Race 1	NEW WORLD RAILWAY METRO 2YO MAIDEN (1000 Metres)
<p>JUST FABULOUS (D Bradley) – Began awkwardly. Raced keenly throughout. Ran wide crossing the junction on to the course proper.</p> <p>MAIPE (T Allan) – Ducked inwards at the start contacting BEAM OF LIGHT, which settled back.</p> <p>DAUPHINE (D Turner) – Reluctant to load. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed against the filly/s barrier manners. Lay out crossing the junction on to the course proper dictating MCHALE wider on the course.</p> <p>LOVE POTION (H Andrew) – Reluctant to load. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed against the filly’s barrier manners. Raced in restricted room approaching the 200 metres having to shift outwards across heels to gain clear running.</p> <p>MCHALE (T Johnson) – Lay out under pressure over the final stages.</p> <p>BEAM OF LIGHT (M Hills) – Contacted at start. Ducked out sharply over the final stages when shying at the winning post.</p> <p>WHAT A SMASHER (C-M Waddell) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 2	NEW WORLD WILLIS STREET METRO MAIDEN (1000 Metres)
<p>EUKA LADY - Late scratching at 11.30am on veterinary advice after suffering an injury to the sole of the right hind.</p> <p>CONFESSIONAL (A Jones) – Jumped outwards at the start contacting LATIN PRINCESS and dictating that runner outwards on to QUAFF, which settled back. Raced three wide on the pace throughout. Lay in under pressure in the home straight.</p> <p>LATIN PRINCESS (M Singh) – Contacted at start.</p> <p>QUAFF (S MacNab) – Contacted at start.</p> <p>NANCEES GOLD (C-M WADDELL) - Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>BOY SOLDIER (M Hills) – Tightened, having to be restrained approaching the 200 metres when DU’BLUES (A Shin) shifted inwards. Apprentice jockey A Shin was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) and advised that he must straighten his mounts sooner than he did on this occasion.</p> <p>D Turner (MALO BIK) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 3	NEW WORLD ISLAND BAY HANDICAP (1200 Metres)
<p>ALMARIE (T Allan) – Slow away. Raced three wide throughout.</p> <p>VALENTIA (J Nason) - Slow away. Raced wide without cover throughout. Lay in under pressure in the home straight.</p> <p>DANMULAN (D Bradley) – Raced keenly throughout.</p> <p>ST REGIS (M Hills) – Was not persevered with over the final stages when beaten. When questioned rider advised the gelding had raced greenly crossing the junction on to the course proper and had not responded to urging in the home straight. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.</p>	

BROTHER ONE (C-M Waddell) – Lost the near side hind plate during the running.

Race 4 | **NEW WORLD HUTT VALLEY HANDICAP (1000 Metres)**

BALLYBAY (D Turner) – Awkwardly away. Raced wide throughout.

SCANDALO (D Bradley) – Slow away.

HUGO THE BOSS (J Nason) – Contacted at the start. Tightened near the 150 metres when THIEN LY (M Hills) shifted inwards under pressure. Rider M Hills was advised to straighten his mounts sooner than he did on this occasion.

ELLERSTINA (T Johnson) - Lay out crossing the junction on to the course proper.

Race 5 | **NEW WORLD CHURTON PARK MAIDEN (1600 Metres)**

GRINNER (T Johnson) – Slow away (3L). Raced keenly in the early stages.

HE'S A FREAK (D Turner) – Awkwardly away settling back.

MASSIVE MISSIVE (J Nason) - Got its head up for a short distance when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.

ORIGINAL GANGSTER (A Shin) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

CANDY BELT (C-M Waddell) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Tightened and disappointed for a run approaching the 250 metres when TOBY'S CHOICE (D Bradley) rolled out under pressure. CANDY BELT made contact with ORIGINAL GANGSTER when attempting a marginal run between that runner and TOBY'S CHOICE. Rider D Bradley was advised to exercise care.

Race 6 | **NEW WORLD STOKES VALLEY HANDICAP (1600 Metres)**

SHARED SECRETS (T Johnson) – Blundered at the start unbalancing the rider and settled back.

STAR OF GREENBEEL (S MacNab) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

THE RIPPA (H Andrew) - Had to be restrained off heels near the 1000 metres. Briefly held up passing the 600 metres behind the tiring ON THE HILL.

BRING TO THE BLOCK (D Turner) - Ran out under pressure over the final stages.

Race 7 | **NEW WORLD SILVERSTREAM HANDICAP (2100 Metres)**

KATIEM MARIE (S MacNab) – Slow away.

SWEET TREAT (T Johnson) – Slow away.

NADIASSTAR (D Turner) - When questioned into the performance of NADIASSTAR, rider advised the mare had got its tongue back over the bit.

COMMANDING PRINCE (M Singh) - Raced keenly in the early stages so was allowed to roll forward approaching the 1400 metres to lead near the 1100 metres.

Race 8 | **KAMADA PARK SUMMER CUP (2400 Metres)**

SHOW MACCOOL (J Nason) – Awkwardly away then tailed the field throughout. Rider reported the gelding had not felt comfortable in its action. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear.

KAMANDA LINCOLN (D Turner) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Briefly inconvenienced 50 metres.

LEADING ROLE (D Bradley) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

TICKET CLIPPER (T Allan) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

DUPLICITY (S MacNab) - Held up entering the home straight having to be angled outwards to gain clear running near the 300 metres.

BIZZWINKLE (H Andrew) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding never travelled comfortably throughout. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear.

HUNTA PENCE (M Hills) – Lay out under pressure then faltered near the 50 metres, briefly inconveniencing KAMANDA LINCOLN. When questioned rider felt the gelding falter and thought it had broken down so did not persevere over the final stages.. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality.

Race 9	NEW WORLD WELLINGTON CITY HANDICAP (1600 Metres)
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RUSTY IN MELBOURNE (D Bradley) – Slow away. Held up approaching the 400 metres having to be angled to the inside to gain clear running near the 150 metres.

THE HUNTSMAN (J Nason) – Slow away.

HAND IT TO JONESY (T Johnson) – Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages making the bend awkwardly passing the 1000 metres.

BEAUTIFUL MAN (A Jones) – Raced wide throughout.

THAT'S AMORE (M Singh) – Gave ground quickly approaching the 600 metres and was not persevered with. Rider reported that the mare had stopped very quickly and felt something was amiss. A subsequent veterinary inspection found the mare to have suffered from cardiac arrhythmia with the appropriate veterinary certificate of fitness required before racing next.

ALLMOSTA (A Shin) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

PICNIC BAY (C-M Waddell) – Raced in restricted room near the 150 metres.

VENCEDORA (D Turner) - Lay out under pressure over the final stages.

VEUVE CLICQUOT (C O'Beirne) – Raced wide without cover throughout.
