RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 ONE GOOD HORSE AT AVONHEAD TAVERN PREMIER (1200m)

ON POINT (S Wynne) - Slow to begin.

MOWENNA (K Cowan) - Began awkwardly.

PINUP COUP (M Cameron) - Slow to begin.

TROY BOY (L Hemi) - Slow to begin.

K Gundowry - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount AQUAZURRA to shift inwards shortly after the start when not sufficiently clear of FREE AND EASY which was checked with CARDRONA also being hampered. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended Mr Gundowry's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 18 November until the conclusion of racing on Thursday 30 November, 7 National days.

FREE AND EASY (T Moseley) - Checked shortly after the start.

CARDRONA (S Collett) - Hampered shortly after the start.

SMOKE 'EM WILSON (A Morgan) - Over raced in the early stages, steadied off heels near the 500 metres

TUSSOCK (C Lammas) - Raced wide throughout.

PER FORM (C Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no tangible excuses.

Race 2 PERFECT PACKAGING PREMIER (1600m)

CASTLE (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly shifting outwards making firm contact with ZENTESSA and lost ground as a result, crowded having to be firmly restrained passing the 1400 metres losing ground.

ZENTESSA (S Collett) - Bumped heavily at the start and lost ground, lay in away from PRODUCER (J Lowry) when that runner shifted inwards near the 1400 metres, raced ungenerously when being restrained passing the 1000 metres then being checked when LADY BYRON shifted inwards to avoid the heels of PRODUCER which made the bend awkwardly when being restrained dropping back onto PRODUCER abruptly, held up and had to be steadied off heels passing the 150 metres.

J Lowry - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount PRODUCER to shift inwards when not fully clear of ZENTESSA near the 1400 metres with ZENTESSA then laying inwards crowding CASTLE which had to be firmly restrained losing ground.

PAMIR (R Firdhaus) - Bumped shortly after the start.

SULCIFERA (M Du Plessis) - Raced wide throughout.

K Gundowry - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres on his mount LADY BYRON.

Race 3 FARMERS MILL PREMIER (2000m)

NASHVILLE (K Cowan) - Slow to begin.

EVA JENSINE (R Myers) - Had a tendency to lay out in the final straight.

LOCHAN ORA (C Campbell) - Held up until passing the 200 metres.

Race 4 NZB READY TO RUN SALE PREMIER (1400m)

SAVVY COUP (C Johnson) - Got its head up when over racing near the 1000 metres.

BENEFICIAL (K Kwo) - Raced wide throughout.

DARK POPPY (J Morris) - Got its head up when being steadied going into the bend near the 1000 metres with HUNTER VILLAIN then having to be firmly restrained when improving onto the heels of DARK POPPY.

HUNTER VILLAIN (K Cowan) - Firmly restrained to avoid heels 1000 metres, briefly steadied to shift outwards across the heels of DARK POPPY to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.

COURTE ZARINDI (T Moseley) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home.

STARMAKER (A Collett) - When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion that the filly would be better suited by some easing of the ground and a shorter distance. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 5 BIDFOOD BUTCHERY PREMIER (1400m)

RICHIE ROX (K Cowan) - Blundered at the start and slow away, over raced in the early stages, gave ground from the 600 metres. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality other than a slow rate of recovery.

KING PIN (G Jogoo) - Raced keenly through the middle stages.

KOLONEL KEV (S Weatherley) - Made contact with ASTRID when shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 400 metres. S Weatherley was advised to exercise care.

ASTRID (C Lammas) - Bumped 400 metres.

Race 6 VALACHI DOWNS CANTERBURY BREEDERS STAKES (1400m)

MORSE CODE (D Weatherley) - Declared a late scratching at 2.54 pm after escaping riderless under the barriers and galloping a circuit of the course. The start was delayed approximately 10 minutes as a result.

CANTILENA (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin, over raced in the middle stages and became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 900 metres being steadied and shifting outwards hampering LAAFFAIRE which was forced over extra ground.

LAAFFAIRE (K Williams) - Slow to begin, hampered and forced over extra ground 900 metres.

RIDEITLIKEUSTOLEIT (J Morris) - Slow to begin.

LA FILLE EN JEU (L Hemi) - Raced wide in the early stages.

ZAWHIP (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early stages, had to be steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of CARAMAC (D Hirini) near the 250 metres. **D Hirini** was issued with a warning.

TWOZNOTENOUGH (A Collett) - Raced wide for the majority of the event.

BELLA COURT (S Collett) - Held up in the early part of the run home and raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 300 metres, crowded for a distance passing the 200 metres when ZAWHIP shifted outwards. **C Johnson** was issued with a warning.

