RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	JACK CURRAGH MEMORIAL MAIDEN 1500m
<p>DALE (B Murray) - Escaped riderless on the way to the barriers and after travelling a short distance was caught and remounted. After a veterinary examination Dale was cleared fit to start. DALE layout passing the winning post the first time shifting wider on the track and eventually slipping and crashing through the outside rail and dislodging its rider. B Murray who was injured was attended to by the on-course paramedics and transported to Greymouth Hospital for observation. B Murray was stood down from his remaining rides. The connections of DALE were advised the horse would have to barrier trial on numerous occasions before returning to the races. Co- trainer P Harris advised that the gelding was retired as a racing proposition from his stable.</p> <p>PATRICIA ROSE (K Kalychurun) – Crowded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>COOKIE TIME (S MacNab) - Crowded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>NAKURU (R Firdhaus) - Restrained to take cover shortly after jumping. Momentarily steadied passing the 1400 metres when MADAM MAKFI (P Shaikh) shifted in when not fully clear. P Shaikh was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground.</p> <p>ZAH WANTED (J Laking) - Made the first bend awkwardly shifting wider on the track inconveniencing PRIZED PINS who was also taken wide on the track.</p> <p>PATRICIA ROSE (K Kalychurun) -Raced wide from the 800 metres.</p> <p>MADAM MAKFI (P Shaikh) - Contacted the running rail passing the 400 metres and became unbalanced momentarily.</p> <p>PRIZED PINS (D Hirini) – Forced wider on the track racing into the first turn. The rider D Hirini failed to weigh in following the conclusion of this race. The stewards sought a ruling under Rule 647(1) seeking disqualification of the gelding which had finished 2nd. After hearing from the stewards the JCA disqualified PRIZED PINS. Rider, D Hirini admitted a breach of Rule 647(1) in that she failed to weigh in and after hearing from all parties the JCA suspended her licence to ride from 13 January 2018 up to and including 10 February 2018 (4 weeks) as well as ordering the forfeiture of her riding fee under Rule 331 (2).</p>	
Race 2	GREG DALY REAL ESTATE MAIDEN 1500m
<p>TAVISTELLA (K Kalychurun) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>DOWRY DUTY (J Morris) -Made heavy contact with SKEDADDLE SKEDOO at the start.</p> <p>SKEDADDLE SKEDOO (C Campbell) – Contacted by DOWRY DUTY at the start.</p> <p>SWISS DREAM (K MUDHOO) - Slow away.</p> <p>LEULUAI (T Jonker) - Momentarily crowded when passing 1200 metres when POWERBALL who was racing greenly lay out and SAMMY LOU (S Wynne) who shifted in. S Wynne was advised to exercise greater care and give riders on the inside more room.</p> <p>POWERBALL (S MacNab) - Got its head up when over racing in the early stages. Continued to over race through the middle stages. Layout throughout the run home and passing the 50 metres shifted out dictating TUSOCK outwards onto LEULUAI with these two runners brushing momentarily. POWERBALL was immediately straightened by its rider.</p>	

