GENERAL:

No issues to report.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 ATKINSON & DONALDSON PLUMBERS 2200

PENZERO (S Weatherley) – Steadied when placed in restricted room after becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of HOOPLA which lay out rounding the bend near the 1900 metres.

DEEJAY MAC (D Prastiyou) – Over-raced in the early stages before being allowed to improve forward three wide passing the winning post on the first occasion to sit outside the leader passing the 1000 metres, briefly steadied near the 150 metres to avoid the heels of MISS RIPPY which shifted inwards under pressure.

D Johnson – Issued with a warning after permitting her mount MISS RIPPY to shift inwards near the 150 metres when not fully clear of DEEJAY MAC.

REDCAYENNE (V Colgan) – Held up rounding the final bend then checked to avoid the heels of DEEJAY MAC near the 300 metres.

THE LAST SAMURAI (S Collett) – Crowded then checked near the 350 metres.

V Colgan – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount REDCAYENNE to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of THE LAST SAMURAI which was crowded then checked near the 350 metres. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended V Colgan's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Tuesday 2 January until the conclusion of racing on Thursday 11 January, 7 National riding days.

D Prastiyou – Suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing on Tuesday 2 January until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 10 January, 6 National riding days, after admitting a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount DEEJAY MAC to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of REDCAYENNE which was checked near the 300 metres.

Race 2 MACMILLAN ACCOUNTANTS 1215

LAURAMIA (J Fawcett) – Slow away, firmly restrained after improving onto the heels of the weakening CANTREL near the 350 metres then being held up for a short distance.

S Collett – Issued with a warning after permitting her mount SOUTH FORK to shift inwards shortly after the start when not fully clear of CANTREL which had to be steadied.

CANTREL (L Satherley) – Steadied to avoid the heels of SOUTH FORK shortly after the start, raced ungenerously when being restrained then racing three wide without cover from near the 900 metres.

SHE'STOOHOTTOTROT (S Weatherley) – When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion that the mare may be better suited stepping up in distance to 1400 metres and had recommended to connections the application of a tongue tie.

Race 3 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE

ORANGE SHORE (M Du Plessis) – Jumped away awkwardly.

PLEEZE BEE (A Jones) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SAIGNON (M Cameron) – Bumped near the 50 metres when HONNEUR NOIR shifted outwards to obtain clear running.

Race 4 LASER ELECTRICAL ROTORUA 1560

MONICA BELLE (L Satherley) – Slow away.

WORDOFMOUTH (S McKay) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

PALERMITANO (J Bayliss) – Raced ungenerously rounding the bend near the 1200 metres.

CASSIO (T Thornton) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1100 metres.

THE HEIRESS (S Weatherley) – Held up rounding the final turn and did not obtain clear running until near the 150 metres.

WRINKLE (M Cameron) – Steadied when weakening near the 300 metres, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelded would be better suited by more rain affected track conditions.

Race 5 DONELLEY SAWMILLING 1560

LADY ROSEANNE (M Du Plessis) – Jumped away awkwardly hampering CRAFTYEVA, lay out making the bend near the 1200 metres awkwardly, lay out rounding the final turn.

CRAFTYEVA (L Satherley) – Hampered start, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had been outpaced throughout with co-trainer A Forsman advising that CRAFTYEVA would be stepping up in distance for its next start.

PRINCESS SAPPHIRE (S Collett) – Crowded leaving the barriers.

PRODIGAL SON (L Innes) – Slow away, raced three wide without cover.

M Du Plessis (LADY ROSEANNE) – Issued with a warning for his use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 6 INTERISLANDER 1950

PASABAHCE (T Thornton) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages, held up near the 400 metres and did not obtain clear running until passing the 200 metres.

TOMMYRA (M Du Plessis) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages, steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 400 metres.

NEK MINNIT (J Bayliss) – Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room near the 150 metres.

THAILAND (S Collett) – When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuses advising that the mare had been disappointing, a post-race veterinary examination including endoscopic examination did not revel any abnormality.

Race 7 LANCE LAWSON 3YO

RITA AURA (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly making solid contact with ALTENARI then blundered badly dislodging its rider who was stood down from his remaining ride with bruising to his right leg.

ALTENARI (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly making solid contact with RITA AURA.

OUR SYDNEY (M Cameron) – Raced three wide without cover.

FASTELLIE (S Collett) – Held up for a distance passing the 200 metres.

Race 8 LIME CAFFETERIA 1400

NUTTEE – Declared a late scratching at 3:54pm as there was no replacement rider available for the injured S Weatherley.

BEN FERRARI (D Prastiyou) – Slow away.

ROYAL BALL (L Satherley) – Slow away.

INVITE ONLY (D Johnson) – Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 1200 metres.

CHAPOUTIER (J Bayliss) – Unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight going to the line untested.

SWISSKY (M Cameron) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

STIMPLYTHEBEST (A Jones) – Had a tendency to lay inwards under pressure in the final straight.
