## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>DAVE HOSKIN CARRIERS MAIDEN 2040m</b>
<b>HOLLYPOP (C Johnson)</b> - bounded at the start settling back	
<b>CRYSTAL ROC (H Andrew)</b> - raced three-wide without cover in the early and middle stages	

**ROCKONEVE (R Myers)** – Lay inwards in the early stages bumping and dictating **HEZA DUKE** inwards tightening **TREBBIANO** which was briefly inconvenienced. Held up behind tiring runners approaching the 400 metres having to be angled outwards in the home straight to obtain clear running.

**MISTER GERONIMO (M Hills)** - had to be restrained off heels passing the 1,600 metres

**CORNERSTONE (L Hemi)** - held up when running up onto heels passing the 500 metres

**DAL KILCHOAN (T Johnson)** – Held up for a short distance passing the 500 metres. Lay in under pressure in the home straight having to be straightened.

**A SHIN (Belladita)** - was spoken to regarding his whip use on a runner out of contention

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>ALSCO 1200m</b>

**PURE DAZE (T Allan)** - began awkwardly settling back

**SON OF SURF (D Hirini)** - Raced three-wide without cover throughout. Lay in and away from **EXHIBIT** going into the first turn when racing greenly which resulted in **FLAVOURING** having to check and **FLOSCEE'S GOLD** and **OUR DYAMITE** being crowded. **SON OF SURF** continued to race greenly throughout. Lost hind-plate during running.

**BRUEGEL (C Johnson)** – Baulked and jumped approaching the crossing in the back straight losing ground. Improved onto heels near the 400 metres and had to be severely restrained. Held up passing the 400 metres having to be angled outwards to obtain clear running approaching the 200 metres.

**OUR DYNAMITE (R Myers)** – Hung passing the 800 metres dictating **FLOSCEE'S GOLD** and **SON OF SURF** wider on the track.

**EXHIBIT (T Johnson)** - was held up for a short distance approaching the home turn. Hung around the home turn.

**FLAVOURING (M Tanaka)** - hung out rounding the turn

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>GAS &amp; HEATING MAIDEN 1340m</b>

**VENENEUSE (C O'Beirne)** – Bumped heavily at the start severely unbalancing the rider then commenced to race ungenerously resulting in C O'Beirne taking the filly forward near the 800 metres.

**OVER THINK (D Turner)** - jumped outwards abruptly at the start dictating **AL BE CIVICS** outwards which contacted **VENENEUSE** and in turn heavily bumped **THUTMOSIS**.

**THATS AMORE (M Singh)** - Jumped outwards at the start dictating **PRIZED PINS** wider on the track which then raced greenly for a short distance losing significant ground. Over-raced when racing wide without cover in the early stages. Held up passing the 200 metres when attempting a marginal run. Angled out to improve near the 100 metres.

**THUTMOSIS (T Johnson)** – Bumped heavily at the start losing ground. Over-raced for some distance in the back straight. Made the home turn awkwardly.

**LIVE IN HOPE (T Allan)** - Hung outwards throughout the home straight and could not be ridden out fully over the final stages.

**PRIZED PINS (S MacNab)** – Dictated wider on the track at the start then raced greenly losing significant ground. Raced in restricted room early in the home straight. When questioned S MacNab advised the gelding had raced greenly throughout. Connections were advised a warning will be placed against the gelding's racing manners.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>PALAMOUNTAINS NUTRITION MAIDEN 1340m</b>

**TAVISTELLA (D Hirini)** - jumped inwards at the start losing ground

**SHEZACRAFTSMAN (S Wynne)** – began awkwardly losing ground

**UP IN SMOKE (T Allan)** – slow away

**PLAY THE FIELD (M Singh)** – Attempted to jump the crossing in the back straight ducking outwards abruptly, inconveniencing **SAINTED PEARL**. Also inconvenienced was **ROUGH 'N' TUMBLE** which bumped with **SAINTED PEARL** a short distance further.

**SAINTED PEARL (L Hemi)** – raced three wide without cover throughout.

**ROUGH 'N' TUMBLE (H Andrew)** – lay in under pressure in the home straight

**BENSON (R Myers)** – Raced keenly when being restrained approaching the 1,000 metres. When questioned into the performance of the gelding R Myers had no excuse.

