RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 LOGAN EQUINE MAIDEN (2000m)

BEETHOVEN (J Lowry) – Lay out over the concluding stages and brushed with OUR ROYAL in the shadows of the post.

HOLY MACKEREL (C Campbell) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

OUR ROYAL (S Wynne) – Crowded and bumped at the start, losing ground. Brushed with BEETHOVEN in the shadows of the post.

SHOTGLASS (D Bothamley) – Crowded by inside runners at the start, losing ground.

DOPPELGANGER (K Kalychurun) – Crowded momentarily and had to steady passing the 1900 metres when BEETHOVEN (J Lowry) shifted in at this point dictating ERIN'S BABE and STRATEGUS inwards. J Lowry was advised to exercise greater care. Over-raced through the middle stages. Reported by its rider to have hung throughout the running.

HERBIE (J Morris) – Over-raced in the early stages. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home.

PRETTY WHAIHINE (K Kwo) - Had to be severely restrained off heels when racing keenly passing the 1500 metres and

continued to race keenly through to the middle stages.

Race 2 LONGFORD TAVERN & FALLS HOTEL HANDICAP (2000m)

HE AIN'T HEAVY (L Callaway) – Held up rounding the final bend, only gaining clear racing room inside the final 175 metres.

SMOKEM UP (S Wynne) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance rider S Wynne advised the gelding had over raced in the early and middle stages, with this taking its toll on the effort over the concluding stages. Miss Wynne added that in her opinion the gelding would derive benefit from today's outing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed an initial slow post-race recovery.

CENTAVADA (C Barnes) – Raced wide from the 1000 metres.

GAZZA THE GURU (T Moseley) – Rider T Moseley was spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

THE QUIET MAN (A Bohorun) – Slow to begin. Raced wide from the 700 metres.

FERGIE (C Campbell) – Began awkwardly and lost ground. Had to be angled wider on the track passing the 200 metres to find clear racing room and lay out from this point, shifting wider on the track.

Race 3 THE THOMAS GREEN & HOWL AT THE MOON HANDICAP (2000m)

SPIDER LILY (J Morris) – Over-raced in the early stages. Hung for the majority of the event and lost ground near the 700 metres when making the bend awkwardly. Held up over the final 50 metres. When spoken to regarding the performance rider J Morris advised that the mare had hung badly on the bends and lost momentum at the vital stage of the race, however had run on very well in the home straight and in fact had been held up over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Connections were advised the mare was on a racing manners warning. Trainer L Stewart advised it was his intention to now spell the mare.

GOLD'NGURU (K Kwo) – Raced keenly and wide in the early stages. When questioned regarding the performance apprentice rider K Kwo advised that after racing wide through the early and middle stages the gelding was left flat footed when placed under pressure rounding the final bend.

KING NERO (K Kalychurun) – Raced wide throughout.

Race 4 FOREST LODGE HOTEL & TOKANUI TAVERN MAIDEN (1200m)

ALL ABOUT ROY (D Bothamley) – Held up for several strides passing the 200 metres and had to be angled wider on the track at the 150 metres to find clear racing room.

FLY WITHOUT WINGS (A Bohorun) - Slow to begin.

THE PUBLICAN (J Lowry) - Slow to begin.

VERIFY (T Jonker) – Knuckled at the start.

ZABAY (C Campbell) – Raced in restricted room early in the run home, only gaining clear racing room inside the final 150 metres.

NIGHT LADY (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly and got back, then was further hampered when THE PUBLICAN shifted in at the start.

GO APACHE (C Barnes) – Late scratching by order of the Stewards at 2.09pm after dislodging rider C Barnes on leaving the birdcage and escaping riderless for a considerable distance. Miss Barnes was uninjured in this incident.

DOUBLE CHOICE (S Muniandy) – When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer A Borthwick advised he had been pleased with both lead up runs this preparation and the mare had derived natural benefit from both outings.

Race 5 SUPER LIQUOR GORE & HEARTLAND HOTEL (1200m)

ROBIN CHARLES (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.

WAIMATE BILL (L Callaway) – Raced wide throughout.

