GENERAL:

All riders were work place alcohol tested with clear results.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 MAJESTIC HORSE FLOATS PREMIER (2000m)

KEEP THE LOT (G Jogoo) - Declared a late scratching at 11.06am behind the barriers on veterinary advice as it was found to have blood present in the left nostril. A post race endoscopic examination confirmed the mare not to be a bleeder with the blood likely to be from an upper airway inflammation after suffering from an allergy issue requiring treatment.

SHOCKTILLYOUDROP (S Wynne) - Slow to begin.

OPIHI JADE (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin, steadied passing the 800 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

LINDIS PASS (L Hemi) - Raced wide without cover until improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 1100 metres.

PICKUP (S Muniandy) - Raced keenly through the middle stages, inconvenienced over the final 125 metres.

TRAVEL WISE (T Jonker) - Hung outwards badly in the final straight and was unable to be fully ridden out inconveniencing PICK UP over the final 125 metres.

DUPLICITY (D Johnson) - Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 600 metres, held up over the concluding stages.

SLAMMER (J Lowry) - Held up passing the 500 metres and was unable to obtain clear running until shifting outwards across heels near the 250 metres.

S Spratt (I'LLAV BUBBLES) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift outwards crowding SAVANNAH GEM near the 200 metres, with Stewards also taking into account some slight inward movement from KATIEM MARIE contributing to the incident.

SAVANNAH GEM (K Kwo) - Steadied when crowded near the 200 metres.

Race 2 THE RECRUITMENT NETWORK PREMIER (1400m)

BUSHIDO (C Johnson) - Knuckled leaving the barriers.

WESLEY HALL (K Gundowry) - Slow to begin.

DIORISSIMO (A Collett) - Slow to begin after blundering on jumping.

CHIC (R Myers) - Got its head up when over racing in the early to middle stages.

PRINCE RANSOM (BB Hong) - Raced three wide without cover from the 700 metres.

Race 3 SOTHYS PREMIER (2500m)

STANDREWS MASONIC (K Cowan) - Began awkwardly, briefly crowded shortly after the start, held up early in the final straight and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 100 metres.

EVA JENSINE (R Myers) - Had a tendency to over race in the middle stages.

DEE AND GEE (T Jonker) - Made contact with SHANTAV when shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 450 metres.

SHANTAV (C Barnes) - Bumped 450 metres.

WHERE ARE YOU (D Johnson) - Required veterinary treatment post race when found to be severely lame in the right foreleg with a veterinary certificate of fitness now required prior to racing again.

Race 4 CASHMERE ESTATE - LIVE WITHOUT COMPROMISE PREMIER (1800m)

SHADOW KING (R Myers) - Slow to begin.

WHO DARES WINS (S Wynne) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

TIMY TYLER (C Campbell) - Raced keenly in the early stages, had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

KINGS PAL (L Innes) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

NO EMOTION (M Cameron) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1600 metres.

FLAG THE GROOM (O Bosson) - Raced in restricted room early in the final straight.

SACRED EMPIRE (S Weatherley) - Held up when disappointed for a run between SANASAR and IRISH CALL near the 350 metres before obtaining clear running passing the 200 metres.

NIGHT NURSE (K Gundowry) - Held up and unable to obtain clear running in the final straight until near the 100 metres.

S Wynne - Spoken to regarding her whip use in the final straight.

Race 5 VERM

VERNON & VAZEY TRUCK PARTS PREMIER (1400m)

KING PIN (G Jogoo) - Declared a late scratching at 1.25 pm after escaping riderless underneath the front gate of its stalling stall after being fractious. Trainer S McKay was advised that the gelding must barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.

DYNAMIC (P Shaikh) - Blundered jumping away, checked when severely hampered by BATMAN shortly after the start, crowded for room passing the 1100 metres and had to steady when THOUGHT THAT was taken in by FLYING IBIS (C Johnson). C Johnson was advised to exercise care.

FAIRLIGHT (S Weatherley) - Knuckled when leaving the barriers.

BATMAN (K Kwo) - Commenced to buck shortly after leaving the barriers making contact with VOLCANO and severely hampering DYNAMIC, continued to buck for a distance becoming tailed off and losing all chance. Trainer N Ridley was advised that the gelding must trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.

VOLCANO (T Jonker) - Bumped shortly after the start, over raced in the middle stages.

THOUGHT THAT (S Wynne) - Commenced to over race passing the 1000 metres and had to be severely restrained to avoid the heels of WILLIAM WALLACE near the 900 metres.

WILLIAM WALLACE (R Myers) - Commenced to over race when being restrained near the 900 metres.

Race 6BARNESWOOD FARM WELCOME STAKES (1000m)DREAMTESTA (R Cuneen) - Proved difficult to load into the barriers, inconvenienced 150 metres.

PATSYS LASS (T Moseley) - Had a tendency to lay out under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing DREAMTESTA near the 150 metres.

Race 7 LAMING RACING PREMIER (1200m)

NOWHERE MAN (K Gundowry) - Reared at the start losing considerable ground. Rider was questioned regarding his riding tactics after failing to show any vigour in an attempt to make up the lost ground including a lack of urgency early in the final straight. K Gundowry advised that he had been reluctant to ride his mount along early after its poor beginning given the strong pace of the race opting to save the gelding in an attempt to finish off the race similar to when winning on the first day of the meeting also adding that the gelding had hung inwards in the final straight. Mr Gundowry was advised that in the Stewards view he had erred in not showing more urgency in his riding particularly entering the final straight and that in future he would be expected to ride his mounts in a manner which is not left open to query.

MIRA (A Morgan) - Slow to begin, hampered passing the 400 metres.

