Twelve riders underwent random drug testing which all produced clear results.
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## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>CHEVALIER PRODUCE 2200</b>
<b>BANBURY LAD</b> (J Nason) - Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.	
<b>EL FERNANDO</b> (T Thornton) - Raced wide until being allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader near the 1200 metres, lost the right hind plate during the running.	

**MONGOLIAN LEGEND** (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuses.

**HUSHED** (O Bosson) - Lost the right front plate during the running.

**Race 2**

**CARLTON EVENTS 1600**

**J Riddell** - Fined \$100 under the minor infringement schedule after failing to make the weight for ELANA ROSE being replaced by J Parkes.

**KEEP THE MOMENT** (T Thornton) - Slow away.

**BLUE BREEZE** (T Abel) - Jumped away awkwardly, raced wide throughout running very wide rounding the final turn, Apprentice Abel was shown film footage of her ride in the presence of the riding master.

**MY DAKOTA** (D Johnson) - Hampered leaving the barriers losing ground.

**MADAM MAKFI** (S MacNab) - Rider badly unbalanced when received solid contact near the 1400 metres when OHCEEDEE shifted inwards abruptly after commencing to race ungenerously when being restrained.

**OHCEEDEE** (A Collett) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1400 metres and continued to so for the remainder of the race going off stride near the 450 metres. Trainer S Cole was advised a warning would be placed against the colt for its racing manners. Mr Cole advised that OHCEEDEE was now likely to be gelded.

**MAKFACTOR** (G Cooksley) - Raced three wide without cover.

**Race 3**

**IDEAL ELECTRICAL LEGRAND 1200**

**CINEMATIC** (A Collett) - Began awkwardly losing ground. A request for a ruling was filed with the Judicial Committee who determined that CINEMATIC be declared a non-runner under the provisions of Rule 632(1) after finding the mare to have been denied a fair start due to a starting attendant still holding on to the right rein when the barriers were released. Had to be steadied after improving onto heels near the 1050 metres and shifted outwards hampering GO NICHOLAS.

**YEARN** (T Thornton) - Jumped away awkwardly. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight until near the 200 metres.

**MR KNOWITALL** (B Morgenrood) - Slow away.

**GO NICHOLAS** (M Du Plessis) - Jumped away awkwardly, hampered 1050 metres.

**THE JUSTICE LEAGUE** (O Bosson) - Got its head up and commenced to over-race shortly after the start.

**PUSHKA** (R Scott) - Firmly restrained to avoid the heels of YEARN approaching the 1000 metres, lay out rounding the final bend.

**D Johnson** - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount ROCANTO to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of KITAYA which was hampered and blundered near the 700 metres with the Judicial Committee suspending her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 11 November, up to and including racing on Friday 17 November, 5 national riding days.

**KITAYA** (J Fawcett) - Hampered and blundered near the 700 metres.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>AUCKLAND CO-OP TAXIS 1200</b>
<p><b>MONEY TRAIL</b> (H Marzuki) - Crowded start losing ground, over-raced in the middle stages, held up early in the final straight before angling outwards abruptly then having to be restrained when disappointed for a run passing the 300 metres having to shift outwards across the heels of <b>SPLENDIDO</b> to obtain clear running.</p> <p><b>WAY IN</b> (J Riddell) - Crowded start losing ground, unable to obtain clear running being badly held up for the majority of the final straight before shifting outwards across heels near the 75 metres.</p> <p><b>WONDER WOMAN</b> (D Johnson) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p><b>SPLENDIDO</b> (G Cooksley) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>TREMENDOUS</b> (A Simms) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>GLASS SLIPPER</b> (S Weatherley) - When questioned regarding performance rider was satisfied with the run advising that the mare would derive benefit from the race, lost both front plates during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>JOHN DEERE AGROWQUIP 1600</b>
<p><b>EM KAY POPS</b> (S MacNab) - Slow to begin, steadied 1400 metres when improving onto the heels of <b>TOUCH OF SILVER</b> which shifted outwards when over-racing.</p> <p><b>TOUCH OF SILVER</b> (G Cooksley) - Commenced to over-race when being restrained in the early stages and continued to do so through the middle stages.</p> <p><b>LUEN YAT MIRACLE</b> (J Parkes) - Hampered leaving the barriers losing ground.</p> <p><b>CREATIVE GENIUS</b> (S Weatherley) - Crowded shortly after leaving the barriers by <b>TOUCH OF SILVER</b> which shifted outwards when commencing to over-race.</p> <p><b>DON'T THINK TWICE</b> (S Collett) - Lost the right hind plate during the running.</p> <p><b>SERENITY</b> (M Cameron) - Lost the left hind plate during the running.</p> <p><b>MISS CAMPBELL</b> (R Elliot) - Ran wide rounding the final turn.</p> <p><b>KACHHI</b> (C Lammas) - Struck on the head by R Myers (<b>TICKET TO RIDE</b>) passing the 50 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>CARBINE CLUB TROPHY</b>
<p><b>BOWIE</b> (A Sims) - Required farrier attention to replace the left hind plate prior to the start delaying the race by approximately 5 minutes.</p> <p><b>CRAFTY JESS</b> (H Marzuki) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>ZACADA</b> (M Cameron) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>CAMINO ROCOSO</b> (M Coleman) - Slow away.</p> <p><b>WAIPIPI LAD</b> (S Spratt) - Held up for clear running until near the 300 metres.</p> <p><b>FRANCIS DRAKE</b> (R Elliot) - Had to be steadied when in restricted room over the concluding stages.</p>	

