**J Waddell** – At an adjourned hearing from the above race meeting admitted a charge in that he used the whip excessively on his mount VITTACHI prior to the 100 metres being fined \$300 by the Judicial Committee.

S Collett – Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres on her mount DON'T THINK TWICE.

# Race 1 MAGILLS MEAT 1150

**LECTRIC LEXI** (A Jones) – Slow to begin, raced ungenerously early stages.

## Race 2 LIQUORLAND 1150

**HONNEUR NOIR** (G Cooksley) – Dislodged its rider during the preliminary who was uninjured. After being re-captured HONNEUR NOIR was returned to the start and underwent a veterinary inspection being passed fit to run.

FIREFLY (H Marzuki) - Slow to begin.

**CHOULEE** (T Thornton) – Held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight having to shift ground outwards passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

FABIO (T Harris) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.

**GOLDEN KEY** (S Collett) – Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 200 metres when GROSVENOR BRIDGE (J Waddell) lay inwards before being corrected by its rider. **J Waddell** was advised to exercise care.

**GIRL WITH A CURL** (D Johnson) - Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 200 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuses.

**CULZEAN** (R Elliot) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

### Race 3 NEW ZEALAND FARRIERS ASSOCIATION 1400

LAURAMIA (J Nason) - Slow to begin.

**TUNZAGUTZ** (T Thornton) – Jumped away awkwardly then further hampered when bumped by NEW CROWN which began awkwardly and shifted outwards, raced three wide without cover.

**NEW CROWN** (S Collett) – Jumped away awkwardly, made the final turn awkwardly then unbalanced when receiving solid contact near the 250 metres following which NEW CROWN lay inwards.

**THE HEIRESS** (S McKay) – Held up rounding the final turn making solid contact with NEW CROWN when attempting to obtain clear running then continuing to be held up for a distance.

**ZAPPEUR** (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuses other that in her opinion the mare would be better suited to a shorter distance.

**S McKay** – Issued with a warning after angling his mount THE HEIRESS outwards making solid contact with NEW CROWN which became unbalanced near the 250 metres.

Race 4 VILAGRAD 1400

KAURI COVE (R Elliot) - Slow to begin.

EARLY RISER (J Riddell) – Jumped away awkwardly, raced wide when improving until near the 900 metres.

**DIVINE RANSOM** (S Collett) – Steadied when placed in restricted room between SHOCKOOL and EARLY RISER near the 1200 metres, raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**CAPITAL** (T Thornton) – Held up rounding the final bend until approaching the 250 metres.

Race 5 GOURMET DELICIOUS 1400

**EITILT** (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**ROUGH CONDUCT** (S McKay) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained passing the 1200 metres.

**DEEJAY MAC** (A Collett) – Lay inwards under pressure in the final straight.

**LUCY WYLDSTYLE** (M McNab) – When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse with a post-race veterinary inspection failing to reveal any abnormality.

Race 6 COOPER NAYLOR 1400

THISTLEDONICELY (S Collett) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**SECRET STASH** (J Waddell) – Briefly held up entering the final straight.

**RAINBOW SONG** (M Coleman) – When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse advising that the gelding had failed to respond to his riding once placed under pressure.

ABOVE ALL (J Fawcett) – Lost the right front plate during the running.

**J Waddell** – Fined \$500 by the Judicial Committee for excessive use of the whip on his mount SECRET STASH prior to the 100 metres.

Race 7 CAL ISUZU 1400

**MARISSA** (H Marzuki) – Raced three wide without cover throughout and had a tendency to over-race in the middle stages.

**THE MACALLAN** (V Colgan) – When questioned rider was unable to offer any excuse with a post-race veterinary inspection failing to reveal any obvious abnormality.

**SPRING SHOW** (L Satherley) – Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection revealing a small laceration to right fore pastern.

**L Satherley** – Fined \$500 by the Judicial Committee for excessive use of the whip on her mount SPRING SHOW prior to the 100 metres.

Race 8 CHARMA HEIGHTS 2000

**TOKOROA** (T Thornton) – Slow to begin.

**DEAR DOUGLAS** (L Satherley) – Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.

## Race 9 WAIPA HOME OF CHAMPIONS 2000

SHONALI (H Marzuki) - Slow to begin.

**FORT KNOX** (T Thornton) – The left side winker became detached near the 1800 metres, raced keenly in the early and middle stages when wide without cover.

**DR HANK** (T Harris) – Commenced to over-race near the 1700 metres shifting outwards to avoid heels inconveniencing RU'MAR which was racing keenly.

**RU'MAR** (J Riddell) – Inconvenienced when racing keenly 1700 metres, lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

**ZAPALI** (A Collett) – Steadied when racing in tight quarters being jostled between RU'MAR, which lay in, and DR HANK, which shifted outwards slightly, near the 175 metres.

**H Marzuki** – Suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 11 November until the conclusion of racing on Thursday 23 November 2017, 8 National Days, after admitting a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount SHONALI to shift inwards over the concluding stages forcing SHE'S ALL CLANG inwards crowding ESKIMO KISS which was checked.

**ESKIMO KISS** (V Colgan) – Crowded then checked over the concluding stages.

SHE'S ALL CLANG (D Johnson) – Crowded becoming unbalanced over the concluding stages.

R Elliot – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres on his mount GEORGETHEFIFTH.

# Race 10 MELBOURNE CUP 1580

**NAUGHTY KNUCKLES** (E McCall) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**KEEN TO KEEPER** (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly, hung outwards badly throughout with trainer S Manning being advised that a warning has been placed against the mare for its racing manners.

WEE SONYA (L Satherley) - Hampered shortly after the start when KEEN TO KEEPER shifted outwards when hanging.

**DOUBTLESS PRINCESS** (R Elliot) – Inconvenienced approaching the 100 metres when NEK MINNIT shifted inwards.

**KEEP UP** (S Collett) – Has a tendency to lay inwards under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing FOUR DEGREES just short of the finish.

**FOUR DEGREES** (M McNab) – Inconvenienced just short of the finish.
