RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	RIVERMONTE PARK 1150
<p>FASTELLIE (J Nason) – Over raced when being restrained in the early and middle stages shifting back onto LEAF passing the 800 metres which dropped back onto MEGAPOWER. Held up until near the 200 metres and when shifting out off heels to obtain clear running inconvenienced HOLD SWAY and PICTURE THIS. J Nason was issued with a warning.</p> <p>LEAF (A Jones) – Steadied off heels near the 800 metres losing ground.</p> <p>PICTURE THIS (J Bayliss) – Inconvenienced 200 metres.</p> <p>HOLD SWAY (C Lammas) – Inconvenienced 200 metres.</p> <p>MEGAPOWER (S Weatherley) – Had to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 800 metres and then made the bend near the 600 metres awkwardly running wide forcing MASTAPLAZA over extra ground.</p> <p>MASTAPLAZA (M Coleman) – Forced wider 600 metres.</p>	
Race 2	GROUNDSPREAD LTD 1150
<p>TARINGAMOTU (M Vance) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>HARRY DUNNE (L Satherley) – Slow to begin. Crowded and briefly steadied 200 metres.</p> <p>CAPISTRANO RUBY (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>QUELLA FINALE (S Collett) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.</p> <p>CHOULEE (T Thornton) – Held up until approaching the 200 metres and when shifting out to obtain clear running dictated AMEN CORNER into the line of HARRY DUNNE which was crowded and briefly steadied. T Thornton was issued with a warning.</p> <p>READY TO ROMANCE (J Bayliss) – Lost the right hind plate during the running.</p>	
Race 3	AC PETFOOD 1400
<p>ABACUS (L Satherley) – A warning was placed against the gelding after being restless in its barrier stall.</p> <p>BARTIMAEUS (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>MONEGASQUE (D Hain) – Was very slow to begin. Made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres having to be briefly steadied.</p> <p>SWISSKY (S Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>MOZART (M Cameron) – Commenced to race ungenerously soon after leaving the barriers and ran wide passing the 1100 metres forcing FINVARA wide on the track. Then continued to race ungenerously running off passing the 600 metres and took no effective part in the race. The stable representative was advised that the colt must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.</p> <p>FINVARA (S Spratt) – Forced wide for a distance passing the 1100 metres.</p>	

Race 4	HARNESS RACING WAIKATO 20 JANUARY 1400
<p>FIRENZE (J Bayliss) – Began awkwardly. Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.</p> <p>S Spratt (EXPRESS CALL) – Admitted a breached of careless riding in that she allowed her mount to shift inwards shortly after the start when not sufficiently clear of SEO LINN which was checked. After viewing films and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended S Spratt’s licence to ride at race meetings from the conclusion of racing on 26 November until the conclusion of racing on 3 December, 5 National days.</p> <p>SEO LINN (J Nason) – Crowded shortly after the start and checked.</p> <p>VICKEZZLEPIN (D Johnson) – Crowded and briefly steadied shortly after the start.</p>	
Race 5	FARRELLY CALF REARING 1400
<p>SPRING SHOW (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly and shifted in abruptly despite the efforts of its rider crowding ORANGE SHORE and SOVEREIGN PRINCE.</p> <p>ORANGE SHORE (M Du Plessis) – Slow to begin then hampered losing ground.</p> <p>SOVEREIGN PRINCE (M Coleman) – Crowded and hampered shortly after the start. Was held up rounding the final turn and then held up over the concluding stages when improving onto heels.</p> <p>JUD STRUNK (D Hain) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>CHOU CHOU (S Collett) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>DON’T BE CHEEKY (R Elliot) – Raced wide in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>THISTLEDONICLEY (M Hills) – Held up rounding the final turn and could not obtain clear running in the final straight.</p>	
Race 6	TE AWAMUTU COLLEGE 1580
<p>THE HEIRESS (M Cameron) – Made contact shortly after leaving the barrier with SLICER then shifting away from that runner despite the efforts of its rider crowding DANMAR onto KANE which was crowded and steadied. Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>KANE (J Bayliss) – Crowded and steadied shortly after the start.</p> <p>MASKOBI PEARL (J Fawcett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>SALIENT (M Hills) - Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>J Bayliss – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he angled KANE out passing the 300 metres when insufficiently clear of MARC ONE and KAURI COVE which were both crowded and hampered. After viewing films and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended J Bayliss’ licence to ride at race meetings from the conclusion of racing on 26 November until the conclusion of racing on 3 December, 5 National days.</p> <p>MARC ONE (C Dell) – Crowded passing the 400 metres by KANE which shifted out to obtain clear running. Crowded and hampered passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>KAURI COVE (R Elliot) – Hampered becoming unbalanced passing the 300 metres.</p>	

Race 7	VILAGRAD WINERY 1580
<p>RECOLLECT (J Bayliss) – Raced in restricted room and briefly steadied passing the 1500 metres.</p> <p>WEHADADEAL (M Coleman) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that it was the first run back after a spell and felt that the gelding would take some improvement out of the run.</p> <p>SWEET TREAT (R Elliot) – Had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 800 metres.</p> <p>DON BLANCO (J Riddell) – Had to be steadied losing ground when crowded passing the 200 metres between RECOLLECT which Lay in becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SEA HOME and when being corrected by its rider made contact with DON BLANCO which was further crowded by TAKE IT OUT (M Vance) which lay in under pressure. M Vance was issued with a warning with Stewards taking into account the outward movement from RECOLLECT.</p> <p>RECOLLECT (J Bayliss) – Lay in passing the 200 metres then made contact with DON BLANCO when being corrected by its rider.</p> <p>TAKE IT OUT (M Vance) – Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>DESERT STORM (S Collett) – Held up throughout the final straight.</p>	
Race 8	TE AWAMUTU COURIER 2000
<p>ASYLUM SEEKER (D Johnson) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>CANZAC (B Morgenrood) – Slow to begin then crowded shortly after.</p> <p>PLAZABEEL (C Lammas) – Crowded and hampered shortly after leaving the barrier losing ground. Raced ungenerously in the early stages when being steadied then continued to race keenly through the middle stages.</p> <p>IMELDA CHOUX (S Weatherley) - Crowded and hampered shortly after leaving the barrier losing ground.</p> <p>IFFRAAJINATOR (A Jones) – Made the bend awkwardly leaving the straight on the first occasion running wide.</p> <p>SOUL SERENADE (L Satherley) – Held up for a distance passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>ASYLUM SEEKER (D Johnson) – Held up rounding the final bend.</p> <p>B Morgenrood – Was issued a warning for his use of the whip on a horse out of contention.</p>	
Race 9	WAIPA HOME OF CHAMPIONS 2000
<p>NEWTON (M Cameron) – When questioned regarding performance rider could not offer any tangible excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed abrasions to the fetlocks.</p> <p>ZAPALI (S Weatherley) – Ducked out when struck with the whip passing the 200 metres making brief contact with SHE’S ALL CLANG.</p> <p>SHE’S ALL CLANG (D Johnson) – Bumped passing the 200 metres.</p>
