GENERAL:

Pre-race blood testing was carried out.

SUPPLEMENTARY:

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 ELMWOOD CATERING MAIDEN 1200m

NATURAL LIGHT (L Callaway) – Declared a late scratching at 12.07pm after refusing to load into the barrier. Trainer A Schwarz was advised that the gelding must barrier trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to racing next. **FULLTOTHEBRIM** (K Selvan) – Slow to begin, inconvenienced shortly after.

NIGHT LADY (C Johnson) – Slow to begin. Steadied near the 100 metres when becoming held up, having to be shifted inwards across heels to obtain clear running.

DALE (C Campbell) – Shifted outwards abruptly leaving the barrier hampering LIL MISS SWISS which lost ground. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

LIL MISS SWISS (K Kalychurun) – Hampered at the start losing ground. Lay outwards when placed under pressure near the 100 metres, having to be straightened.

MISSING HAZARD (R Firdhaus) – Raced greenly shortly after the start, shifting outwards and hampering LETS GO LILY which in turn was forced outwards onto FULLTOTHEBRIM.

LETS GO LILY (T Jonker) – Hampered shortly after the start.

PLOWSHARE (J Lowry) – Raced wide in the early stages.

RED MAJOR (T Moseley) – Commenced to over-race near the 900 metres having to be steadied when awkwardly near the heels of MYSTICAL EYES. Lay outwards when placed under pressure near the 300 metres.

STEP INSIDE LOVE (C Barnes) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

GO APACHE (K Williams) – Hung outwards when negotiating the bend near the 400 metres and continued to do so for some distance. Rider K Williams reported that the mare had got its tongue over the bit during the running.

Race 2 SADDLERY WAREHOUSE INVERCARGILL MAIDEN 1200m

MORRIE MAC (A Bohorun) – Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout. Lay inwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

LINEDANCEKING (R Yatim) – Shifted outwards leaving the barrier forcing GUN LAW and ROCK MASTER outwards into the line of DIESEL BURNER which was hampered, losing ground. Raced fiercely in the early stages and near the 900 metres had to be steadied when awkwardly near the heels of FEISTY JANE. Crowded momentarily near the 300 metres when between ROCK MASTER and ITZ MY ONE which lay inwards.

DIESEL BURNER (L Callaway) – Hampered at the start, losing ground. Steadied approaching the 800 metres when in restricted room. Fell when being pulled up following the event and was immediately attended to by the on-course Veterinarian, however was found to be deceased upon arrival after suffering a suspected internal haemorrhage. Rider L Callaway was examined by St John Paramedics and cleared to fulfil his remaining engagements.

ITZ MY ONE (K Selvan) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages when being obliged to race wide without cover.

DRUMROYAL (J Lowry) - Steadied near the 900 metres when awkwardly paced to the outside of

LINEDANCEKING which shifted outwards when making the bend awkwardly.

ROCK MASTER (T Moseley) – Over-raced in the early stages.

FERRARI (C Campbell) – Ran wide when negotiating the bend near the 900 metres, placing apprentice rider C Campbell in difficulty for the remainder of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Co-trainer P Harris was advised that a warning would be placed against the racing manners record of the filly. Mr Harris advised it would be the stables intention to freshen the filly prior to racing next.

Race 3 SPEIGHT'S HANDICAP 2100m

ODI ET AMO (K Kalychurun) – Began awkwardly.

HE AIN'T HEAVY (L Callaway) – Bumped with HONOR THAT upon jumping. Bumped near the 100 metres.

HONOR THAT (T Moseley) – Bumped with HE AIN'T HEAVY upon jumping.

LIN (G Jogoo) – Lay outwards under pressure passing the 100 metres making contact with HE AIN'T HEAVY.

CONSOLIDATE (C Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance rider C Johnson advised that the mare had proved disappointing when placed under his urgings however he could offer no tangible explanation.

Race 4 CATR FASHIONS in the FIELD SAT 16 DEC MAIDEN 2100m

HERBIE (J Morris) – Slow to begin.

