RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 WILD BUCK NZ ALE MAIDEN 2000m

NAKURU (S Collett) - Slow to begin.

JUSTRUSH (T Jonker) - Wide early stages.

COWBOYS DONT CRY (K Williams) - Lay out from the start and ran off on the bend passing the 1500m and was retired from the event. The connections were advised the gelding must barrier trial prior to racing next. Trainer P Robson advised she would send the gelding for a spell before returning to the trials.

MACARIO (A Morgan) - Gave ground quickly from the 500m and faulted in its action at the 400m and was dismounted and led back to the birdcage with a Veterinary Inspection revealing a near fore suspensory injury.

NANCY (K Mudhoo) - Became awkwardly placed on the heels of the quickly tiring MACARIO with 250m to run clipping a

heel and unbalancing rider K Mudhoo who was dislodged. Neither horse nor rider was injured in this incident.

LATE NOTICE (C Campbell) - Wide throughout. Hampered when avoiding the fallen rider with 250m to run.

DOWRY DUTY (J Morris) - Rider advised the mare failed to breathe during the event with the trainer advising they would be adding a tongue tie for its next start.

PATRICIA ROSE (L Callaway) - When spoken to regarding the performance of the favoured runner, rider L Callaway reported the mare had felt indifferent in its action throughout. Stewards requested a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed no abnormalities.

Race 2 GREG DALY REAL ESTATE RATING 65 2000m

PAYMENT PENDING (K Kwo) - Began very awkwardly, badly unbalancing the rider momentarily.

PENNY PERFECT (C Johnson) - Wide early stages.

SWEET INDULGE (K Williams) - Wide early stages.

SHOCKTILLYOUDROP (J Laking) – Got its head up when over racing in the early stages. Momentarily held up passing the 200 metres.

BACHATA (L Callaway) – Over raced early stages and had to shift outwards off heels passing the 1500 metres taking RESEDALE wider on the track.

ST MALO (T Jonker) – Raced wide from the 1200 metres and forced wider on the home turn when KEEP THE LOT shifted out.

EN SUITE (C Campbell) - Obliged to improve very wide from the 700 metres.

Race 3 VERNON & VAZEY TRUCK PARTS MAIDEN 1020m

ICEBERG ROCK (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin, tailed the field throughout with rider advising the gelding was looking for more distance.

OUR GOLDEN GIRL (C Campbell) –Began awkwardly losing ground.

SMOKE 'N PUMPKIN (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

SUPAGILI (J Laking) – Wide throughout.

RUBY CHOUX ROSE (G Jogoo) – Wide throughout.

PRAWN STAR (S MacNab) – Obliged to improve very wide from the 400 metres.

SMILE (P Shaikh) - Held up rounding the final bend and had to steady momentarily passing the 300 metres.

MIACOCA (K Williams) – Momentarily held up rounding the bend passing the 300 metres.

Race 4 REEFTON CRANE & CONSTRUCTION RATING 65 1020m

OUR TEDDY BOY (C Campbell) - Commenced to buck shortly after the start, dislodging its rider. C Campbell was attended to by the St John's paramedics and cleared to continue riding. Connections advised the gelding must barrier trial prior to racing next.

RED TIARA (T Jonker) – Clipped a heel and blundered, losing momentum passing the 200 metres when improving quickly onto the heels of the tiring FLASH SUGGESTION.

Race 5 TASMAN AGRICULTURE RATING 75 2000m

SPEEDY JAX (T Jonker) - Blundered at the start unbalancing the rider and shifted out making firm contact with LADY LINDAEUR with both these runners losing ground at the start. Crowded and had to steady at 1500 metres when QUEEN SERENE shifted inwards to avoid the heels of LONG HARBOUR which was being steadied at this point.

LADY LINDAEUR (C Campbell) – Buffeted at the start losing ground.

CHIC (S MacNab) – Raced wide for the majority of the event.

LONG HARBOUR (C Johnson) – Had to be restrained off heels passing the 1500 metres when racing keenly.

CAN YOU HEAR ME (L Callaway) - Shifted in under pressure passing the 200 metres buffeting and unbalancing FLORENCE IVY momentarily. Rider L Callaway was advised to exercise greater care.

FLORENCE IVY (S Collett) – Buffeted and unbalanced passing the 200 metres.

MINERVA (R Firdhaus) – Lay out rounding the final bend shifting wider on the track. Continued to lay out throughout the run home.

Race 6 FASTTRACK \$5K 2000m

STORMY HABIT (P Shaikh) – Slow to begin and improved four wide from the 700 metres.

SHADOW KING (S MacNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

LOCALLY SAUCED (C Johnson) – Raced keenly through the early to middle stages.

FERAL ICE (H Bennet) – Raced in restricted room momentarily passing the 500 metres.

