Race 1	WANGANUI FUNCTION CENTRE MAIDEN 2040 (2040 metres)	
TURFSHAKER	(M Tanaka) - Shifted our abruptly at the start hampering HEZA DUKE.	
HEZA DUKE (T	Allan) – Hampered at start.	
WEARE ROCKING (R Myers) and PEEWEE – Bumped near the 1800 metres.

LA PHYTA (A Collett) – Raced keenly on a slow pace in the early stages shifting outwards off heels rounding the bend near the near the 1300 metres to a three wide position being allowed to improve forward near the 1000 metres. When questioned A Collett advised that she elected to attempt to improve forward due to the slow pace of the race but had then been caught wide when riders to her inside had increased the tempo, following which the mare had been unable to finish the race off.

FLYBOY (D Turner) - Finished some distance last. Connections advised the gelding would no longer be a racing proposition from the stable.

ELOQUENCE (C Lammas) - Inclined to shift in near the 100 metres and had to be straightened.

 SPOONERS DRY CLEANING 2040 (2040 metres)

 KEEPING FAITH –M Singh replaced S O'Malley (unable to make weight), jumped away awkwardly.

S O'Malley (KEEPING FAITH) – Spoken to in the presence of his employer with regard to failing to make the weight and on this occasion was issued with a warning.

FISTFULOFDOLLARS (M Tanaka) - Jumped away awkwardly.

JOVANNI (C Johnson) – Raced three wide without cover.

DANDEEDEE (S Collett) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages, bumped near 1800 metres when EL JODI (T Allan) shifted inwards with DANDEEDEE continuing to race ungenerously and making further contact with EL JODI. T Allan was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground. Had to be steadied abruptly near the 600 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of EL JODI. Got its head up near the 400 metres when being checked to avoid the heels of FITSFULOFDOLLARS.

STELLACANTO (S McKay) – Raced ungenerously for a distance when being steadied passing the 1800 metres.

SO IT WAS (M McNab) – Held up rounding the final turn until near the 400 metres.

Race 3 G BRISTOL & SONS MAIDEN 1200 (1200 metres)

EIGHT MILE (C Dell) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground, steadied to avoid the heels of LEDGOWAN which shifted inwards approaching the 1000 metres when not fully clear. D Bradley was advised to exercise care.

LEDGOWAN (D Bradley) – Jumped away awkwardly.

PARKA'S LADY (A Jones) – Raced very ungenerously when being restrained after being placed in restricted room to the inside of LUCIDITY which shifted inwards slightly to avoid the heels of DU'BLUES shortly after the start. PARKA'S LADY continued to race ungenerously making the bend near the 1000 metres awkwardly. When questioned A Jones advised that the filly had raced greenly throughout and been very field shy.

Race 4 RACE IMAGES-VISIT YOUR HORSE AT RACEIMAGES.CO.NZ 1200 (1200 metres)

BOSS (R Myers) – Very slow to begin.

GAMEPLAN (C O'Beirne) – Very slow away.

BOOK SMART (M Singh) – Had to be firmly restrained after improving on to heels rounding the bend approaching the 600 metres, held up passing the 400 metres before shifting outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.

LINCOLN STAR (A Collett) – Steadied when placed in restricted room between COUP BRADMAN and BOSS approaching the 200 metres when both those runners shifted ground slightly.

PETITE MIDAS (M Tanaka) – Rider dropped his whip near the 250 metres.

Race 5 MANELY HORSE 1200 (1200 metres)

CHOUXPERB (S Collett) – Slow away. Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 200 metres.

VINCENT (J Nason) – Raced three wide without cover.

Race 6 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1340 (1340 metres)

OUR WONDER – Late scratching @ 2.10pm on veterinary advice, after suffering an injury on the horse transporter.

UNUSUAL ACHIEVER (C Johnson) – Slow away.

LOST FLAG (A Jones) – Slow away.

VELOCE (M Tanaka) – Made contact with KATHY'S LINCOLN on a number of occasions rounding the bend from the 500 metres with KATHY'S LINCOLN being bumped on to SWIFT SAOIRSE, which was forced wider near the 400 metres. M Tanaka was advised to exercise care. Hampered approaching the 100 metres.

KATHY'S LINCOLN (A Shin) - Bumped on a number of occasions rounding the bend from the 500 metres.

SWIFT SAOIRSE (D Bradley) - Bumped and forced over ground near the 400 metres.

LISBETH (S Collett) - Held up entering the final straight near the 300 metres, again held up passing the 200 metres and when shifting outwards to obtain clear running, hampered VELOCE near the 100 metres. S Collett was advised to exercise greater care. Contributing to this incident was some minor inward movement from SWIFT SAOIRSE.

REALM (S McKay) – When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the filly had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 7 RACINGTIPS.CO.NZ. MAIDEN 1340 (1340 metres)

HE'S RIC (A Jones) – Jumped away awkwardly.

ENGLISH ROSE (C Lammas) – Jumped away awkwardly.

ARIDITY (J Nason) – Steadied approaching the bend near the 1000 metres.

DARSHARP PRINCESS (R Myers) – Inclined to lug inwards in the home straight.

Race 8 CRAIG CONNELL 10 YEAR ANNIVERSARY 1600 (1600 metres)

MIKJENE (M Tanaka) – Made the first turn awkwardly.

JACKSON ROAD (D Turner) – Made the first turn awkwardly.

ELEGANT D'ORO (M McNab) - When questioned into the disappointing run M McNab said that after getting back the mare could not make up any discernable ground over the final stages. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 9	COMMDIVES NZ MAIDEN 1600 (1600 metres)

MASSIVE MISSIVE (C Johnson) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early to middle stages.

STAR QUALITY (S Collett) – Raced three wide without cover.

HEEL BE JAKE (A Jones) – Steadied when over-racing passing the 800 metres.

CANDY BELT (C-M Waddell) - Raced up on to heels near the 100 metres and had to angle outwards to improve.

LITTLE MAJELLA (D Bradley) - Rider reported that the mare had felt indifferent in its action, with a post-race veterinary inspection not revealing any obvious abnormality.

LAST MAN STANDING (C Lammas) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding had overraced when stepping up in distance and had been unable to finish the race off.

Race 10

WANGANUI RACEHORSE OWNERS ASSOCIATION 1600 (1600 metres)

SOIREE (M Singh) – Commenced to over-race going into the bend near the 1300 metres, continuing to do so through the middle stages, racing wide throughout.

TERASEEDA (D Bradley) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages, inconvenienced when weakening passing the 150 metres when SILVER MISSILE shifted out to obtain clear running.

WOTAMISSION (C Dell) - Raced three wide throughout.