OUR ABBADEAN (C Lammas) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuses. A post race veterinary inspection revealed the mare to be suffering from cardiac arrhythmia with the appropriate veterinary clearance now required prior to racing next.

Race 7 HALLS REFRIGERATED TRANSPORT (2000m)

The start was officially delayed until 3.34 pm on TAB request.

DUPLICITY (S Collett) - Blundered leaving the barriers and slow away as a result.

FERGIE (C Campbell) - Slow to begin, steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of SHEZATOUCHA which shifted outwards slightly rounding the turn passing the 450 metres with FERGIE then making contact with SHAKTI which had to be steadied to avoid the heels of GARFUNKEL.

WAGNER (S Wynne) - Raced keenly through the early to middle stages.

GARFUNKEL (A Collett) - Raced three wide without cover throughout and had a tendency to over race.

NOTHING TRIVIAL (S Weatherley) - Briefly held up entering the final straight.

SHAKTI (D Bothamley) - Steadied to avoid heels passing the 450 metres.

Race 8 LINDAUER STEWARDS STAKES HANDICAP (1200m)

The start was officially delayed until 4.08 pm on TAB request.

BATMAN (M Du Plessis) - Raced wide throughout.

DON CARLO (K Williams) - Lay outwards passing the junction at the 600 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse other than the gelding possibly not having backed up from Saturday.

R Cuneen - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount SIGNIFY to shift outwards passing the 500 metres when not sufficiently clear of PASSITO which was crowded and checked, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 18 November until the conclusion of racing on Friday 1 December, 8 National days.

PASSITO (S Weatherley) - Crowded and checked passing the 500 metres.

Race 9 AMICUS INSURANCE BROKERS PREMIER (1600m)

NESTA (C Johnson) - Proved difficult to load, over-raced in the early to middle stages.

PRAWN STAR (S MacNab) - Crowded leaving the barriers, held up rounding the final turn continuing to have some difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

ADVENT (A Collett) - Blundered jumping away.

PYJAMARAMA (J Morris) - Steadied near the 1500 metres, saddle shifted forward passing the 1000 metres placing the rider in difficulty for the remainder of the race and running wide rounding the final turn.

SENSIBILITY (T Moseley) - Over raced when being restrained near the 1000 metres, crowded just short of the finish.

RAVENHILL (D Hirini) - Had to be steadied to avoid the heels of OUR ROYAL which shifted outwards when being steadied near the 700 metres, hampered when forced wide by PYJAMARAMA rounding the bend passing the 500 metres.

NAKURU (M Cameron) - Held up early in the final straight and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.

RED RIVER ROCK (R Myers) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 150 metres.

QUAINTRELLE (K Gundowry) - Held up until passing the 300 metres.

LEULUAI (T Jonker) - Made contact with NESTA when attempting a marginal run to the inside of that runner near the 100 metres, crowded between LOS CABOS and NESTA just short of the finish.

Race 10 13th COUPLAND'S BAKERIES MILE (1600m)

RINGO (L Innes) - Slow to begin, when questioned regarding performance rider reported that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

BENZINI (K Cowan) - Slow to begin, inconvenienced approaching 100 metres.

LA DIOSA (R Cuneen) - Raced three wide without cover until near the 800 metres, inconvenienced near the 125 metres when BEEFEATER shifted ground under pressure after being taken out by SHADOWS CAST.

SON OF MAHER (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

TOMMY TUCKER (J Lowry) - Had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of LA DIOSA approaching the 100 metres and shifted outwards inconveniencing BENZINI.

A Collett - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount SHADOWS CAST to shift outwards over the concluding stages when not sufficiently clear of BEEFEATER which was checked. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 18 November until the conclusion of racing on Sunday 3 December, 10 National days and in addition imposed a fine of \$700.

BEEFEATER (S Collett) - Checked concluding stages.

A Collett - Admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$600.

S Wynne - Admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres on her mount BOOTS 'N' ALL with the Judicial Committee suspending her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 18 November until the conclusion of racing on Thursday 30 November, 7 National days.

Race 11 ROMANO'S PIZZAS PREMIER (2500m(

KINGTIDE (T Moseley) - Began very awkwardly losing ground, over raced through the early and middle stages, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that after over racing following its poor beginning had failed to finish the race off.

HELL BOUND (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly shifting outwards crowding PICKUP and SEBRING DRAGON.

PICKUP (S Muniandy) - Crowded start.

SEBRING DRAGON (T Jonker) - Crowded start, raced wide in the early stages.

KATIEM MARIE (R Myers) - Hampered passing the 400 metres when HELL BOUND shifted inwards.
