Held up rounding the turn and had to be angled wide near the 200 metres to improve.</p> <p><b>KATIE'S SO KOOL</b> (M Singh) – Slow away.</p> <p><b>PURE DAZE</b> (T Allan) – Raced greenly early and shortly after the start shifted in hampering <b>CASTANI</b>.</p> <p><b>FASCINO LASS</b> (T Johnson) - Inclined to shift in under pressure in the home straight.</p> <p><b>PICNIC BAY</b> (M Tanaka) - When questioned into the run of <b>PICNIC BAY</b> M Tanaka could offer no excuse.</p>

<p><b>ON THE HILL</b> (D Bradley) – Slow away.</p> <p><b>YEMANYA</b> (S MacNab) - Had to steady off heels for some distance passing the 1200 metres when racing keenly. Shifted in under pressure in the home straight.</p> <p><b>WOODBINE LADD</b> (T Johnson) - Taken forward near the 1000 metres after racing wide early.</p> <p><b>MALTESE RUBY</b> (J Fawcett) – Shifted in under pressure in the home straight.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>COTTER &amp; STEVENS MDN 2050M (2050 metres)</b>
<p><b>ROCK RULZ</b> (T Allan) - Shifted in on jumping away and bumped PRINCESS PAMME.</p> <p><b>PRINCESS PAMME</b> (S Collett) – Bumped at start.</p> <p><b>DAL KILCHOAN</b> (T Johnson) - Shifted in rounding the first turn tightening WEARE ROCKING. T Johnson was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p><b>GO ROXY</b> (H Andrew) – Hung outwards approaching the 400 metres.</p> <p><b>STUNNING</b> (M Tanaka) – Held up for some distance round the turn.</p> <p><b>WEAREROCKING</b> (R Myers) – Held up behind a tiring runner near the 300 metres prior to gaining clear running near the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>IRISH ENCHANTER</b> (M Singh) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>VALLEY PLUMBING MDN 1000M (1000 metres)</b>
<p><b>ROCCO BELLO</b> (J Fawcett) – Underwent and passed a veterinary inspection at the barrier after the rider considered the gelding may have been a little short in its action.</p> <p><b>TUDOR ANGEL</b> (J Bassett) – Slow away.</p> <p><b>VINNIE’S VOLLEY</b> (S Collett) - Inclined to lug outwards rounding the turn.</p> <p><b>T Allan</b> (MAGICO) – Spoken to regarding his use of the whip in the home straight.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>JACKSON ST BAR MDN 1300M (1300 metres)</b>
<p><b>MYSTIGAN</b>, late scratching on veterinary advice after becoming injured en route to the track.</p> <p><b>BOTANICAL</b> (J Fawcett) – Race greenly throughout and made the home turn awkwardly, clipped a heel of SARDEEN and blundered passing the 700 metres.</p>	

**PETITE MIDAS** (A Shin) - Raced greenly throughout and on the point of the home turn shied, unbalancing the rider.

**NAPOLEAN** (J Fawcett) – Raced wide throughout and had little left at the finish.
