Race 1	MILLS REEF HANDICAP
<p>DELUXE EDITION (C Lammas) – Crowded start. Lost the off fore plate.</p> <p>ST SATURNIN (T Thornton) – Slow away.</p> <p>DUKE OF MILLFIELD (C Dell) – Crowded shortly after the start and had to be steadied to the inside of DIESEL (M Du Plessis) which shifted in when not fully clear. As a result DUKE OF MILLFIELD shifted in crowding BROOKBARS onto HESALLJAZZ which was steadied. M Du Plessis was issued with a warning.</p> <p>DONTBREAKMYHEART (J Nason) – Raced wide early stages.</p> <p>DIESEL (M Du Plessis) – Raced wide without cover in the early to middle stages. Raced in restricted room approaching the 400 metres between having to briefly steady.</p> <p>HESALLJAZZ (J Parkes) – Crowded start. Briefly steadied passing the 200 metres when awkwardly placed.</p> <p>KEEP UP (S Collett) - Lay in when placed under pressure making contact with QUINTESENTIALLY approaching the 100 metres</p> <p>QUINTESENTIALLY (J Riddell) - Briefly contacted approaching the 100 metres.</p> <p>SUGGESTIVE HEIGHTS (L Satherley) – When questioned regarding the performance, rider L Satherley advised that the mare was feeling the effects of the improved track conditions.</p>	
Race 2	O’CONNOR WARREN INSURANCE BROKERS MAIDEN
<p>REBEL REBEL (J Nason) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly passing the 1200 making having to be restrained off heels.</p> <p>ON THE ROCKS (J Bayliss) – Had to shift out off heels passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>HEAD RUSH (H Andrew) – Had to change ground passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.</p>	
Race 3	FERCO 3YO
<p>DEMONETIZATION (J Waddell) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>SMOKIN’ OAK (J Riddell) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in early stages. Lay in under pressure in the final straight making contact with XBOX approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p>SHADOW DANCER (S Collett) – Lay out approaching the 350 metres making contact with KAPOOR which became briefly unbalanced. Rider S Collett advised that the mare may be feeling the effects of the improved track conditions.</p> <p>KAPOOR (D Prastiyou) – Bumped and unbalanced 350 metres.</p> <p>MULANCHI (V Colgan) – Had to be restrained when being improving onto heels passing the 700 metres.</p> <p>XBOX (M Coleman) – Was held up rounding the final turn and early in the final straight obtaining clear running approaching the 300 metres. Briefly contacted 200 metres.</p> <p>L Satherley (LADY ROSSA) – Admitted a breach in that she failed to ride out to the end of the race when there was a reasonable chance of LADY ROSSA finishing in 5th position (finished 6th) with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$200.</p>	

Race 4	PRESTON ROWE PATERSON PROPERTY VALUERS HANDICAP
<p>MAHALO (M Coleman) – Jumped awkwardly.</p> <p>PRECISION MISS (S Collett) - Slow away and hampered shortly after losing ground.</p> <p>DE NIRO (S McKay) – Hampered leaving the barrier. Held up rounding the final turn and attempted to shift out approaching the 300 metres making heavy contact with SABER. DE NIRO was then held up and shifted in to obtain clear running with BRIGHTON improving onto that runners heels and held up as a result. S McKay was issued with a warning.</p> <p>SABER (T Thornton) – Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages. Heavily contacted 300 metres.</p> <p>BRIGHTON (M McNab) – Hampered leaving the barrier. Held up passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>SELFIE (J Waddell) – Hampered leaving the barrier. Held up and could not obtain clear running until near the 200 metres.</p> <p>A Sims (MR KNOWITALL) – Admitted a breach in that she used her whip in an excessive manner prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee suspending her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 25 November 2017 up to and including racing on the 3 December 2017, 6 national riding days.</p>	
Race 5	DOMINATOR GARAGE DOORS TAURANGA HANDICAP
<p>J Waddell – Was unable to make the contracted weight for RED SKY AT NIGHT and was fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule. J Waddell was replaced by S Collett.</p> <p>NAUGHTY KNUCKLES (M Hills) – Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground.</p> <p>RED SKY AT NIGHT (S Collett) – Shifted out off heels passing the 1000 metres racing wide for the remainder.</p> <p>VIKTOR VEGAS (J Bayliss) – Returned to the enclosure with a twisted near hind plate. A post-race veterinary examination revealed lameness in the near hind as a result of the plate shifting.</p>	
Race 6	GARTHSHORE TAURANGA STAKES
<p>RONCHI (G Cooksley) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.</p> <p>KAWI (J Waddell) – Slow away. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight and then had to change ground passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>MISS WILSON (J Riddell) - Raced keenly when the pace steadied approaching the 1000 metres. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>STOLEN DANCE (M Coleman) - Raced in restricted room approaching the 400 metres briefly going off stride.</p>	
Race 7	CHESTERS PLUMBING & BATHROOM HANDICAP
<p>SNAPSHOT (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Hampered approaching the 100 metres.</p> <p>D Prastiyou (NATUZZI) – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he allowed NATUZZI to shift in when not clear of SNAPSHOT which was hampered near the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 21 November up to and including racing on 1 December 2017, 7 national riding days</p> <p>TEMPLE TIGER (M Hills) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Crowded passing the 300 metres by SNAPSHOT (C Lammas) which shifted out under pressure. C Lammas was issued with a warning and advised he must correct his mounts when they are shifting ground.</p> <p>SPLURGE (M McNab) – Had to be restrained off heels passing the 1100 metres.</p>	

Race 8	DEVAN PLASTICS HANDICAP
<p>RODMAR (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly and was crowded shortly after having to be steadied.</p> <p>LUEN YAT MIRACLE (J Nason) – Raced wide without cover from near the 800 metres and lay out final bend.</p> <p>GRAND SOLEIL (V Colgan) – Shifted out passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>OUTSIDER (A Jones) – Raced in restricted room passing the 250 metres between LUEN YAT MIRACLE which shifted out slightly and MARSHAL which shifted in and away from LA FOI before being corrected by its rider.</p> <p>H Andrew (THE BANDITO) - Admitted a breach in that she used her whip in an excessive manner prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee suspending her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 19 November 2017 up to and including racing on the 29 November 2017, 6 national riding days.</p>