STROWAN (R Cuneen) - Raced wide throughout.

MR TYPHON (BB Hong) - Shifted outwards to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres hampering MIRA. **BB Hong** was issued with a warning. Shifted inwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

MIA MAMMA (C Johnson) - Gave ground over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 8 GAVELHOUSE.COM NEW ZEALAND 1000 GUINEAS (1600m)

PROM QUEEN (A Collett) - Blundered at the start and shifted outwards crowding DIJON BLEU. When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion that the filly may not have seen out the 1600 metre distance. Co-trainer K Rae was spoken to in relation to comments made in a post race interview regarding PROM QUEEN's fitness leading into today's race. Mr Rae advised that bloods had been taken from the filly on Thursday with test results being clear. Mr Rae further advised that he had developed concerns with the environment in which the filly was stabled and elected to change her stabling location for the last two days but had been happy with her condition going into today's race. After reviewing the Trackside interview and considering the explanation of Mr Rae no further action was considered necessary. A post race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality other than a slow rate of recovery consistent with the filly having had a hard race.

CONTESSA VANESSA (C Johnson) - Slow to begin, raced keenly in the early stages, hampered 250 metres.

LUBAYA (R Myers) - Slow to begin then further hampered by HOT FUSS which began awkwardly shifting outwards.

HOT FUSS (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly, hampered 250 metres, had to shift ground to the inside of the tiring MALAMBO near the 150 metres.

DIJON BLEU (L Innes) - Crowded start, hampered 1300 metres, steadied passing the 1000 metres when improving onto heels.

AKOYA PEARL (S Weatherley) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages, briefly steadied to avoid the heels of HASAHALO which shifted outwards to obtain clear running near the 400 metres. S Spratt was advised to exercise care.

THE SPARKLE (S Muniandy) - Commenced to over race for a distance near the 1200 metres having to be restrained off heels passing the 1000 metres, inconvenienced having to shift ground near the 100 metres when DIJON BLEU shifted outwards under pressure.

S Muniandy (THE SPARKLE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards near the 1300 metres dictating MAHIDUN inwards causing THE LUSTRE to check and DIJON BLEU to steady, with the Judicial Committee suspending S Muniandy's licence to ride at race meetings from the conclusion of racing today Saturday 18 November until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 6 December, 11 National days.

THE LUSTRE (J Lowry) - Checked 1300 metres.

S Muniandy (THE SPARKLE) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards under pressure when not fully clear of HOT FUSS and CONTESSA VANESSA near the 250 metres.

S Wynne (HOT FUSS) - Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 9 AVON CITY FORD WUHAN JOCKEY CLUB TROPHY PREMIER (1400m)

HEE'S OUR SECRET (T Harris) - Slow to begin, raced wide throughout.

LADY AMADEUS (O Bosson) - Blundered badly at the start and then shifted inwards further hampering GALWAY GARRY which had lost its footing on jumping.

GALWAY GARRY (C Campbell) - Lost footing start then further hampered.

CANTILENA (S Weatherley) - Over raced when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.

HOVER (R Cuneen) - Steadied for a distance when placed in restricted room near the 1000 metres to the inside of GALWAY GARRY which shifted away from FULLY PUMPED which lay in, lost both front plates during the running.

BRUEGEL (R Firdhaus) - Raced three wide without cover.

IT'S PANDEMONIUM (L Innes) - Was unable to obtain clear running in the final straight.

SACRED DESIRE (D Johnson) - Briefly held up approaching the 200 metres having to shift inwards across heels to obtain clear running.

DEEDEE PANACHE (R Myers) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.

Race 10 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO 154TH NEW ZEALANFD CUP (3200m)

IMPERIUM (M Cameron) - Crowded at the start and got back.

ZENTANGLE (R Myers) - Over raced in the early stages.

SAMPSON (R Jones) - Crowded passing the 1100 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of PENTATHLON (T Harris). T Harris was advised to exercise care.

SUREASYOUWEREBORN (T Moseley) - Gave ground quickly from the 1000 metres and was not persevered with finishing a distant last. A post race veterinary inspection found the mare to be suffering from cardiac arrhythmia, with the connections advised that the appropriate veterinary clearance is required prior to racing next.

GOBSTOPPER (S Spratt) - Lay out under pressure in the final straight.

Race 11

WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS PREMIER (2000m)

Payment of dividends was withheld until rider C Campbell (SIR ED) confirmed that his chances had not been affected after a starter's assistant who was in the process of clearing the barriers was positioned to the front of the barrier of SIR ED when the field was released. An inquiry was opened and adjourned into this incident.

LARRIKIN (K Williams) - Slow to begin.

C Campbell (SIR ED) - Dropped his whip near the 400 metres.

SWEET INDULGENCE (A Collett) - Was not persevered with in the final straight with the rider reporting that the mare had felt indifferent in its action. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 12 SPEIGHT'S PREMIER (1600m)

TIFFANY'S TIME (M Cameron) - Lost its footing and blundered badly at the start.

PINSRAAD (R Jones) - Lost its footing and blundered badly at the start.

RESIDENTIAL (G Jogoo) - Blundered shortly after jumping away.

ONEMOREWHISKEY (A Collett) - Began awkwardly then being buffeted between runners before having to be further steadied when crowded shortly after.

J Lowry (RAISE YOU TEN) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards shortly after the start applying pressure to NOT AVAILABLE which was inclined to lay away from that runner, crowding RESIDENTIAL onto BRIDGETTE TOWN.

RESIDENTIAL (G Jogoo) - Crowded shortly after the start.

BRIDGET TOWN (A Morgan) - Crowded shortly after the start.

STONEMASON (K Williams) - Raced three wide without cover.