SHOTGLASS (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.

MINNIE PINS (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly and shifted outwards bumping with BRIEF ENCOUNTER which in turn was forced into the line of HOLY MACKEREL which was inconvenienced. Steadied passing the 1600 metres when awkwardly near the heels of MAVRICK as the pace of the race eased at this stage. Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight.

HOLY MACKEREL (J Lowry) – Bumped at the start.

BRIEF ENCOUNTER (K Kalychurun) – Bumped at the start. Got it head up when being restrained in the early stages, then made the crossing near the 1600 metres awkwardly.

OUR ROYAL (D Bothamley) – Got its head when being restrained passing the 1600 metres as the pace of the race eased at this stage.

FLY THE FLAG (K Williams) – Got its head when being restrained passing the 1500 metres as the pace of the race eased at this stage.

Race 5 ASCOT PARK HOTEL HANDICAP 2100m

LIMOUSINE (D Bothamley) – Began awkwardly.

THE ENERGIZER (K Kwo) – Slow to begin.

HIGHER AUTHORITY (C Barnes) – Crowded leaving the barrier when between ERIN'S BABE and BEETHOVEN

both of which shifted ground.

CENTAVADA (K Kalychurun) – Over-raced in the early stages.

MADAM DE SOIR (K Williams) – Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres, only obtaining clear running approaching the 100 metres.

ERIN'S BABE (C Campbell) – Held up for a short distance near the 350 metres. Steadied near the 150 metres when becoming awkwardly positioned to the inside of the weakening SMOKEM UP.

BEETHOVEN (J Lowry) – Lay inwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

SMOKEM UP (C Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance rider C Johnson advised the gelding had proved disappointing and had been under pressure some distance from the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Race 6 MCCALLUMS GROUP MAIDEN 1600m

PORTUMNA LASS (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.

TURBULENCE (C Campbell) – Slow to begin.

COATNCOLLAR (K Kalychurun) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Rider K Kalychurun reported that in his opinion the gelding may benefit for further distance at this stage of its preparation and in addition, a more rain affected surface.

MAKS LEGEND (K Kwo) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

PRETTY WHAIHINE (L Callaway) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Held up for a distance passing the 350 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have lameness in the left fore-leg. A veterinary certificate of fitness is required prior to PRETTY WHAIHINE racing next. Co-trainer N White reported it would now be the stables intention to send the mare for a spell prior to resuming racing.

MAC MURDOCH (K Mudhoo) – Obliged to race four-wide from the 600 metres. Lay inwards when struck with the whip near the 150 metres and had to be straightened.

PYJAMARAMA (J Morris) – Weakened from the 250 metres. Rider J Morris advised that she had been under pressure rounding the final bend however could offer no tangible explanation. Co-trainer B Blatch reported that it would be the stables intention to send the mare for a brief freshen up prior to racing next.

Race 7 ILT FOUNDATION HANDICAP 1400m

TANIWHA (J Morris) – Slow to begin. Out-paced through the early stages.

ALL BLACK MAGIC (L Callaway) – Slow to begin. Steadied near the 150 metres when attempting a marginal run to the inside of KATANGO, only gaining clear running inside the final 75 metres.

BRIDGET TOWN (K Kalychurun) – Rider K Kalychurun was reminded of his obligations regarding use of the whip on a runner out of contention.

Race 8 MARQUEE & PARTY HIRE MAIDEN 1400m

SWEET CHASTITY (K Williams) - Co-trainer P Harris advised the Stewards that the mare had come heavily

into season with this information being disseminated through the appropriate channels.

THE MIST (K Kalychurun) – Declared a late scratching at 4.18pm after refusing to load into the barrier. Connections were advised that the gelding must barrier trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to racing next.

ITEMIZE (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly. Lay inwards under pressure in the early stages of the final straight and bumped with GET RYTHM over the concluding stages.

