LITTLE MAJELLA (D Bradley) – Trainer C Cromarty advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the mare and it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

## Race 3 - EL CHEAPO CARS PREMIER (1200 metres)

EUPHORIA (M Du Plessis) – Trainer R Frost advised Stewards that EUPHORIA underwent a veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination in the days following its performance in this race which revealed the mare to be slightly lame in the left front leg.

CHANCE TO DANCE (O Bosson) – Trainer J Richards advised that the gelding would now be sent for a spell.

Race 3 - Bidfood 1200

NUCLEONIC (O Bosson) – Trainer J Richards advised that he was satisfied with the recovery of the filly, adding it is now their intention to freshen NUCLEONIC prior to racing next and look for some easing in the ground.

#### Race 4 - 0800 Horsevets 1500

EVER LOYAL (J Waddell) – Trainer T Pike advised that he would be changing the bit back to the Norton bit previously used after it travelled too keenly in this race.

# Race 1 CAMPBELL INFRASTRUCTURE 1215

**COLOGNE** (D Johnson) - Slow to begin.

**DEVIANT MISS** (A Schwerin) - Slow to begin, raced wide throughout.

THORNBURY (R Norvall) - Slow to begin.

**GORANA** (S McKay) - Slow to begin, rider was unable to offer any excuses for the mare's poor performance with trainer P Lock advising that GORANA would not be persevered with as a racing proposition.

**IFFIDA** (C Lammas) - Raced keenly in the early stages before having to be firmly restrained after becoming awkwardly placed when improving inside the heels of NUTTEE (L Satherley) which shifted inwards when being steadied near the 900 metres. L Satherley was advised to exercise care.

**EENY MEENY MINY MO** (A Collet) - Raced three wide without cover.

**RUBY RUEBEN** (A Jones) - When question regarding performance, rider advised that the gelding would be better suited by more rain affected conditions.

## Race 2 BURTON CONSTRUCTION 1215

ICHIBAN (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly.

ABOVE ALL (S Collett) - Slow to begin.

**HONKIETONK TIGER** (L Satherley) - Raced wide without cover.

**EPROUVEZ** (M McNab) - Over raced when being restrained passing the 800 metres.

# Race 3 POMARE ELECTRICAL 1100

**MASKA** (J Nason) - Slow to begin quickly becoming tailed off and remaining so throughout with the rider reporting that the gelding felt reluctant to hit out, a post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality with trainer M Forbes being advised that MASKA must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.

**BAHAMAS** (T Thornton) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**ARRIVO** (T Abel) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

# Race 4 ARAWA PARK FUNCTION ROOMS 1950

**DUKE STREET** (T Thornton) - Slow away, over raced badly in the early to middle stages.

**ANARCHY** (M McNab) - Crowded start when SPECTRA jumped outwards.

**VINAROS** (S McKay) - Raced wide around the first turn when improving forward.

**DEEJAY MAC** (D Prastiyou) - Badly held up rounding the bend near the 400 metres and did not obtain clear running until near the 125 metres.

AIGNE (T Allan) - Held up early in the final straight.

**J Riddell** - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount TENSILE to shift outwards passing the 200 metres when not fully clear of PONT ALMA which had to steady near the 175 metres.

PONT ALMA (J Bayliss) - Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 175 metres.

### Race 5 RYDGES HOTEL ROTORUA 1950

**LADY ROSEANNE** (T Thornton) - Lay out rounding the first bend.

**DEFER** (A Jones) - Raced wide rounding the first bend, hampered when weakening near the 100 metres.

MISS RIPPY (D Johnson) - Firmly restrained having to shift out to avoid heels passing the winning post on the first occasion crowding DOUBTLESS PRINCESS, had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.

**DOUBTLESS PRINCESS** (J Waddell) - Crowded 1600 metres, lost the right front plate during the running.

**TOUCH OF SILVER** (J Bayliss) - Raced wide throughout then being asked to improve forward from the 900 metres, when questioned regarding his ride J Bayliss advised that he had been instructed to ride the gelding back in the field and to commence a run from the 800 metres but after being unable to gain any cover, had elected to improve forward in the manner he did.

**ARTISTE** (M Cameron) - Held up behind the weakening KEEN TO KEEPER rounding the bend near the 450 metres, briefly held up entering the final straight before being badly held up passing the 200 metres and continuing to have difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 50 metres.

### Race 6 ISCL 1400

**ROUGH CONDUCT** (T Thornton) - Over-raced in the middle stages having to shift ground outwards to avoid heels approaching the 850 metres inconveniencing DON'TBLAMETHEMUSIC.

**DON'TBLAMETHEMUSIC** (T Newman) - Inconvenienced approaching the 850 metres.

# Race 7 NZRB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE

**CABOCHON** (L Satherley) - Began awkwardly losing ground, held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight.

EN SOIE (J Waddell) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**CHIQUITITA** (S Collett) - When questioned regarding performance, rider was of the opinion that the filly may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

**SUNRISE RUBY** (S Spratt) - When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that the filly had travelled well but had failed to respond when placed under pressure and had been disappointing.

### Race 8 MACMILLAN ACCOUNTANTS 1400

**SECRET DREAMS** (L Satherley) - Raced three wide without cover.

**NO DOUBT A STAR** (T Thornton) - When questioned regarding performance, rider could offer no excuses other than the gelding not being suited racing amongst other runners back in the field after being unable to take up a more prominent position and not feeling entirely comfortable in today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.