DOCTOR EDEN (K Kalychurun) – Over-raced in the early stages.

HE'S MI BROTHER (A Bohorun) – Momentarily crowded and had to steady, when racing keenly passing the 1000 metres.

Following the running of this event the official track conditions were upgraded to Dead 4.

Race 6 LIQUORLAND GORE & TRAFFERS HANDICAP (1335m)

ASTRID (S Muniandy) – Held up early in the run home.

SHOWEMUP (K Kwo) – Reported by its rider to have struck itself during the running. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have minor lacerations to both hind legs.

SHAKTI (K Kalychurun) – Began awkwardly and lost ground and was then out-paced through the middle stages. When spoken to regarding today's performance rider K Kalychurun advised that after beginning awkwardly, the gelding had been outpaced on a very good tempo however had found the line nicely and in his opinion would appreciate a step up distance.

Race 7 THREE RIVERS HOTEL MAIDEN (1335m)

COATNCOLLAR (K Kalychurun) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

BEAM ME UP SCOTTY (S Wynne) – Momentarily crowded and had to steady passing the 1150 metres. Held up early in the run home, only gaining clear racing room inside the final 175 metres.

DAD'S BROTHER (D Bothamley) – Bumped with THE FLAGON passing the 125 metres.

NOMEN LUDI (K Kwo) – Raced wide without cover from the 700 metres. Lay in passing the 150 metres and had to be straightened.

RUNNINGTHEGAUNTLET (L Callaway) – Raced keenly through the middle stages and had to be steadied off heels on a number of occasions.

THE FLAGON (R Beeharry) – Dipped and shifted out passing the 1150 metres momentarily crowding BEAM ME UP SCOTTY which had to steady. Held up early in the run home and then shifted out to find clear racing room passing the 125 metres, bumping with DAD'S BROTHER.

FINBARR (J Lowry) – Held up rounding the final bend and for the majority of the run home and went to the line without being fully tested by its rider.

THE STYLE (T Jonker) – Bounded in the air at the start losing several lengths then raced wide for the remainder of the event. Shifted in abruptly passing the 200 metres when struck with the whip, bumping with COURTE ZARINDI.

BRIEF ENCOUNTER (C Barnes) – Raced wide throughout.

COURTE ZARINDI (T Moseley) – Held up for several strides passing the 300 metres and passing the 200 metres bumped with THE STYLE which shifted inwards at this point. Lay inwards for the majority of the run home.

Race 8 PIONEER TAVERN MAIDEN (1335m)

MAKS LEGEND (S Muniandy) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 900 metres and had to be steadied.

LARUNDEL (S Wynne) – When questioned regarding the performance rider S Wynne advised she was not overly disappointed with the effort considering it was fresh up since September and added in her opinion the gelding would derive benefit from the outing.

MAC MURDOCH (D Bothamley) – Buffeted by inside runners passing the junction near the 1200 metres, then crowded and had to steady when placed in restricted room by MAKS LEGEND which was taken in momentarily by LARUNDEL (S Wynne.) S Wynne was issued with a warning for the manner she shifted ground at this point.

NAPOLEON DYNAMITE (R Beeharry) – Bumped heavily with PORTUMNA LASS as the start was effected. When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer G Tippett advised the win was not totally expected, however the gelding had

performed well when sent back to the trials after attempting to buck at its last start and that, combined with a 4kg claim may have contributed to the better showing today.

PORTUMNA LASS (S Toolooa) – Began awkwardly and bumped heavily with NAPOLEON BONAPARTE as the start was effected, losing ground.

VINO TINTO (T Moseley) – Held up for several strides passing the 200 metres then raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

LEILA EVE (R Firdhaus) – Held up rounding the final bend.

MINNIE PINS (K Kwo) – Crowded and buffeted momentarily, when inside runners shifted out when negotiating the junction near the 1200 metres. Raced wide from the 1000 metres.

Race 9 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1335m)

TAPILIZE (K Kalychurun) – Bounded at the start losing ground.

BURWOOD (K Kwo) – Raced wide throughout. When questioned regarding the performance apprentice rider K Kwo advised that he had been trapped wide throughout and could offer no other tangible explanation.
