOWOULDKNOW (J Bassett) - Began awkwardly bumping PRINCESS SPICE. Raced ungenerously in the early stages making the bend passing the 800 metres awkwardly. Having to be further restrained off heels passing the 600 metres

PRINCESS SPICE (R Myers) – Bumped at start.

SHAHRAZAD (T Johnson) – Jumped awkwardly bumping PRINCESS SPICE.

THREE WAY CUT (C Lammas) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

STEALTH GIANT (M Singh) - Shied passing the 50 metres having to be straightened.

Race 3 | **D&G AUTOSPRAY 2100 (2100 metres)**

CARTAGENA (D Hirini) – Slow away.

GALAPAGOS (S Weatherley) – Slow away.

MWAADAN (C Lammas) – Gave ground quickly approaching the 800 metres and was pulled up. After undergoing a veterinary inspection, the gelding was confirmed to have bled. MWAADAN is now unable to be in training for two months and is unable to trial or race for three months with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing or trialling next.

HERE’S TROUBLE (R Myers) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nasal area. After undergoing a veterinary inspection, the gelding was confirmed to have bled. HERE’S TROUBLE is now unable to be in training for two months and is unable to trial or race for three months with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing or trialling next.

LET HER GO (K Cowan) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nasal area. After undergoing a veterinary inspection, the mare was confirmed to have bled. **LET HER GO** is now unable to be in training for two months and is unable to trial or race for three months with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing or trialling next.

Following the running of Race 3 Stewards upgraded the track to Heavy (10) after several hours of warm drying weather.

Race 4 | **ALL DIAMONDS ZEDACE SYNDICATE 2200 (2200 metres)**

HAMILTONIAN (C Lammas) – Slow away.

AL MUNROE (R Myers) - Awkwardly away settling back.

CLASS ABOVE (M Singh) – Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages.

ALL IN LUCK (J Parkes) - When questioned into the performance rider could offer no excuse.

PERFECTLY ENCHANTED (K Cowan) – Rider advised the mare may have struggled with the weight in the Heavy (10) track conditions.

ASH PALACE (D Bradley) – Lost the off-hind plate during the running.

Race 5 | **LOWE SCHOLLUM JONES 1600 (1600 metres)**

MARTY O’CEIRIN (J Parkes) - Jumped out at the start bumping **VERACIOUS** which settled back. Was not persevered with over the concluding stages, finishing last. When questioned, rider J Parkes was of the opinion the gelding would improve with the run.

VERACIOUS (M McNELIS) – Bumped at start, settled back.

M McNelis (**VERACIOUS**) was issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.

GERARDASUN – (M Singh) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

LOOK OUT (C-M Waddell) – Lugged in rounding the bend passing the 800 metres.

Race 6 | **PUKEMANU FARMS 1100 (1100 metres)**

TOULOUSE (M McNelis) – Began awkwardly.

RUFUS RUFFCUT (C Lammas) -Began awkwardly, briefly inconveniencing **INCANTATION**, which settled back.

INCANTATION (R Myers) - Briefly inconvenienced at start, settling back.

GILHOOIE (K Cowan) - Raced keenly when being restrained rounding the bend approaching the 800 metres.

Race 7 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1200 metres)**

PURE DAZE (K Cowan) – Jumped inwards abruptly at the start, having to be straightened. Settled back and then began to race keenly, running up on to heels approaching the 800 metres, having to be angled outwards to gain clear running, briefly inconveniencing **TIPPERARY MARY**. Continued to race greenly and lay out when struck with the whip in the home straight having to be straightened on a number of occasions, briefly inconveniencing **MISSTART** approaching the 100 metres, which had to be angled inwards to gain clear running.

TAVISTELLA (D Hirini) – Slow away.

MISS BUMBLEBEE (J Parkes) – When questioned into the performance, rider advised the mare may appreciate improved track conditions and also being ridden off the pace.

Race 8	DANNEVIRKE SERVICE & CITIZENS' CLUB 1400 (1400 metres)
<p>TREBBIANO (T Allan) – Tightened at the start when runners either side began awkwardly, settling back. Finished well back, when questioned into performance of the gelding, rider could offer no excuse.</p> <p>LINDSAY (H Andrew) – Inconvenienced when OUR CHARLI'S ANGEL jumped out at the start, settling back.</p> <p>CHOICE ATTITUDE (S MacNab) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>MONSIEUR (A Chan) – Raced greenly in the home straight having to be straightened on a number of occasions.</p>	
Race 9	LUMINO 1400 (1400 metres)
<p>SANDY SMALL (K Cowan) – Underwent a veterinary inspection prior to the start after becoming fractious in the barriers and was cleared to run. Raced very keenly in front in the early and middle stages making the 800 metre bend awkwardly. When questioned, K Cowan advised that she was unable to restrain the mare in the early and middle stages and had little left at the finish.</p> <p>When questioned into the disappointing run of BELLA MARGARITA, M Tanaka had no excuse.</p>	
Race 10	JOHN & NATALIE MABEY 1400 (1400 metres)
<p>KEEPING FAITH (S O'Malley) – Awkwardly away losing ground.</p> <p>STUMBLIN IN (S MacNab) – Slow away.</p> <p>FRANCESCANA (M Singh) – Jumped outwards abruptly at the start, contacting and dictating SO IT WAS wider on the track, which bumped with KAIRANGA LAD.</p> <p>SO IT WAS (S Weatherley) – Contacted and dictated at the start. When questioned into the performance of the mare, rider could offer no excuse but was of the opinion the mare would improve with the run.</p> <p>KAIRANGA LAD (C O'Beirne) – Bumped at start. Held up passing the 600 metres, gaining clear running early in the home straight.</p> <p>C O'Beirne (KAIRANGA LAD) – Advised to exercise greater care after she allowed her mount to shift in making contact with AMPARO near the finish.</p>