POINT PROVEN (K Kwo) – Rider issued a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(i) using his whip when the runner was out of contention.

Race 7 ELECTRONET MAIDEN 1400m

SUMPIN LEICA DAD (H Bennet) – Slow to begin. Ran very wide on the track racing into the first bend and tailed the field throughout with rider H Bennet reporting the filly had hung outwards throughout and proved difficult to control. The connections were advised the filly must barrier trial prior to racing.

SKEDADDLE SKEDOO (C Campbell) - Began awkwardly and lost ground. Held up for several strides passing the 150 metres.

KEYBOARD WARRIOR (T Jonker) – Slow through the early stages and tailed the field for the majority of the event. Rider T Jonker reported that the gelding had been flat throughout and had raced greenly. She also added that in her opinion, the gelding was looking for wetter tracks.

OUR BOY BAZ (B Murray) – Made the first bend awkwardly shifting wider on the track. Under pressure and lost contact with the field passing the 500 metres.

POWERBALL (S MacNab) – Had to be restrained off heels passing the 800 metres.

COOKIE TIME (K Kwo) – Held up rounding the final bend.

PLATINUM RAIDER (R Firdhaus) – Crowded and had to steady momentarily passing the 900 metres when SENSIBILITY (L Callaway) improved forward and inwards marginally at this point. L Callaway was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground. Raced three wide from the 700 metres.

SENSIBILITY – Found with blood in both nostrils post-race and with a endoscopic examination revealing the mare was not a bleeder and had suffered an injury consistent with banging its head on the float.

Race 8 EVELYN CARRAN MEMORIAL REEFTON CUP 1400m

THE REAL DEAL (B Hong) – Began awkwardly and lost ground. Made the first bend awkwardly and shifted up the track forcing FLYING SARDINE and OVERTHERIVER wider on the track passing the 1100 metres. This resulted in the trailing PRETTY GOOD EXCUSE also being forced wider to avoid heels of OVERTHERIVER who in turn dictated TWOZNOTENOUGH wider on the track at this point. Then began to race fiercely passing the 1000 metres and had to be severally restrained off the heels of the runner in front. Continued to race keenly and had to be restrained again passing the 700 metres.

DYNAMIC (K Gundowry) – Knuckled on jumping away losing some momentum

ELECTRONIC MOTION (R Firdhaus) - Raced wide into the first bend and was then obliged to race wide for the majority of the race.

PRETTY GOOD EXCUSE (K Williams) – Forced wide at the first bend.

TWOZNOTENOUGH (S Collett) – Forced wide at the first bend.

OVERTHERIVER (S MacNab) – Dictated wider 1100 metres. Raced in restricted room rounding the final bend.

FLYING SARDINE (C Campbell) – Dictated wider 1100 metres.

Race 9 FAHEY CONTRACTING RATING 65 1400m

MOREIRA (K Mudhoo) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

MASABIO (H Bennet) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Made the first bend awkwardly dictating MINUTES TO MIDNITE wider on the track. Raced wide from the 1000 metres.

MINUTES TO MIDNITE (T Jonker) - Shifted out at the start. Forced wider at the first bend. Lost contact with the field passing the 700 metres despite the efforts of the rider. When spoken to rider T Jonker advised that after being forced wider on the track racing into the first bend and then having to be restrained to take cover the gelding had not travelled well and had been disappointing and could offer no other tangible excuses.

CARNABY (G Jogoo) - Had to be steadied when over-racing passing the 1000 metres. Raced four wide from the 600 metres.

SAMMI LOU (C Johnson) – Held up rounding the final bend.

GALWAY GARRY (B Murray) – Held up rounding the final bend. Had to shift ground outwards passing the 100 metres to find clear racing room.

Race 10 MOLLOY & ASSOCIATES CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS RATING 65 1400m

BOYSWAY (S MacNab) - Slow to begin.

JUSTICE WELL (J Laking) - Wide throughout.

THATZ LOUIE (P Shaikh) –Became awkwardly placed on heels and had to be steadied passing the 600 metres and again passing the 400 metres with the trailing PROMISING having to be steadied at this point.

PROMISING (B Murray) – Steadied off heels at 400 metres.

Race 11 BIRCHFIELD COAL MINES RATING 75 1400m

HIGHBROOK (S MacNab) – Knuckled at the start.

EM KAY POPS (P Shaikh) – Fractious in its stall prior to the start then began awkwardly losing ground. Jumped the crossing at the 1150 metres.

WHAT'S UP ALF (B Murray) – Awkwardly placed on the heels of BISOU BISOU passing the 1100 metres and had to shift wider on the track and in doing so forced FLICKA OF GOLD wider.

FLICKA OF GOLD (C Campbell) – Forced wider on the track at the 1100 metres and then obliged to race wide through the middle stages.

MILK IT (K Mudhoo) – Rider dropped the whip passing the 300 metres.