GET RYTHM (A Bohorun) – Crowded leaving the barrier when between THE PUBLICAN and NOMEN LUDI which was forced inwards by ITEMIZE which began awkwardly. Steadied passing the 400 metres when improving up onto the heels of VINO TINTO and again shortly after when making the final bend awkwardly. Shifted inwards under pressure over the concluding stages bumping with ITEMIZE. Apprentice rider A Bohorun, in the presence of Mr D Walsh the NZTR Apprentice Riding Mentor, was spoken to regarding this and advised that he is expected to straighten his mounts when shifting ground in future.

ZAH WANTED (R Firdhaus) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

DEZZIES DELIGHT (C Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance rider C Johnson advised that the mare had proved disappointing however he could offer no tangible explanation. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a minor laceration to the right hind fetlock. Stewards will follow up the recovery with trainer S Kirkland in the coming days.

NOMEN LUDI (K Kwo) – When questioned regarding the performance apprentice rider K Kwo advised that the gelding had become fractious in the barrier due to a delay in the loading process, adding that NOMEN LUDI had been flat to maintain its position during the running and had proved disappointing.

Race 9 INVERCARGILL LICENSING TRUST HANDICAP 1400m

SQUIZZY (K Kalychurun) – Began awkwardly.

CASING THE JOINT (K Selvan) – Slow to begin.

LIVADREAM (G Jogoo) – Got its head up when being restrained to obtain cover in the early stages.

THEM OR US (K Williams) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages until near the 900 metres.

SALLY GETCHA GUN (J Morris) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

OH SO SMART (R Beeharry) – Obliged to race wide round the final bend. Apprentice rider R Beeharry with the assistance of senior rider T Moseley was shown the video coverage particularly from the 400 metres for educational purposes. Mr Beeharry was further advised that in the Stewards opinion he had erred in his judgement when improving the mare extremely wide on the final bend when the opportunity had existed to race in a position tighter to the main body of the field.

TEDDYTWINKLETOES (K Kwo) – Held up rounding the final bend until near the 200 metres.

THE BRAVE ONE (J Lowry) – Bumped near the 150 metres. Rider J Lowry reported that the gelding had proved disappointing under his urgings over the concluding stages however he could offer no tangible

explanation.

MISS TUSCAN (T Moseley) – Bumped with THE BRAVE ONE near the 150 metres.

Race 10 CHRISTMAS at the RACES SAT 16 DEC HANDICAP 1400m

BLUE FLAG (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.

POLLY'S SISTER (R Firdhaus) – Slow to begin.

NAPOLEON DYNAMITE (R Beeharry) – Began awkwardly. Lay inwards under pressure in the early stages of the final straight.

I'M HORACE (K Kwo) – Blundered leaving the barrier. Raced wide without cover throughout. Bumped with TAIERI GEM near the 250 metres. Apprentice rider K Kwo reported that his saddle had slipped back during the running placing him at a disadvantage.

THE CZAR (K Kalychurun) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Hung outwards rounding the final bend and throughout the home straight. Rider K Kalychurun reported the gelding to have hung outwards throughout.

TAIERI GEM (C Barnes) – Over-raced in the early stages. Bumped with I'M HORACE when shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

THE KRAKEN (K Mudhoo) – Out-paced through the early and middle stages despite the efforts of its rider to maintain his positon in the field. Held up momentarily near the 350 metres. Hampered and had to be steadied over the concluding stages when racing to the inside of NAPOLEON DYNAMITE (R Beeharry). Stewards questioned riders R Beeharry and K Mudhoo regarding this incident where it was established that NAPOLEON DYNAMITE had shifted inwards and away from the improving BLUE FLAG at this stage, whilst hanging inwards despite the efforts of its rider. Accordingly Stewards took the matter no further. Rider R Beeharry reported that the gelding had hung inwards throughout the final straight and was unable to apply any significant vigor as a result.

DAN CUGAT (L Callaway) – Steadied for a short distance near the 450 metres when improving up onto the heels of NAPOLEON DYNAMITE.
