# **RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1 PRECAST CONCRETE MANAWATU MAIDEN (1400 metres)
SUFFIGN (A Shin) – Awkwardly away.

**PLAY THE FIELD** (M Singh) – Began awkwardly, raced keenly in the early stages.

**PENTICOUP** (J Parkes) – Raced keenly in the middle stages having to be restrained off heels passing the 600 metres. Bumped with ROCK RULZ when obtaining a run to the inside passing the 300 metres. When questioned, J Parkes had no excuses.

**BLUE RATA ANNA** (A Collett) – Held up passing the 300 metres, having to be angled inwards to gain clear running near the 150 metres.

**MINI COOPA** (S Collett) - Held up behind the tiring WHAT THE DEUCE passing the 400 metres having to be angled outwards to gain clear running passing the 300 metres.

**ROCK RULZ** (H Andrew) – Began awkwardly bumping with HERBIE HANKOCK. Three wide without cover throughout. Bumped 300 metres. Lay inwards in the home straight.

**HERBIE HANKOCK** (D Turner) – Bumped start. Held up for a distance passing the 500 metres.

**TAUTU** (M Du Plessis) – Held up approaching the 500 metres gaining clear running passing the 250 metres.

**WHAT THE DEUCE** (R Elliot) – Dropped out quickly prior to entering the home straight after leading throughout and finished some distance last. R Elliot had no excuse. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

**H Andrew** (ROCK RULZ) and **L Hemi** (RIP INTO GHIA) were spoken to with regard to the manner in which they used their whips prior to the 100 metres.

Track upgraded to Good (3) retrospective to Race 1.

#### Race 2 ALTHERM WINDOW SYSTEMS 3YO MAIDEN (1200 metres)

**EUGENIE JOY** (D Hirini) - Bumped and dictated inwards on to LA TURQUE when MAGICO began awkwardly. Rider reported the filly had raced greenly throughout.

**CHAMPAGNE BRIDE** (C Johnson) – Slow away. Hung off the track approaching the 600 metres. Rider reported the filly had raced greenly throughout.

LINCOLN RAIDER (D Turner) – Raced greenly throughout. Lay out in the home straight. Bumped near 100 metres.

**LA TURQUE** (M Coleman) – Had to be restrained when racing in restricted room to the inside of COLLINSTREET (J Riddell) which shifted in near the 100 metres when not clear and subsequently jostled with LINCOLN RAIDER. After questioning riders, J Riddell was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d). Stewards took into account the tendency of LINCOLN RAIDER to lay out when assessing the degree of interference to LA TURQUE.

### Race 3 F&R INSULATION PANELS LIMITED HANDICAP (1200 metres)

MIGHTY SOLOMON (R Myers) - Bumped with SHADOW FOX at start.

**SHADOW FOX** (J Parkes) – Bumped at start.

**DARCI MAC** (R Elliot) – Awkwardly away settling back. Lay out early in the home straight. Briefly inconvenienced passing the 100 metres when MIGHTY SOLOMON lay in.

YEMANYA (A Shin) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages making the bend awkwardly passing the 800 metres.

#### Race 4 GREAVES ELECTRICAL SERVICE MAIDEN (1400 metres)

**BOY SOLDIER** (M McNelis) – Began awkwardly then over-raced in the early and middle stages and improved rapidly into a marginal run near the 1000 metres despite the rider's attempts to restrain it. This resulted in ROCKONEVE having to be steadied and in turn bumped with RED RED ROBIN. BOY SOLDIER continued to over-race throughout. Connections will be advised a warning is placed against the racing manners of BOY SOLDIER

**HEINEKEN ROCKS** (H Andrew) – Three wide without cover throughout.

**BELLE CANTO** (R Myers) – Disappointed finishing well back. R Myers had no excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate. R Bergerson was asked to report the mare's progress over coming days.

