RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 OTAGO FARM MACHINERY 1600m

CHELSEA BLUE (C Barnes) – Slow to begin. Made contact with ERIN'S BABE on at least two occasions entering the home straight.

CASTLE (T Moseley) – Slow early.

LITTLE BOSSING (L Callaway) – Held up for a short distance early in the home straight.

ERIN'S BABE (C Campbell) - Lay inwards in the final straight.

OREO (J Morris) – When spoken to regarding the performance of OREO rider J Morris stated the mare was disappointing and may be looking for more distance at this stage of its preparation.

Race 2 CENTRAL CITY CAR PAINTERS 1200m

WIZE ACT (K Williams) – Slow to begin.

SOMETHINGS BURNING (T Jonker) – Keen early stages. Raced wide throughout.

FASCINATE (C Campbell) – Held up early part of the home straight before finding clear running near the 150 metres.

TOMM JONES (S Wahab) – Keen early stages. When spoken to regarding the performance rider S Wahab reported that after racing keenly early the gelding had blown out over the concluding stages in its first up run.

Race 3 RAY AND ALISON KEAN OF SOUTHERN WIDE REAL ESTATE 1600m

GALLANT DEFENDER (S Muniandy) – Very slow to begin losing several lengths. When spoken to regarding the performance rider advised that after losing considerable ground at the start the gelding had too much ground to make up thereafter.

SHAKTI (K Mudhoo) – Keen early.

BRIDGET TOWN (A Morgan) – Not afforded clear running for some distance from the 200 metres until passing the 100 metres.

KING NERO (K Kalychurun) – Rider warned under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) for the use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

Race 4 OTAGO TYRES 1400m

SPANKY (R Cuneen) – Proved difficult to load. Hampered at the start when runners either side shifted ground.

RUNNINGTHEGAUNTLET (L Callaway) – Slow to begin. Crowded and had to steady passing the 800 metres when JANDLES who was racing keenly shifted inwards momentarily at this point.

JAKAYA (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly and got back. Made the bend by the 850 metres awkwardly and had to be steadied. Lay inwards passing the 50 metres.

GRACIOUS LUCK (J Morris) – Keen early.

TURBULENCE (C Campbell) – Race wide throughout.

JANDLES (S Muniandy) – Raced keenly through the middle stages. Crowded and had to steady at 100 metres when JAKAYA who was laying inwards, shifted in when struck with the whip.

K Mudhoo (JAKAYA) admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift inwards near the 100 metres crowding and checking JANDLES with the JCA imposing a suspension of his rider's licence from 12 November to 17 November inclusive (5 national riding days).

Race 5 LIVING CORPORATION 1400m

KING PIN (G Jogoo) – Began awkwardly and was hampered at the start.

GALLANT BOY (J Lowry) – Put its head up when over-racing in the early stages.

SECRET POWER (K Williams) – Put its head up when over-racing in the early stages.

FAIRLIGHT (K Kwo) – Lay out throughout the run home shifting wider on the track.

Race 6 KB CONTRACTORS 1200m

HIHO (C Barnes) – Slow to begin. Made bend at 800 metres awkwardly.

MURRAY (S Muniandy) – Slow to begin. Raced greenly in the early stages and had to be restrained off heels as the pace

steadied passing the 1000 metres. Awkwardly placed on heels passing the 200 metres.

COCEE (M Tanaka) – Raced keenly early.

MOWENNA (K Mudhoo) - Race keenly for several strides passing the 1000 metres.

EL FAMOSO (K Kwo) – Taken forward to lead then steadied the pace of the race passing the 1000 metres. Rider K Kwo was issued with a warning under Rule 638(4) for slowing the pace.

ALWAYS ON CALL (T Moseley) – Raced wide in the early stages. Returned to the Birdcage with blood in one nostril and was the subject of a veterinary examination which revealed a minor abrasion in the nasal passage.

PEGGY STEWART (J Morris) – Keen early stages and had to be steadied off the heels of EDWARD near the 900 metres.

EDWARD (S Wynne) – Crowded passing the 800 metres by COCEE which was racing greenly at this point. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home.

YES YOU DID (K Kalychurun) – Steadied near the 500 metres when improving up onto heels. Rider reported the gelding felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed that its left front shoe had come off and pulled away part of the hoof.

Race 7 CROMBIE LOCKWOOD 1200m

TAIERI GEM (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

BORN A ROYAL (K Kwo) – Raced wide without cover throughout and made the bend by the 800 metres awkwardly inconveniencing DOCKET.

DOCKET (S Wynne) – Raced very wide in the early stages. Inconvenienced near the 850 metres.

ELUSIVE BOXERS (L Hemi) – Under pressure to maintain its position in the field passing the 600 metres and was not persevered with over the concluding stages with the rider reporting it was less than genuine in its efforts today.

MIA MAMMA (S Wahab) – Raced keenly while leading through the early to middle stages. Momentarily buffeted passing the 175 metres when CELTIC CROSS lay inwards at this point.

Race 8 BROCKLEBANKS DRYCLEANERS 1200m

OLYMPIA (S Wynne) – Took charge of its rider during the preliminary galloping for a distance. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was declared fit to start.

CAVALLUCCI (J Morris) – Was slow to begin. Bumped and forced wider passing the 250 metres when GALWAY GARRY shifted out abruptly when shying away from KILLA QUESTION which was improving on its inside.

DAN CUGAT (L Hemi) – Raced wide in the early stages. Rider issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

GALWAY GARRY (K Kwo) – Over-raced in the early stages.

THEM OR US (K Williams) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

MACY (S Muniandy) – Spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use after the winning post.

Race 9 THE WINGATUI FUNCTION CENTRE 1400m

PAW PATROL (J Lowry) – Slow to begin. Held up in the early stages of the home straight and had to be shifted wider on the track near the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

QUEEN SERENE (A Morgan) – Slow to begin. Held up early in the run home and raced in restricted room only gaining clear racing room inside the final 150 metres.

SQUIZZY (J Morris) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Got its head up when being restrained in the early stages.

ENTRÉE (S Wynne) – Raced wide in the early stages.

WHY ME (P Shaikh) – Raced keenly early.

I'M HORACE (L Hemi) – Raced wide early.

MAJIC EL (S Wahab) – Held up in the middle stages of the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 75 metres.

ROAD TO REDEMPTION (D Turner) – Rider issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.
