RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	GARTSHORE 1200
AQUILIO (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up until approaching the 200 metres.	
BOMBARD (S Spratt) - Raced keenly throughout the early stages.	
THE GREAT SOUTHERN (S Collett) - Passing the 700 metres appeared to go off stride briefly inconveniencing ELECTRODE. Held up early in the final straight.	

ELECTRODE (L Satherley) - Over raced when being restrained in the middle stages. Inconvenienced passing the 700 metres.	
POWER DREAM (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding the performance Jockey M Cameron advised the filly may be feeling the effects of recent racing with Trainer S Marsh advising POWER DREAM would now be spelled.	
Race 2	CLASSIC CUISINE 1200
SALLY LUNN (T Thornton) - Slow away.	
KATIE PERRIE (S Collett) - Began awkwardly losing ground.	
MISS FREELOVE (M Cameron) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide for the majority of the race. When questioned regarding the performance Jockey M Cameron advised that in his opinion the filly would be better suited to more ground. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.	
MOSES (H Marzuki) – Shifted out abruptly shortly after jumping away hampering MONGOLIAN GENERAL. Raced wide without cover throughout.	
MONGOLIAN GENERAL (O Bosson) - Hampered shortly after jumping away losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance Jockey O Bosson advised the colt had never travelled throughout. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.	
MOUNT MIDORIYAMA (M McNab) - Raced in restricted room shortly after jumping away having to be steadied. Contacted passing the 300 metres becoming briefly unbalanced.	
KATIE PERRIE (S Collett) - Shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 300 metres.	
Race 3	SERVCO 1600
MADRUGADA (S Collett) – Began awkwardly shifting in forcing REPLICA in onto FORTALEZA placing that runner in restricted room for a short distance. Hampered 1200 metres. Shifted out abruptly when struck with the whip passing the 150 metres inconveniencing FINE AND DANDEE. When questioned regarding the riding tactics S Collett explained that the mare is reluctant when amongst other runners and when the pace had eased passing the 1200 metres she elected to improve forward to lead. S Collett’s explanation was noted.	
FINE AND DANDEE (M McNab) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Passing the 1200 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of IVY’S COURT which stead off the heels of TUFF GIRL (T Thornton) which had steadied abruptly. As a result FINE AND DANDEE was hampered and shifted out to avoid heels, crowding SHUZURU onto FORTALEZA which was hampered and forced out onto MADRUGADA which was dictated wide onto the track. Steadied as a result was ALIGN THE GALAXY. Rider T Thornton was issued with a warning and advised that she must not steady the pace when to a degree where it puts riders in difficulty. FINE AND DANDEE was held up early in the final straight shifting out approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running. Inconvenienced 150 metres.	
IVY’S COURT (O Bosson) – Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed 1200 metres.	
FORTALEZA (T Harris) – Crowded start. Hampered 1200 metres and shifted out. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.	
SHUZURU (J Fawcett) - Hampered 1200 metres.	
ALIGN THE GALAXY (J Nason) - Had to be steadied 1200 metres.	
Race 4	ALL FROCKED UP GIRLS 2100
MASTER POET (B R Jones) - Began awkwardly shifting in hampering RED JOHN.	

RED JOHN (S Spratt) - Hampered leaving the barrier losing ground. Commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied for a distance in the early stages.

WILIJONMCBRIDE (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly shifting in hampering **HEEZA DREIMER**.

GANGSTERS LASS (T Thornton) - Commenced to over race in the early stages and was then allowed to improve forward to lead passing the 1400 metres.

HEEZA DREIMER (M Cameron) - Hampered leaving the barrier losing ground.

PESO (H Marzuki) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

NOTHING TRIVIAL (O Bosson) - Held up for a distance rounding the final turn obtaining clear running passing the 200 metres.

SAVAPAK (T Harris) - Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres.

DON'T LOOK BACK (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

RUBY ARMANI (M Du Plessis) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

BLUETWENTYTWO (T Abel) – Crowded shortly after jumping away having to be steadied.

SLEEK SECRET (R Elliot) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Crowded 300 metres and briefly unbalanced.

SHELLEZ ACE (J Fawcett) – Shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 300 metres making contact with **SLEEK SECRET** becoming slightly unbalanced. J Fawcett was advised by Stewards that she must exercise greater care when shifting ground.

TERRIFIQUE (T Harris) - When questioned regarding the performance T Harris advised the mare had hung outwards from near the 900 metres and had failed to respond when placed under pressure in the final straight. **TERRIFIQUE** underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed slight lameness in the left hind leg. Connections were advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required for **TERRIFIQUE** prior to racing.

NEALA (A Jones) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SPLURGE (O Bosson) – Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 1100 metres. Briefly raced in restricted room passing the 350 metres to the outside of **DEALS IN HEELS** which hung out when making the bend.

Race 7	STE INDUSTRIAL ELECTRICAL 1400

DON BLANCO (M McNab) – Placed in restricted room shortly after jumping away having to be steadied losing ground.

GETALONGHOME CINDY (R Scott) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

LADY SHABEEL (H Marzuki) - Slow away. Briefly held up entering the final straight.

MAKARIOS (M Du Plessis) – Raced in restricted room passing the 500 metres and then hampered when making brief contact with the running rail. Co-trainer P. Gerard was reminded that blinkers are not to be removed following the race until the horse has returned to the tie up stalls.

A Jones (I'M BRONSON) – Fined \$300 by the Judicial Committee after admitting a breach in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.

V Gatu (ITS A KINDA MAGIC) – Fined \$300 by the Judicial Committee after admitting a breach in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.

Race 8	INTERISLANDER SUMMER FESTIVAL 2 JAN 1600

SASANOF'S HERO (T Abel) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced in restricted room passing the 250 metres to the outside of HAY TIGER which lay out under pressure.

ARRAIGNMENT (T Harris) - Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with UABASSO which became briefly unbalanced. Raced in restricted room passing the 1200 metres.

UABASSO (T Thornton) – Hampered leaving the barriers. Over raced through the early stages.

BREAK MY STRIDE (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly shifting out forcing WOODEN EDGE wider on the track. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. O Bosson advised that the gelding had hung outwards throughout. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.

WOODEN EDGE (H Marzuki) – Hampered start.

MCCULLUM (R Elliot) - Steadied when weakening passing the 150 metres after being crowded between HELLO M'LADY which lay in, and ARRAIGNMENT which shifted out when improving to the outside of TIPTRONIC which shifted out slightly under pressure. Riders T Harris and J Nason were both advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

DALEZINGA (T Wenn) - Became awkwardly placed 150 metres having to briefly steady when laying out across the heels of UABASSO.

HAY TIGER (B R Jones) – Contacted and briefly unbalanced passing the 75 metres by ARRAIGNMENT which had shifted out and away from TIPTRONIC.
