RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WENTWOOD GRANGE JUVENILE
ELLE D'BERRY (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after between SIMOGRAMOR which shifted in slightly and PUSHMEE which lay out. L Innes was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.	
SIMOGRAMOR (L Innes) – Began awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality. Co trainer G Rogerson advised the filly would be sent for a spell.	
Race 2	LANGSFORD – N & G LTD 1200
THELMA (S Collett) – Slow to begin.	

HEAT SEEKER (B Morgenrood) - Slow to begin. Held up until near the 150 metres.

PINSMAN (D Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly. Went off stride near 450 metres.

ALL TRUMPED UP (S Weatherley) – Hampered near the 950 metres. Improved onto the heels of the weakening SITULA STAR passing the 400 metres and shifted out making contact with CLARIOS which became briefly unbalanced.

CLARIOS (J Fawcett) – Bumped 400 metres and become briefly unbalanced.

COME IN SPINNER (L Innes) – Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

SITULA STAR (L Satherley) – Raced wide when disputing the pace in the early to middle stages and lay out approaching the 600 metres.

Race 3 | **RANDAL JUDD MEMORIAL 1200**

PINNACLE (S Weatherley) - Hampered leaving the barriers.

LO SCHIAFFO (T Thornton) – Raced keenly when becoming awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 700 metres.

PRINCEVILLE (S Spratt) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

MISS FREELOVE (M Coleman) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

ZA ZA GABOR (J Bayliss) – Steadied approaching the 100 metres and hampered after improving into restricted room between THE SWISS MAESTRO which lay out making contact, and POWER O’HATA which shifted in and away from PINNACLE.

ACTRESSA (L Innes) – Reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his mount out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.

Race 4 | **MONOVALE SAND 1400**

ALBUT ME (M Hills) – Slow to begin.

SACRED TONIC (L Innes) - Raced three wide without cover.

Race 5 | **PORRITT SAND 1600**

PRINCE JABEEL (L Innes) – Blundered leaving the barriers losing ground.

DAYTONA RED (C Johnson) – Slow to begin.

QUEEN EL JAY (M Coleman) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres.

FAST FINANCE (R Elliot) - Briefly held up approaching the 400 metres.

Race 6 | **SPRAYLINK WEED SPRAYING 1600**

RODOLFO (R Elliot) – Blundered leaving the barriers losing ground.

VERRY FLASH (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly then crowded. Raced ungenerously throughout.

REFLECTION (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

REPLICA (M Cameron) – Raced wide without cover. Inconvenienced when weakening near the 250 metres. When questioned rider advised racing wide rounding the bend had been detrimental to the fillies' chances.

EACH WAY (M Coleman) – When questioned regarding the performance rider advised after travelling well the gelding had not responded as anticipated when placed under pressure and may prefer further easing of the ground.

Race 7 | **COOLMORE AUSTRALIA 1600**

MISS CAMPBELL (J Bayliss) – Blundered leaving the barrier losing ground.

KORAKONUUI (L Innes) – Slow to begin.

KIRKENES (J Riddell) – Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground.

SLICE OF CAKE (V Colgan) – Crowded start. When questioned regarding the performance rider could offer no excuse.

REPEAT (D Johnson) – Had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 600 metres.

TOBI (C Dell) – Raced keenly in the middle stages then had to be firmly restrained after improving on to heels near the 500 metres.

Race 8 | **STABLECRAFT 1200**

FAST AND FURIOUS (A Schwerin) – Crowded and checked approaching the 900 metres to the inside of AILEEN GRACE which was dictated in by KAHAROA ROSE which was racing ungenerously and shifted in and away from ORPHEA abruptly. Crowded and checked near the 700 metres losing ground.

KAHAROA ROSE (T Thornton) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early to middle stages. Firmly restrained off heels near the 700 metres going back on to AILEEN GRACE which then shifted out abruptly to avoid that runner's heels crowding FAST AND FURIOUS which was checked losing ground. Also hampered as a result was MISS HOROTIU.

AILEEN GRACE (S Weatherley) – Crowded near the 900 metres. Had to be firmly restrained near the 700 metres to avoid heels and shifted out abruptly.

SAIGNON (C Johnson) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

SHE'S FLOSSIE (J Nason) - Raced three wide without cover.

ORPHEA (L Innes) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight then had to be steadied over the final 100 metres when improving on to heels.

MISS HOROTUI (M Coleman) – Hampered near the 700 metres. Shifted out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

CHOUXS WISELY (S Collett) – Received veterinary attention after being galloped on during the running.
