Race 1	JARKS CITYSIDE MEMORIAL 2100 (2100 metres)	
KIRKENES (H Marzuki) - Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1800 metres.		

TAUTU (H Andrew) – Bumped with TROUP ROAD early in the home straight.

TROUP ROAD (R Jones) – Bumped early in the home straight.

K Mallyon (FASHIONABLY) –Issued with a warning regarding her use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

Track conditions upgraded to Good (3) retrospective to Race 1.

Race 2 IVAN GORDON MEMORIAL (1200 metres)

PITCH AND SWITCH (D Bradley) - Underwent and passed a veterinary inspection prior to the start after becoming fractious in the gates. Ducked inwards abruptly when struck with the whip approaching the 200 metres, briefly inconveniencing SO GLORIOUS.

TRENDSETTING (K Mallyon) - Slow away.

SILHOUETTE BEAUTY (R Jones) – Raced keenly in the early stages having to be restrained off the heels of AFTER FIVE when that runner shifted in near the 1000 metres when not the required distance clear. Stewards took into account the filly's tendency to over-race when assessing the degree of interference. Held up for a short distance passing the 250 metres, having to be angled outwards to gain clear running.

CABOCHON (L Satherley) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages. Continued to race greenly throughout.

EVA DAWN (M Singh) - Held up for a short distance approaching the 500 metres

Race 3 BEST TRAVEL 1200 (1200 metres)

SAVVY DREAMS (K Mallyon) – Slow away. Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

CHOUXPERB (H Andrew) - Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages.

Race 4 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400 metres)

UNUSUAL ACHIEVER (T Johnson) – Held up for a short distance passing the 500 metres. Bumped MAKEITRAIN when attempting a narrow run to the inside of THELMA passing the 200 metres.

MAKEITRAIN (H Marzuki) – Slow away. Bumped passing 200 metres. Had to be restrained off heels passing the 800 metres and when doing so shifted out inconveniencing MILSEAIN.

MILSEAIN (L Satherley) – Inconvenienced passing 800 metres.

TEMPTRESS (M Singh) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

ZENVO (K Mallyon) – Got its head up when being restrained in the early stages.

H Andrew (THELMA) – Issued with a warning regarding her use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

Race 5RUSSELL ROADS CITY OF HASTINGS CUP – FASTTRACK 5K (1300 metres)

Prior to the authorisation of dividends an objection was lodged by the connections of the 3rd placed PETITE EN JEU (M Singh) against the 2nd placed MORSE CODE (T Johnson) alleging interference in the home straight. After a JCA hearing the protest was upheld and placings now read 1st SCANDALO, 2nd PETITE EN JEU, 3rd MORSE CODE.

T Johnson (MORSE CODE) admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) and had his license to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Friday, 12th January up to and including Saturday, 20th January 2018 (6 days).

Race 6 KAHUNGUNU KAPA (1600 metres)

ROYAL RUBY (M Singh) – Slow away.

WIDE AWAKE (K Mallyon) – Awkwardly away.

PRINCESS SAPPHIRE (H Marzuki) - Three wide without cover throughout. Raced greenly over the final stages inconveniencing DANGEROUS PONY short of the line.

DANGEROUS PONY (U Holmquist) – Inconvenienced short of the line. Returned to the tie-ups with signs of possible heat stroke. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any significant abnormality other than a poor recovery.

Race 7 JIMMY RURAL 1400 (1400 metres)

PRINCESS RAAJ (H Marzuki) - Held up for some distance rounding the turn and near the 400 metres was angled out abruptly and in doing so tightened PINCANTO and WANDERING EYE, which both became unbalanced. **H Marzuki** admitted a breach of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) and had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 6 January up to and including racing on Saturday, 20 January 2018 (10 days).

SWISS PRECISION (H Andrew) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

H Andrew (SWISS PRECISION) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100metres. H Andrew had her licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 6th January up to and including Wednesday 17th January (8) days.

WANDERING EYE (K Mallyon – Slow away

COMMANDER (D Bradley) – Was not persevered with in the home straight, finishing last. Rider could offer no excuse.Race 8ROGER RUSSELL/CHARLIE KEENAN MEMORIAL (1600 metres)

CHAMPAGNE BRIDE (S MacNab) – Awkwardly away settling back.

JUNIOR (H Marzuki) – Slow away.

HE'S A FREAK (M Singh) – Held up approaching the 600 metres only gaining clear running inside the 200 metres.

MISS FOXY GIRL (D Bradley) – Lay in under pressure in the home straight.
