RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 TREMAINS STARTING GATES 2000 (2000 metres)

ROYAL RUBY (S Collett) -Made the bend awkwardly passing the 1700 metres.

MAGIC WONDER (A Chan) – Made the first bend awkwardly.

ALFIE DEE (C Lammas) - Raced keenly in the middles stages.

MY TOMMY (C Johnson) - Raced keenly throughout and had little left at the finish.

WILIJONMCBRIDE (R Elliot) - Raced keenly passing the 1400 metres when being restrained moved outwards to race three wide without cover for the remainder, was tightened near the 450 metres when ALFIE DEE (C Lammas) was improving into a run to its inside. C Lammas was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground.

ITISWHATITIS (R Myers) – Raced in restricted room approaching the home turn.

Race 2 DRILLERS POULTRY 1300 (1300 metres)

MALCAN (R Myers) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages making the bend passing the 800 metres awkwardly, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had not felt entirely comfortable in today's track conditions, a post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

SOULSANA (D Hirini) - Raced keenly throughout when three wide.

MY BIG SISTA (C Johnson) - Lay out under pressure in the final straight.

TOMS (L Innes) – When questioned into the performance rider had no excuse.

Race 3 DUNSTAN FEEDS 1500 CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER (1200 metres)

GOODSAV (C Johnson) - Awkwardly away settling back.

STEPPENWOLF (S Collett) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained passing the 1000 metres, when questioned regarding the performance S Collett advised the gelding was not entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.

SAVVY DREAMS (M Tanaka) - Raced in restricted room when taking a marginal run to the inside of STRAIGHT SETS passing the 150 metres.

Race 4 STELLA ARTOIS 1200 (1200 metres)

JESSIE MAY (M McNab) - Slow away then raced ungenerously when being restrained after improving onto heels in the middle stages, held up approaching the 400 metres having to be angled outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 200 metres, lay in under pressure over the final stages bumping with ESTIMATION approaching the 100 metres.

POPPIN' BUBBLES (C Lammas) - Steadied near the 900 metres when VENDELLA shifted in. L Innes was advised to exercise greater care, when being corrected shifted out and bumped GATE TO RIO, when questioned regarding the performance C Lammas advised the filly travelled comfortably enough but had been quickly beaten when placed under pressure and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a poor post-race recovery.

GATES TO RIO (L Hemi) - Bumped near the 900 metres becoming unbalanced.

ESTIMATION (R Myers) - Wide without cover throughout, bumped approaching the 100 metres.

VENDELLA (L Innes) - Lay out under pressure over the final stages bumping MISS OAHU just short of the finish.

MISS OAHU (S McKay) - Bumped just short of the finish.

Race 5 MITRE 10 TRADE – GOING THE EXTRA MILE (1600 metres)

REAL BEACH (M Tanaka) - Slow away, raced up onto the heels having to be restrained when the pace eased approaching the 900 metres.

IRISH ENCHANTER (H Andrew) - Raced three wide without cover from the 800 metres.

FIRENZE (L Innes) - Held up from the 800 metres gaining clear running passing the 400 metres.

VICKEZZLEPIN (D Johnson) - Held up for a distance from the 600 metres and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running.

OWNED (R Myers) – When questioned into performance the rider advised the gelding may not have been suited to today's track conditions.

Race 6 TRINITY HILL MILE (1600 metres)

VAN HALEN (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

FIREFLY (D Johnson) - Had to be restrained off heels passing the 1200 metres.

Race 7 FRESHMAX GROUP 3YO (1400 metres)

BEAU GESTE (M McNab) - Began awkwardly settling back.

SACRED TONIC (L Innes) - Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages, making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly hampering AERO DE PARIS.

JUNIOR (L Hemi) - Over-raced when being restrained near the 1000 metres.

AERO DE PARIS (S Weatherley) - Hung from the 900 metres, hampered going into the bend near the 800 metres running wide and then hung out badly rounding the bend, running very wide passing the 600 metres. Co-trainer A Scott was spoken to regarding the gelding's racing manners, with Mr Scott advising they would be giving consideration to making a gear alteration for its next start, further adding that today's race was its first run on a left handed track.

S Weatherley was spoken to regarding his celebratory gesture.

MAKEITRAIN (R Myers) - Held up for a distance approaching the 600 metres.

BUFFIT (A Jones) – A post-race veterinary examination revealed lameness in the left hind. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance was required prior to next going to the races.

Race 8 INTERISLANDER SUMMER FESTIVAL NEW YEARS DAY 1400 (1400 metres)

MONIE O'CEIRIN (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

ROAD TRIP (R Myers) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

DON'T BE CHEEKY (R Elliot) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

CASCATA (A Collett) - Was held up approaching the 400 metres having to be angled outwards across heels to gain clear running near the 200 metres.

D Turner (SELOUS) admitted a breach of [Rule 638(3)(b)(ii)] regarding the use of his whip prior to the 100 metres and was fined the sum of \$500 by the JCA.

GRIS DAME (M McNab) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the filly had found it difficult to quicken in today's track conditions and would be better suited to firmer footing, also adding in his opinion GRIS DAME may be better suited to a longer distance.
