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RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MURRAY CONTRACTORS MAIDEN (1100 Metres)
DALLA MOSA (S Collett) – Jumped outwards at the start contacting ROCCO BELLO, raced keenly in the early to middle stages then held up for a distance rounding the final turn having to be angled outwards early in the home straight to gain clear running, brushed with GARMENT near the 250 metres.	
ROCCO BELLO (D Johnson) – Bumped at start, raced keenly in the early stages.	

GARMENT (R Myers) – Awkwardly away. Had to be restrained off heels approaching the 800 metres. Brushed 250 metres.

MIGHTY MOUSE (H Andrew) – Bumped at start then raced three wide without cover throughout. Trainer advised the mare had lost the offside front plate during the running.

ROCCO BELLO (D Johnson) - When questioned into the disappointing run of ROCCO BELLO, D Johnson had no tangible excuse. Co-Trainer S Ramsay advised the gelding would be spelled. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

Race 2 | **MCI & ASSOCIATES MAIDEN (1200 Metres)**

BELLE TEM (D Turner) – Held up for a short distance passing the 500 metres and again entering the home straight, gaining clear running passing the 100 metres.

MOLIZLAD (M Singh) – Raced greenly in the home straight when under pressure.

SURVEILLANCE (D Johnson) – Lay outwards approaching the 200 metres having to be straightened briefly inconveniencing DRUM RISE which was improving to its outside, raced greenly over the final stages.

DRUM RISE (A Jones) – Inconvenienced approaching 200 metres.

TAVIJAZZ (S Collett) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

DARSHARP PRINCESS (J Parkes) – When questioned regarding performance, rider advised the filly may prefer some easing in the ground.

Race 3 | **THE TARARUA CLUB MAIDEN (1400 Metres)**

BELLE GOSSE (D Johnson) – Late scratched at the barrier after becoming fractious in the gates and was found to be lame in the right hind leg. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required and the mare must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to next racing.

RAVENHILL (A Jones) – Very slow away (3L).

TURFSHAKER (M Tanaka) – Bumped 1000 metres, raced wide without cover throughout.

DANCING AURIOLE (C Dell) – Racing keenly in the early stages and when being restrained, shifted outwards bumping TURFSHAKER near the 100 metres.

TINY TOT (S MacNab) - Held up for a short distance passing the 500 metres.

Race 4 | **PRENTERS READY MIX CONCRETE RATING 65 (1400 Metres)**

TURNCOAT (J Parkes) – Slow away. When questioned into the disappointing performance, rider advised the gelding may appreciate more easing in the going.

PERFECT SHOCK (D Turner) – Got its head up when being restrained in the early stages and then raced wide throughout.

LISTOWEL (M Singh) - Held up rounding the home turn.

WAFER (S Collett) – Awkwardly away. Briefly inconvenienced when TIPPING POINT (R Myers) shifted out near the 200 metres. Prior to the authorisation of dividends connections viewed footage but elected not to proceed with an

objection. It was considered TIPPING POINT shifted out further than R Myers intended.

Race 5 | **GOLDEN BAY CEMENT 3YO MAIDEN (1400 Metres)**

PHYLLTHEPOWER – Late scratching at 8.30am on veterinary advice. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to PHYLLTHEPOWER next racing.

TELSETTE (C Dell) – Slow away.

LINCOLN DREAMER (M Tanaka) – Slow away.

BALANTO (D Turner) - Tightened shortly after the start and got back. Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

HE'S RIC (T Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. Steadied off heels around turn.

ROUGH 'N' TUMBLE (H Andrew) - Raced wide without cover.

VIVA LILLI (J Parkes) – Tightened having to be restrained when HE'S RIC (T Johnson) shifted outwards when being restrained off the heels of DEUCE COUPE near the 550 metres. Apprentice jockey T Johnson was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d).

COLLINSTREET (J Riddell) - Held up entering the home straight having to be angled outwards to obtain a narrow run to the outside of FRANCESCA KATE which simultaneously lay out dictating COLLINSTREET on to ROUGH 'N' TUMBLE which was inconvenienced near the 250 metres. COLLINSTREET then commenced to lay in, bumping on a number of occasions over the final stages with FRANCESCA KATE, which lay out.

FRANCESCA KATE (C O'Beirne) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay out in the home straight bumping on a number of occasions with COLLINSTREET.

M Singh (DEUCE COUPE) – Reminded of his obligations regarding whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 6 | **NEW CENTRAL MOTOR INN MAIDEN (1600 Metres)**

WORD SAVVY (T Johnson) - Underwent and passed a pre-race veterinary inspection after making contact in the enclosure. Made the bend awkwardly into the back straight running wide on the track.

DARE TO ROCK (A Jones) – Slow away.

MAUNA KEA (D Turner) - Tightened shortly after the start when runners either side shifted ground.

HANDYMAN (C-M Waddell) - Raced three wide in the early stages before being ridden forward to sit outside the leader.

FICTITIOUS (M Tanaka) - When questioned into the performance, rider advised the filly had raced greenly throughout. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 7 | **ALPHA DOMUS MAIDEN (1600 Metres)**

FAIRSUCOFTHESAV (H Andrew) – Raced keenly when wide without cover throughout.

TIME BEARER (M Tanaka) - Lay inwards under pressure in the home straight.

LISBETH (A Jones) – Held up for a distance approaching the 500 metres behind the tiring FAIRSUCOFTHESAV. When questioned rider reported the filly had been inconvenienced by a tiring runner rounding the turn but could offer no

excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate indicative of heat stress.

SKYPHYTA (J Parkes) – Inconvenienced near the 500 metres by the tiring FAIRSUCOFTHE SAV.

Race 8

BAMBRY'S WATER TREADMILL WOODVILLE CUP RATING 75 (2100 Metres)

BRAKBAR (T Johnson) – Tightened at the start settling back.

KEILIB (R Myers) – Improved wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

MISSY MOO (J Parkes) – Raced three wide without cover in the early stages before being allowed to roll forward to sit outside the lead near the 1100 metres.

HANDFULL (D Turner) - Held up approaching the 500 metres gaining clear running passing the 350 metres.

STEPHENSTIHLS (S Collett) – Held up for a distance from the 500 metres gaining clear running entering the home straight.

Race 9

TUI 'BACKING A WINNER SINCE 1889' MAIDEN (2100 Metres)

SHEZACRAFTSMAN (D Bradley) – Slow away. Held up entering the home straight having to be angled outwards across heels to gain clear running approaching the 200 metres.

HARD BUT FAIR (R Myers) – Slow away.

PEEWEE (D Turner) – Gave ground quickly from the 800 metres and was not persevered with. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nasal area. After undergoing a veterinary inspection, the gelding was confirmed to have bled. PEEWEE is now unable to be in training for two months and is unable to trial or race for three months with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing or trialling next.
