RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	SOUTHERN INSULATION HANDICAP (2500m)
BEETHOVEN (S Wynne) – Raced keenly in the early stages. SLAMMER (J Lowry) – Raced wide from the 800 metres. GAZZA THE GURU (T Moseley) – Made the bend by the 800 metres awkwardly, getting its head up when being steadied. SUNSET GIRL (K Williams) – Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home by a tiring runner. THE ENERGIZER (K Kalychurun) – Raced wide from the 800 metres.	

THE QUIET MAN (A Bohorun) – Slow through the early stages. Improved wide from the 400 metres.	
Race 2	INVERCARGILL LICENSING TRUST (1100m)
TICKETS ON HER (G Jogoo) – Apprentice rider G Jogoo spoken to advisedly regarding anticipating runs which had not fully developed. MACY (S Muniandy) – Got its head up when being steadied, racing into the bend by the 700 metres.	
Race 3	VERSATILE HOMES & BUILDINGS MAIDEN (1400m)
<p>The start of this event was delayed approximately 6 minutes due to the bridle on STEPHANIE requiring replacing.</p> <p>GET RYTHM (A Bohorun) – Slow to begin. Got its head up when being severely restrained through the early stages losing considerable ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Apprentice rider A Bohorun in the presence of his employer Mr S Blair-Edie and Mr D Walsh (the NZTR Apprentice Rider Mentor) admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(e) in that he rode incompetently when severely restraining his runner over the initial 400 metres of the race. After viewing replays and hearing submissions on penalty the JCA imposed a suspension of Mr Bohorun's apprentice riding licence from the 18th December 2017 up to and including the 24th January 2018 (5 ½ weeks)</p> <p>MIDNITE KAOS (L Callaway) – Crowded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>TUSSOCK (G Jogoo) – Held up in the early stages of the run home. Awkwardly placed close to the heels of STEPHANIE which was laying inwards near the 100 metres. Treated post-race for lacerations to a hind leg which required suturing, consistent with having been galloped on during the running.</p> <p>ROCK MASTER (S Toolooa) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>MISSING HAZARD (R Firdhaus) – Held up throughout the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 75 metres.</p> <p>CAROL'S CHEVAL (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Rider T Moseley reported the filly was feeling the firm nature of the track. Trainer S McKay advised the filly would now be sent for a spell.</p> <p>STEPHANIE (K Kwo) – Raced wide from the 800 metres. Trainer K Cairns was issued with a warning pursuant to Rule 616(4) when presenting his runner to race in non-approved gear.</p> <p>GUN LAW (J Morris) – Slow to begin.</p>	
Race 4	NIGEL ROBERTSON BUILDING HANDICAP (1400m)
<p>GOLD'NGURU (S Muniandy) – Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>WILD JACK (A Bohorun) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>ALL BLACK MAGIC (L Callaway) – Rider L Callaway was warned for his excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>DOCKET (K Williams) – Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.</p>	
Race 5	SHEET METALCRAFT HANDICAP (1200m)
<p>FULLTOTHEBRIM (J Laking) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>FEISTY JANE (K Williams) – When questioned regarding the performance rider K Williams could offer no tangible explanation other than the mare had not handled the bends comfortably today and in her opinion may now be looking for further distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.</p> <p>OUR CHARLIE (D Bothamley) – Got its head up when being restrained to take cover in the early stages. Held up for the majority of the run home, going to the line not fully tested by its rider.</p> <p>TAPONISME (L Callaway) – Got its head up when making the bend by the 800 metres awkwardly.</p> <p>IT'S PANDEMONIUM (K Kalychurun) – Slow to begin.</p>	

