BEASTMODE (J Parkes) – Trainer A Campbell advised Stewards that following its performance in this race the colt had been jarred up in front, adding it is his intention to freshen BEASTMODE prior to racing next.

ROYAL SUCCESS (C Lammas) – Trainer J Richards advised Stewards that the gelding would be freshen and undergo further veterinary examination prior to racing next.

Race 6 KAHUNGUNU KAPA (1600 metres)

DANGEROUS PONY (U Holmquist) – Trainer S Ritchie advised Stewards that the mare has been sent for a spell.

Race 8 NEW WORLD TE PUKE 1300

GOTHENBURG (J Waddell) – Trainer D Guy advised Stewards that she was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding and it is her intention to continue on with its current preparation.

Race 9 GARTSHORE 1600

ROC WHEELER (M Cameron) – Trainer A Forsman advised Stewards that the gelding has been sent for a spell and would most likely trial prior to racing next.

Race 5 NZB Insurance Pearl Series

BITS AND PIECES (M Coleman) – Trainer K Kelso advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the filly and it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 WEXFORD STABLES 1600

MONREITH MOYRA (V Gatu) - Began awkwardly then crowded losing ground. Over raced in the early stages having to be restrained off heels for a distance approaching the 1200 metres.

SEO LINN (J Nason) - Began awkwardly. Had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the final straight.

BARZELLAR (C Lammas) - Raced three wide without cover. Commenced to lay in early in the final straight and had to be steadied near the 200 metres after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of CAMEO (S Spratt) which shifted out in an attempt to obtain clear running with BARZELLAR then being held up for a distance. S Spratt was advised to exercise care.

VERSES (T Yanagida) - Held up until passing the 200 metres.

SAILING (L Satherley) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 100 metres.

THATLADYROCS (A Collett) – Steadied passing the 200 metres when placed in restricted room to the outside of SHE'S ICE COLD which ducked outwards abruptly despite the efforts of its rider. Also inconvenienced as a result was AMPLIO.

AMPLIO (J Bayliss) - Inconvenienced passing the 200 metres.

FLYING TRAPEZE (D Johnson) - When question regarding performance, rider D Johnson could not offer any excuse

Race 2 STABLE BOOKS 1600

BRIDE TO BE (J Waddell) - Slow to begin. Held up rounding the final bend. Then had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.

KING OF THE DANCE (M McNab) - Began awkwardly making contact with another runner.

DAZED AND CONFUSED (C Lammas) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

MARQUITA MISS (M Du Plessis) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

UNNAMEABLE (A Collett) - Hampered passing the 1400 metres when crowded by HARRY DUNNE (L Satherley) which shifted in when not fully clear then raced ungenerously for a distance. L Satherley was advised to exercise care. Checked near the 100 metres.

L Satherley - Admitted a breach of careless riding, in that she allowed her mount HARRY DUNNE to shift out near the 100 metres when not sufficiently clear of UNNAMEABLE which was checked with the Judicial Committee suspending L Satherley's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 17 January until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 24 January, 5 National riding days.

CARICATURE (L Innes) – Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

LEWIS ROAD (S Collett) - Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages.

Race 3 OHUKIA LODGE 1400

SHOW ME YOUR PINS (T Abel) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Crowded for a distance passing the 1100 metres.

LAURAMIA (E McCall) - Became awkwardly placed on heels soon after leaving the barrier then steadied. Checked after improving into restricted room when the pace steadied near the 1100 metres.

CORLEONE (J Nason) - Over raced in the early stages.

NORMANDY (T Newman) - Raced three wide without cover.

JEWEL OF PATCH (T Yanagida) - Held up rounding the bend and early in the final straight.

AMEN CORNER (A Schwerin) - Raced ungenerously for a distance when the paced eased approaching the 1100 metres. Received veterinary attention for lacerations to the hind legs consistent with being galloped on.

S McKay (SMART THINKING) - Issued with a warning for the manner in which he reduced the pace passing the 1100 metres with AMEN CORNER becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SMART THINKING then having to shift in crowding LAURAMIA which had improved into restricted room. Hampered as a result was SHOW ME YOUR PINS.

Race 4 BAKER RACING 1100

DUBLIN ROSE (S Collett) - Raced wide in the early stages.

CYBER ATTACK (V Colgan) - Became briefly unbalanced when approaching the 300 metres when contacted by HANDSOME REBEL (M McNab) which had shifted out to obtain clear running. M McNab was advised to exercise greater care.

MAARA GRANGE REHABILITATION FACILITY 1200

WINNIE'S RAINBOW (M McNab) – Began awkwardly. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

SLOW HANDS (J Waddell) - Slow to begin.

Race 5

OUR MCKAY (D Johnson) – Slow to begin.

GOING PRO (M Coleman) - Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after.

EXCELSIOR ISLAND (M Du Plessis) - Raced in restricted room and steadied passing the 1000 metres.

DUDEWITHATTITUDE (T Thornton) - Had to be steadied after becoming awkwardly paced on heels passing the 1000 metres.

HENLEY ROAD (R Norvall) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

HEAVENLY GOLD (A Jones) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

SHOW 'N' GO (S Collett) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

Race 6 CHELTENHAM STABLES 1100

SMART PATCH (J Bayliss) - Slow to begin. Had to shift out near the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

PONSONBY ROAD (D Johnson) - Crowded leaving the barrier. Steadied when placed in restricted room over the concluding stages.

PWERFECT (C Lammas) - Crowded and hampered leaving the barrier losing ground. Held up over the concluding stages.

PINK GRAFFITI (L Innes) - Began awkwardly. Hampered when placed in restricted room near the 500 metres.

OCEAN RULER (S McKay) - Raced ungenerously when being steadied passing the 800 metres.

SHEEZNOTEASY (T Thornton) - Lay out rounding the final bend.

Race 7 NRB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES

GLASS SLIPPER (S Spratt) - Knuckled leaving the barrier. Became awkwardly placed on heels for a distance passing the 200 metres.

VOLEUSE (S McKay) - Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after.

LOVERS LANE (J Waddell) - Slow to begin. Had to shift out passing the 100 metres to obtain clear running.

SCARLETT PRINCESS (M McNab) - Slow to begin. Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1100 metres having to be restrained.

TATTYBOGLER (S Collett) - Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

ASYLUM SEEKER (S McKay) - Slow to begin.

REBEL REBEL (J Nason) - Began awkwardly then hampered.

CHIARA (A Collett) - Commenced to over race passing the 1700 metres becoming awkwardly placed on heels and was hampered when being restrained.

HELLO SAILOR (M McNab) - Raced wide in the early stages before being allowed to improve forward passing the 1000 metres.

SHOCKOOL (L Innes) - Raced wide for the majority of the race. Crowded when weakening passing the 300 metres.

FIREFLY (D Johnson) - Held up entering the final straight.

KANE (J Bayliss) - Inconvenienced near the 150 metres by BOUNDARY which lay in.

Race 9STABLE BOOKS SUPPORTING NZ TRAINERS 2000TAKE IT OUT (A Schwerin) - Slow to begin.

JUD STRUCK (E McCall) – Slow to begin.

DOUBTLESS PRINCESS (J Nason) – Slow to begin.

STAR ELLA (S McKay) - Briefly crowded passing the 1700 metres by RUB IT IN which shifted out to avoid the heels of LINK ROAD.

DONNA ANNE BILLY (T Yanagida) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

ALL RAZZLE DAZZLE (A Sims) - Held up over the concluding stages.