THATS AMORE (M Singh) -Momentarily steadied near the 250 metres when there was insufficient room to improve.

#### Race 5 MARTIN BEVERIDGE PAINTERS HANDICAP (1200 metres)

**THATZ LOUIE** (C Johnson) —Over-raced and hung throughout, dictated wide at the 800 metres.

**SON OF SURF** (D Hirini) – Hung outwards badly near the 800 metres dictating AWATANE, JET CHARGED and THATZ LOUIE very wide on the track.

AWATANE (J Riddell) - Dictated wide near the 800 metres.

JET CHARGED (D Bradley) – Dictated wide near the 800 metres.

**BRAKBAR** (L Hemi) – Held up for a short distance approaching the 300 metres. Brushed with JET CHARGED near the 100 metres.

**DIVINE POWER** (H Andrew) - Shifted in under pressure near the 100 metres and had to be straightened.

#### Race 6 PATTON ENGINEERING HANDICAP (2100 metres)

**PURE LORDE** (S Collett) – Underwent a veterinary examination and was cleared to start after becoming fractious in the gates. When questioned, rider advised the mare may prefer any easing in the track. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormalities.

THORN PASS (A Collett) - Slow away.

**ANIMATOR** (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly. Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

KAIRANGA LAD (M Singh) – Began awkwardly. Was obliged to improve very wide passing the 600 metres.

**OPHELIA LEE** (M DuPlessis) – Over-raced passing the 2000 metres. Continued to over-race through the middle stages.

**LIGHT EM UP** (R Myers) – Raced three wide without cover in the early stages before being restrained to trail approaching the 1200 metres.

#### Race 7 HUMPHRIES CONSTRUCTION HANDICAP (1500 metres)

**DRAMATIST** (S Collett) – Race three wide without cover throughout. Rider reported the mare hung throughout.

**EFFECTAV** (M Tanaka) – Slow away.

**RISING SHOT** (M Du Plessis) – Held up for a short distance from the 600 metres.

#### Race 8 HOTCHILLY HANDICAP (1400 metres)

**NICOLETTA** (M Coleman) – Blundered at the start. When questioned rider advised the mare may prefer easing in the track. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormalities.

MISSY MOO (A Collett) – Awkwardly away, settling back. Finished last, rider had no excuse.

**GOBUYIT** (K Cowan) – Over-raced in the early stages, having to be restrained for some distance.

**CLASSIC TOUCH** (M Cameron) – Held up and unable to improve from the 400 metres, having to be angled outwards across heels to gain clear running approaching the 100 metres.

**TINKALICIOUS** (M Tanaka) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**H Andrew** (LORD ERNESTO) – H Andrew was issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) for the manner in which she used her whip prior to the 100 metres.

# Race 9 MCINTOSH FARM MACHINERY & CRANES HANDICAP (1550 metres)

**ROC 'N' IT** (D Turner) – Slow to begin then tailed off in the early stages. D Turner reported the gelding may be better suited to more rain affected going. Trainer L Latta advised the gelding would be spelled.

**BATCHELOR BABE** (A Chan) – Began awkwardly bumping with THE RIPPA.

THE RIPPA (M Tanaka) – Bumped at start.

**MONSIEUR** (C Johnson) – Raced erratically from near the 800 metres and commenced to give ground rapidly, causing ADONIS to be steadied abruptly near the 700 metres and again approaching the 400 metres. Also inconvenienced was OUTSTANDING. When questioned into the performance C Johnson advised the gelding may prefer more rain affected footing.

**ADONIS** (M Singh) – Tightened near the 1000 metres when MONSIEUR (C Johnson) crossed to the lead. After questioning rider C Johnson was advised to exercise greater care. Held up behind tiring runner from the 800 to the 400 metres.

HANK MOODY (A Shin) – Held up in the home straight and unable to improve until near the 100 metres.

**OUTSTANDING** (M Du Plessis) – Raced in restricted room over the final stages.