HE'S MI BROTHER (A Bohorun) – Raced wide through the early and middle stages.	
Race 6	goracing HANDICAP (1200m)
<p>DARCI MAC (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>TIMY TYLER (K Kwo) – Raced wide for the majority of the event.</p> <p>JOHNNY JONES (G Jogoo) – Raced wide and over-raced in the early stages and continued to over-race having to be restrained off heels passing the 700 metres. Lay out through the early stages of the run home having to be shifted wider on the track to find clear racing room.</p> <p>KING PIN (R Firdhaus) – Began awkwardly and was further hampered losing ground, when SHAARA shifted out at the start.</p> <p>SHAARA (K Mudhoo) – Had to be steadied off heels near the 800 metres when over-racing.</p>	
Race 7	AWS LEGAL SOUTHLAND CRYSTALS (2150m)
<p>GALLANT BOY (S Muniandy) – Raced keenly through the early stages.</p> <p>DEE AND GEE (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly and got back as a result.</p>	
Race 8	AON INSURANCE BROKERS HANDICAP (1600m)
<p>TEDDYTWINKLETOES (K Kwo) – Obligated to race wide from the 700 metres. Apprentice rider K Kwo was reminded of his obligations in regards to his use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>SMOKEM UP (S Wynne) – When questioned regarding the performance rider S Wynne reported that in her opinion the gelding was feeling the effects of recent racing.</p> <p>LEILA EVE (K Mudhoo) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>COUNTESS RUBY (S Muniandy) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance rider S Muniandy advised that in his opinion the mare had been unsuited by the firm nature of the track.</p> <p>LETTHETHUNDERROLL (R Firdhaus) – Held up rounding the final bend.</p>	
Race 9	TIM YEO CONTRACTING HANDICAP (1600m)
<p>MAGIC EPIC (R Firdhaus) – Crowded and had to steady passing the 1500 metres.</p> <p>THOUGHT THAT (S Wynne) – Crowded and had to steady passing the 1500 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider S Wynne could offer no tangible explanation.</p> <p>SHAKTI (K Mudhoo) – Held up rounding the final bend, having to be steadied off heels passing the 350 metres.</p> <p>WILLOW (C Barnes) – Shifted in passing the 1500 metres dictating LORD SIBFORD inwards crowding MAGIC EPIC and THOUGHT THAT with both these runners having to steady. Contributing to the crowding was FASCINATE which was also steadying back at this point to take a trailing position. After interviewing riders and viewing replays it could not be established that any one rider could be held accountable, however C Barnes was issued with a warning pursuant to Rule 638(1)(d) and advised that she must leave sufficient room for runners to her inside. Raced wide throughout. Shifted in passing the 200 metres and had to be straightened.</p> <p>INDIANA PEARL (R Cuneen) – Crowded shortly after the start and had to steady. When questioned regarding the performance rider R Cuneen advised the mare had traveled well during the running however when placed under pressure had failed to respond to his urgings.</p>	
Race 10	NZME HANDICAP (1600m)
<p>THE BELIEVER (R Cuneen) – Raced wide for the majority of the event.</p> <p>CAN YOU HEAR ME (L Callaway) – Brushed with SALLY GETCHA GUN passing the 50 metres.</p>	

BLUE FLAG (T Moseley) – When questioned regarding the performance rider T Moseley could offer no tangible explanation.

JAKAYA (S Muniandy) – When questioned regarding the performance rider S Muniandy advised the mare was unsuited by the tight turning nature of the track.

SALLY GETCHA GUN (J Morris) – Crowded momentarily and had to be steadied passing the 900 metres when THE BELIEVER (R Cuneen) which was improving forward pressured YODELAY inwards at this point. R Cuneen was advised to exercise care. Lay out throughout the final straight and brushed with CAN YOU HEAR ME passing the 50 metres. J Morris was reminded of her obligations to straighten her mounts sooner than she did so on this occasion.

LIMOUSINE (K Mudhoo) – Slow into stride and then lost contact with the body of the field through the middle stages despite the efforts of its rider.

WAIMATE BILL (A Bohorun) – Lay in throughout the final straight and had to be straightened passing the 75metres.