Race 3	RAILWAY HOTEL GREYMOUTH RATING 85 1500m
<p>SHADOW KING (S MacNab) – Factious in its stall, began awkwardly and lost ground. Held up for several strides passing the 300 metres and got back with rider S McNab reporting that after losing ground at the start she had been unable to make any ground on the tight turning track over the concluding stages.</p> <p>EM KAY POPS (P Shaikh) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>ABSOLUT EXCELENCIA (R Firdhaus) - Made contact with BISOU BISOU passing the 1000 metres unbalancing the rider R Firdhaus who momentarily lost use of his outside iron.</p> <p>BISOU BISOU (D Hirini) – Racing keenly early stages and made contact with ABSOLUT EXCELENCIA passing the 1000 metres. Continued to over race for some distance after being bumped.</p>	
Race 4	DUNOLLIE HOTEL RATING 65 1500m
<p>BOYSWAY (D Hirini) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>CHIC (S MacNab) - Raced wide early and middle stages. Lay in on the bend near the 600 metres crowding JUSTICE WELL for several strides.</p> <p>JUSTICE WELL (J Laking) – Crowded at the 600 metres for several strides.</p> <p>SHOW LOVER (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Improved wide from the 500 metres. Had to be steadied for several strides passing the winning post on the first occasion when racing keenly.</p> <p>TENFOLD (G Jogoo) - Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres when attempting a marginal run on the inside of MYSTIFY ME.</p>	
Race 5	GREYMOUTH STAR RATING 65 1500m
<p>RICHIE ROX – Late scratched on veterinary advice after being found lame prior to the races.</p> <p>STITCH (S Wynne) - Bounded at the start. Had to be steadied momentarily passing the 500 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of HOT FUSS.</p> <p>GALWAY GARRY (C Campbell) – Slow to begin. Held up rounding the final bend.</p> <p>MOREIRA (K Mudhoo) – Taken back from a wide draw. Raced wide from the 800 metres.</p> <p>HOT FUSS (K Williams) – Raced wide early.</p> <p>GOLDEN BAY (J Laking) - Wide throughout.</p> <p>NUNCHUCKS (S MacNab) - Raced wide the majority of the event.</p> <p>IVANSKAVINSKYSKVAR (K Kalychurun) – Raced in restricted room for the majority for the run home and could not be ridden to full advantage.</p>	
Race 6	OMOTO SUPPORTERS CLUB MAIDEN 1100m
<p>SHE’S GRACEFUL (J Laking) – Crowded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>RUBY CHOUX ROSE (G Jogoo) – Blundered as the start was made.</p> <p>PRAWN STAR (S MacNab) - Improved wide from the 600 metres.</p>	
Race 7	PAROA HOTEL RATING 65 1100m
<p>FULLY PUMPED – Late scratching at 3.59pm due to veterinary advice after the gelding was found to be sore in near front leg. With the connections advised that a veterinary clearance required prior to racing again.</p>	

MASABIO (H Bennet) - Held up rounding the final bend and then again passing the 150 metres, only gaining clear racing room in the final 50 metres. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary inspection of MASABIO which revealed no abnormalities.

GREEN SPIRIT (J Morris) - Raced wide early then raced keenly for a distance passing the 700 metres. Bumped by inside runner at 350 metres becoming momentarily unbalanced. Crowded and had to steady passing the 250 metres when MILK IT (K Mudhoo) shifted in marginally on the point of the turn. K Mudhoo was advised to exercise greater care.

MAJORCA (K Kalychurun) – Had to be firmly restrained off heels passing the 350 metres shifting out bumping with GREEN SPIRIT.

MIA MAMMA (R Beeharry) – Raced keenly while leading through the early to middle stages. Lay in for the majority in the run home, shifting in passing the 125 metres when struck with the whip and had to be straightened.

Race 9	RECREATIONAL HOTEL GREYMOUTH CUP 2000m

SON OF ZAC (S Wynne) – Slow to begin. Raced wide from the 800 metres.

SHOW MACCOOL (C Campbell) – Attempted to improve wide from the 1200 metres. Raced keenly over the middle stages. Finished a distant last with the rider reporting, in his opinion that the gelding had choked down. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities.

THE GORDONIAN (K Mudhoo) – Wide early. Held up rounding the final bend.

OVERTHERIVER (S MacNab) – Raced keenly early to middle stages. Rider S MacNab reported the gelding had raced too keenly in the early stages and had only battled over the concluding stages as a result.

DEE AND GEE (T Jonker) – Held up rounding the final bend and became awkwardly placed on heels of THE GORDONIAN passing the 125 metres having to shift outwards to find clear racing room.

STORMY HABIT (P Shaikh) – Held up for several strides passing the 175 metres.

FERAL ICE (K Mudhoo) – Crowded and checked shortly after the start when RUBY ROW shifted in. S Wynne admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) with Careless Riding with the JCA suspending her licence to ride from 11th January 2018 up to and including 16th January 2018 – 5 national days.

PAYMENT PENDING (L Callaway) – Wide early to middle stages.

POINT PROVEN (K Kwo) – Stepped outwards abruptly after contacting the running rail passing the 400 metres bumping with EN SUITE. Became awkwardly placed when on the heels of PICKUP and had to steady in the shadows of the post.

SUNSET GIRL (K Williams) – Outpaced throughout with the rider reporting the mare had made abnormal breathing noises. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities. Trainer reported that the mare had its tongue over the bit.
