**ALTIUS** (S McKay) – Trainer C Cole advised Stewards that the gelding had taken some time to recover from this run and would now be freshened prior to racing next.

**RAUL** (J Parkes) – Trainer M Breslin advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding and it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation with Mr Breslin adding he was of the opinion that RAUL may have held its breath during the running.

### Race 4 Dunstan Feeds 1500 Championship Qualifier

**MEURSAULT** (G Cooksley) – Trainer K Zimmerman advised Stewards that the mare has now been retired.

### Race 7 Hynds Holdings Limited Bonecrusher Stakes (1400 metres)

**PROM QUEEN** (A Collett) – Trainer K Rae advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the filly and that she has now been sent for a spell.

#### Race 8 RYDGES WELLINGTON CAPTAIN COOK STAKES (1600 metres)

MISS WILSON (S Collett) – Trainer J Bary advised Stewards that the mare underwent a veterinary examination upon return to his stables which included an endoscopic examination and blood tests which did not reveal any abnormality. Mr Bary added that she was noticeably in season in the days following the race and it is his intention for the mare to receive treatment from a chiropractor prior to racing next.

#### **RACE COMMENTS:**

#### Race 1 REAL CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 1600

VIKTOR VEGAS (M Cameron) - Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with SASANOF'S HERO losing ground.

**UABASSO** (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly.

**DONNA ANNE BILLY** (J Fawcett) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

JOE CARGO (S Collett) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running entering the final straight.

**VIKTOR VEGAS** (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding performance rider M Cameron advised the gelding had been out paced in the early stages and would prefer more rain affected footing.

**DR HANK** (M McNab) - When questioned regarding the performance rider M McNab advised the gelding would prefer more rain affected footing.

T Thornton – Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres on PASABACHE.

## Race 2 ICON SECURITY SYSTEMS 1200

**DAMA ZORRO** (M McNab) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**REGAL ASSASSIN** (A Collett) – Began awkwardly. Had to steady when placed in restricted room shortly after the start to the inside of EAGER BEAVER and EXPEDITION which were forced inwards slightly by TENACIOUS (P Moloney). Rider P Moloney was advised to exercise care.

**FASTELLIE** (J Nason) – Began awkwardly. Raced in restricted room approaching the 1100 metres then commenced to race ungenerously through the middle stages. Held up rounding the final bend and early in the final straight. When questioned regarding the performance, rider J Nason advised after beginning awkwardly the filly got back further than intended which had not suited.

**TENACIOUS** (P Moloney) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

# Race 3 REJTHAR LAW 1200

**WORDOFMOUTH** (S McKay) – Began awkwardly shifting in making contact with SILVER CLOUD which became briefly unbalanced losing ground.

MONREITH MOYRA (V Gatu) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**NUTTEE** (S Collett) – Had to steady when in placed restricted room near the 1000 metres to the outside of LADY LINWOOD which was laying outwards, contributing was inward movement from GOODNIGHT IRENE which shifted in.

**NO DOUBT A STAR** (J Nason) – Hung out and raced wide without cover throughout. A warning was placed on the gelding's racing manners.

**GOOD INTENTIONS** (M Cameron) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**WILSON** (A Collett) – Forced wider entering the final straight by HEAT SEEKER (B Morgenrood) which shifted out to obtain clear running. Rider B Morgenrood was issued with a warning.

**HEAT SEEKER** (B Morgenrood) - Shifted out entering the final straight to obtain clear running.

**SILVER CLOUD** (D Johnson) – Briefly unbalanced shortly after the start losing ground. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

**GOODNIGHT IRENE** (A Jones) - Had to be steadied over the concluding stages when placed in restricted room to the inside of CLARIOS which was forced inwards by WORDOFMOUTH which shifted in and away from HEAT SEEKER. Rider B Morgenrood was advised to exercise care.

### Race 4 VISION FRESH-WORKING WITH KIWI GROWERS 1400

LA ESTRELLA (P Moloney) - Slow away.

**SHINDEE** (R Jones) - Raced keenly in the middle stages then had to be steadied approaching the 1100 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of SECRET DREAMS (M Vance) which shifted in. Rider M Vance was advised to exercise greater care.

ISABELLA GUNN (M Hills) - Raced wide without cover.

**ANICETA** (T Thornton) – Inconvenienced passing the 300 metres when HINERANGI shifted out under pressure with ANICETA then having to shift inwards to obtain clear running. Following the race the connections of ANICETA wished to view Stewards footage before electing not to proceed with a protest.

