RACE COMMENTS:

TREASURE (J Kah) – Slow away. Became awkwardly placed passing the 400 metres and briefly steadied.

ZENVO (J Collett) – Began awkwardly.

LOS ANGELES (D Lane) - Began awkwardly.

TERRA FIRMA (S Collett) – Began awkwardly and then crowded shortly after losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance S Collett was of the opinion that the filly would appreciate a step up in distance.

RONDINELLA (M Cameron) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Lost the right hind plate during the running.

SPECIAL LIGHT (A Collett) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

SCREAMING MIMI (C Johnson) – Lost the left hind plate during the running.

B Allen (LILY THE PINK) – Was reminded of his obligations in that he must not shake hands prior to weighing in.

Race 2 First Global Logistics 2200

DAYTONA RED (A Collett) – Slow away.

SOUL SERENADE (J Kah) – Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding the performance J Kah advised that the mare may be feeling the effects of improved track conditions.

LA ACHIEVER (S McKay) – Over-raced in the early stages.

PLAZABEEL (C Johnson) – Raced in restricted room passing the 300 metres.

Race 3 Ezgo Golf Cart Rentals 1600

MY DAKOTA (J Collett) – Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground.

KAURI COVE (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly and then was crowded shortly after. Raced wide until near the 800 metres.

HEREMON (A Collett) – Crowded when leaving the barriers losing ground. Raced in restricted room passing the 1000 metres to the inside of OVER TORQUE which lay in despite the efforts of its rider. Held up for clear running until passing the 350 metres.

GO FOR DOUGH (S Collett) – Held up for clear running early in the final straight.

DE KONING (S McKay) – Held up for clear running until passing the 300 metres.

Race 4 Cardinal Logistics 1600

LUCKY SWEEP (J Collett) – Slow away.

ROCETTE LADY (S McKay) – Briefly steadied approaching the 1500 metres when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of GRAND SOLEIL (M Coleman) which shifted in when not fully clear. M Coleman was advised to exercise greater care.

DIVINE RANSOM (T Thornton) – Raced in restricted room passing the 1000 metres to the inside of SEA HOME which lay in and when being corrected by its rider SEA HOME then shifted out with MAKARIOS becoming awkwardly placed and hampered going back on to ZANYETTA which was also steadied. When questioned Rider T Thornton advised that the mare was feeling the effects of the firm nature of the track.

PRINCESS SAPPHIRE (S Collett) – Had to be restrained off heels passing the 900 metres when becoming awkwardly placed and continued to race ungenerously until the middle stages.

Race 5 Barfoot & Thompson Twilight Cup (1500 metres)

BUY ME A ROCK (J Collett) - Began awkwardly.

COMIN'THROUGH (M Coleman) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start and steadied.

RED TSUNAMI (A Collett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

SARABANDE (S Collett) – Shifted out passing the 250 metres inconveniencing SHADOWS. S Collett was advised to exercise greater care.

SHADOWS (S McKay) – Inconvenienced passing the 250 metres. S McKay reported that the gelding had not been entirely comfortable in today's firmer track conditions.

TOORAK TOWER (C Johnson) – Reluctant to load into the barriers. The connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the horse's barrier manners. Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight. Lost the right hind plate during the running.

C Johnson (TOORAK TOWER) – Issued with a warning regarding his whip use in the final straight.

Race 6 Dunstan Feeds 1500 Championship Qualifier

LUPELANI (J Kah) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

RICHIE MCHORSE (S Collett) – Slow away.

M Coleman (DASHPER) – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he allowed DASHPER to shift in passing the 1100 metres when not sufficiently clear of INDECISION which was hampered and dictated in on to MORRIE OCK which was checked. M Coleman had his license to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing 17 December up to and including 23 December, 5 national riding days.

INDECISION (B Allen) – Crowded and hampered 1100 metres.

MORRIE OCK (A Collett) – Crowded and checked 1100 metres. Disappointed for a run approaching the 200 metres by DASHPER which was taken in by SPINDLE which shifted in under pressure before being straightened by its rider. T Thornton was advised she must exercise care in a similar circumstance.

INSCRIPTION (J Collett) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. When questioned Rider J Collett advised that after being caught wide the mare had then failed to quicken when placed under pressure and in his opinion would be better suited by some easing of the ground.