**HEART OF FAME (M Tanaka)** - lost an off-hind plate during the running

**T ALLAN (Up In Smoke)** which finished unplaced, was given a warning under Rule 647 (1) for failing to weigh in.

**Race 5** | **AME ELECTRICAL 2040M**

**GO TO MAN (S Wynne)** – Slow away. Held up approaching the 400 metres and again passing the 300 metres having to be angled outwards to obtain clear running inside the 200 metres.

**AMUN RA (D Turner)** – Raced in restricted room passing the 1,700 metres when **NAPOLEON (A Jones)** shifted ground inward tightening **BELLA'S DELIGHT** on to **AMUN RA**. A Jones was advised to exercise greater care.

**BELLA'S DELIGHT (D Bradley)** - raced three-wide without cover throughout

**ANIMINATOR (T Johnson)** – Lay in under pressure in the home straight. Briefly inconvenienced passing the 100 metres when **HUNTA PENCE** shifted out under hard riding.

**HUNTA PENCE (C Johnson)** - held up for some distance approaching the 600 metres gaining clear running entering the home straight.

**KAIRANGA LAD (M Singh)** – raced keenly in the early and middle stages

**GORDYS GESTURE (S MacNab)** – Briefly held up passing the 400 metres behind the tiring **NAPOLEON**.

**A JONES (Napoleon)** – Was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (3) (b) (i) with regard to her use of the whip on a horse out of contention.

**Race 6** | **LOADERS LANDSCAPE SUPPLIES 1600m**

**TROUP ROAD (A Shin)** – slow away

**TERRACOTTA WARRIOR (L Hemi)** – raced wide without cover throughout

**HANDFULL (D Turner)** - Bumped with **REBEL ROSE** when seeking to improve near the 600 metres.

**REBEL ROSE (A Jones)** – Bumped 600 metres. Lugged in in the home straight.

**DURHAM (S MacNab)** - Held up approaching the 400 metres having to be angled inwards to gain clear running near the 200 metres.

**EN SUITE (R Myers)** - Held up approaching the 100 metres having to be angled outwards across heels to gain clear running.

**DANDEEDEE (D Hirini)** - raced in restricted room over the final 100 metres

**O'CEIRINS CHOICE (H Andrew)** – Went off stride after making contact with the running rail going into the back straight and again a short distance further into the back straight. H Andrew was of the opinion the mare was not suited to racing in restricted room. Held up approaching the 100 metres when attempting a marginal run to the inside of **FIGURABLE**.

**MAGIC WONDER (C Johnson)** – When questioned into the run C Johnson could offer no excuse but was of the opinion the mare would improve with the run.

**Race 7** | **CAMBRIDGE THOROUGHBRED LODGE WANGANUI CUP 2040m**

**SNOW SECRET (B Hutton)** – Raced keenly in the early stages. Held up entering the home straight bumping with **CRUISER** when angling for a run approaching the 100 metres. B Hutton was of the opinion the mare would be better suited to any easing in the going.

**QUINTESENTIALLY (C Johnson)** – Slow away then raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Hung rounding the home turn. Held up early in the home straight until being angled for an inside run approaching the 150 metres.

**HUSHED (S Wynne)** - Lay out approaching the 100 metres tightening **BALHAM** then raced in restricted room having to be restrained over the final stages when **ALL IN VOGUE** shifted inwards dictating **BALHAM**.

**CRUISER (D Bradley)** – bumped approaching the 100 metres

**H ANDREW (Blathwayt)** – Issued with a warning under Rule 638 (3) (b) (ii) with regard to her whip use in the home straight.

**Race 8** | **WANGANUI STEELFORMERS 1340m**

**ALL CHARM (M Singh)** – Commenced to over-race approaching the 800 metres and when being steadied shifted inwards crowding **BISOU BISOU** and **GLADSTONE BELLE** which was checked. **ALL CHARM** then shifted wide on the track when being corrected. Continued to race greenly throughout.

**ITELLYOONETHING (R Stam)** - Steadied going into the 800 metre turn when **PERFECT HARMONEE** shifted in.

**BISOU BISOU (S Wynne)** - tightened near the 800 metres and then commenced to over-race

**GOODSAV (C Johnson)** – held up for some distance in the home straight until near the 150 metres