# Race 5 ST PATRICK'S DAY RACES – SATURDAY 17 MARCH 1400

MASTAPLAZA (A Collett) - Hampered on jumping away losing ground. Held up over the final 100 metres.

**SWISSKY** (M Cameron) – Hampered on jumping away losing ground.

**MARQUITA MISS** (M Du Plessis) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Hampered near the 500 metres when forced wider by BOOMERANG (L Innes) which shifted out to obtain clear running. Rider L Innes was issued with a warning.

MASTER PAINTON (M McNab) - Rider dropped his whip approaching the 200 metres.

**THE MAGNATE** (M Coleman) - Was unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight.

**SUFFICE TO SAY** (R Elliot) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the outside of THE MAGNATE which shifted out near the 150 metres. M Coleman was advised to exercise greater care.

### Race 6 YOUNG READ WOUDBERG CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 2100

MARSHAL (S Weatherley) – Slow away. Briefly held up approaching the 350 metres.

**TOUCH OF SILVER** (G Cooksley) – Raced wide without cover until improving forward to lead passing the 1000 metres.

**DEFER** (S Collett) - Raced keenly in the middle stages. Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 300 metres when runners either side shifted ground.

**IVY'S COURT** (A Collett) - Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 150 metres to the inside of BROOKBARS which lay in under pressure. Also contributing was outward movement from ROSSO CORSA which shifted out and away from MARSHAL.

ROSSO CORSA (M Cameron) – Rider M Cameron was questioned regarding his ride in the final straight when he appeared to ride with less vigor for a period approaching the 100 metres with M Cameron explaining that ROSSO CORSA had had a tendency to hang out and became awkwardly placed when MARSHAL shifted out from his inside further advising that the rider of IVY'S COURT had been calling to him when in restricted room to his outside. ROSSO CORSA underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality.

### Race 7 KIWIFRUIT INVESTMENTS LIMITED 1400

**TWO THIRTY** (D Johnson) - Hampered on jumping away losing ground due to runners on either side shifting ground. Crowded and becoming briefly unbalanced near the 300 metres.

**TAVIS STAR** (T Newman) – Began awkwardly and had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

**BEAUTY'S ROSE** (S Weatherley) - Held up entering the final straight then improved into a marginal run passing the 300 metres crowding SHE'S FLOSSIE inwards onto TWO THIRTY which became briefly unbalanced. Contributing was slight inward movement from PRECISION MISS. Apprentice S Weatherley was advised to exercise care.

**SHE'S FLOSSIE** (A Jones) - Crowded when weakening near the 300 metres.

**RASPBERRY SWEET** (D Prastiyou) - Had to shift out passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

## Race 8 KIWI BUS BUILDERS 1600

**LUXE** (J Nason) - Raced wide for the majority of the race.

**HE'S UNFORGETTABLE** (S Weatherley) – Made firm contact with the side of the starting stall with rider S Weatherley becoming briefly unbalanced then had to steady shortly after when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of CASSIO. Improved to the outside of REPLICA (M Cameron) which had commenced to shift out near the 500 metres making brief contact with HE'S UNFORGETTABLE which then shifted out inconveniencing CURIOUS GEORGE. Rider M Cameron was issued with a warning.

**CASSIO** (T Thornton) - Had to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 800 metres.

**CURIOUS GEORGE** (P Moloney) - Inconvenienced and forced wider near the 500 metres.

**REPLICA** (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding performance M Cameron advised that the filly may prefer more rain affected footing.

**SALIENT** (M Hills) – Lay out passing the 100 metres having to be straightened by its rider.

MARK TWO (D Johnson) - Had to shift out passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

### Race 9 SUNLIVE 1600

**CARRADINE** (M Morgenrood) - Slow away then commenced to buck dislodging its rider who was uninjured. Connections were advised the gelding will be required to barrier trial prior to racing next.

**BARNABY** (S McKay) - Lay in shortly after jumping away crowding BLACK LACE in onto MARISSA and SOVEREIGN PRINCE with all those runners being hampered losing ground.

**BLACK LACE** (T Wenn) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

MARISSA (J Fawcett) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

**SOVEREIGN PRINCE** (M Coleman) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Raced keenly in middle stages.

**TAVIGARDE** (S Collett) - Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room near the 550 metres. Had to shift out passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

**UNFAZED** (M McNab) - Briefly held up entering the final straight.