**MAID OF STEEL** (V Colgan) - Eased down from near the 300 metres rider advising the mare had felt indifferent in its action. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which found mild lameness in the right hind leg. Trainer T Pike advised that he would be discussing the mare's future with her owners.

**Race 7** | **ELLERSLIE JEWELLERS & ENGRAVERS 1400**

**TOMELILLA** (M Cameron) - Began awkwardly.

**SKYWEKA** (C Lammas) - Slow away, had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight being held up near the 150 metres before being disappointed for a marginal run to the inside of DIVISE which shifted inwards slightly passing the 100 metres.

**DEVISE** (M Coleman) - Race three wide without cover.

**TOP PROSPECT** (A Collett) - Unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight having to be checked near the 100 metres when attempting to improve into a marginal run which closed.

**TE WAEWAE BAY** (T Thornton) - Crowded passing the 100 metres between CHERRY BAY and TOP PROSPECT.

**CHERRY BAY** (R Myers) - Made contact with TE WAEWAE BAY passing the 100 metres when attempting to improve to the outside of the heels of STACCATO which shifted out slightly under pressure with CHERRY BAY then being held up over the concluding stages.

**CHEEKY BOY** (G Cooksley) - A post-race veterinary examination found the gelding to be lame in the right hind leg with a veterinary certificate of fitness being required prior to racing next.

**Race 8** | **OMF STAKES (Group 3)**

**PROMISE TO REIGN** (D Johnson) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**MIME** (M Coleman) - Steadied 1800 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of SAINT EMILION which was dictated inwards by AUTHENTIC PADDY.

**WAIT A SEC** (J Parkes) - Began awkwardly, briefly placed in restricted room to the inside of SMEDLEY which shifted away from JIAYUGUAN near the 1800 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after getting back the gelding had been unable to make ground and may be better suited to a longer trip. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any apparent abnormality.

**AUTHENTIC PADDY** (J Riddell) - Crowded between CHANCE TO DANCE and MIME over the final 50 metres when both of those runners shifted ground slightly. O Bosson and M Coleman were advised to exercise care. Following the race the connections of the 3<sup>rd</sup> placed horse AUTHENTIC PADDY view Stewards footage alleging interference by the 1<sup>st</sup> placed horse CHANCE TO DANCE and 2<sup>nd</sup> placed horse MIME before electing not to proceed with a protest.

**Race 9** | **BUNNINGS TRADE 1400**

**T Harris** - Fined \$300 by the Judicial Committee after failing to make the weight for TRANSFORMER being replaced by C Lammas.

**IAGO** (O Bosson) - Removed from the barriers after becoming fractious being passed fit to run after undergoing a veterinary inspection.

**VERRY FLASH** (T Thornton) - Began awkwardly and then was hampered, steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of FASION SENSE which lay in passing the 1200 metres.

**FASHION SENSE** (V Colgan) - Blundered leaving the barriers, hampered near the 200 metres when TRANSFORMER ducked outwards when struck with the whip.

**SPECTRA** (M Cameron) - Hampered leaving the barriers.

**OWEN PATRICK** - Hampered leaving the barriers.

**AERO DE PARIS** (M Coleman) - Made contact with the hindquarters of COMMENDED shortly after the start, then racing ungenerously when being steadied.

**ABACUS** (J Riddell) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**DREAM** (A Collett) - Steadied when racing in restricted room between IAGO which shifted outwards to avoid the heels of TRANSFORMER when improving near the 450 metres and ABACUS which was weakening.

**TRANSFORMER** - Held up rounding the final bend near the 450 metres.

**Race 10**

**SCOTT ELECTRICAL 2400**

**MODEL AYE** (A Collett) - Slow to begin, raced in restricted room near the 1200 metres to the inside of SHERIDAN which lay in.

**CLARIFY** (S McKay) - Slow away.

**DELUXE EDITION** (J Fawcett) - Slow away, raced three wide without cover throughout.

**SUGGESTIVE HEIGHTS** (L Satherley) - Held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight.

**STORMY HABIT** - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

**SHERIDAN** (V Colgan) - When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion that the gelding would be better suited by some easing of the ground and may be feeling the effects of recent racing. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.
