RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MACALEA 2000 (2000 metres)
PERFECTO (A Collett) – Awkwardly away settling back. Dictated wider on the track 600 metres.	
SILVER MISSILE (M McNab) - Jumped inwards at the start contacting ENGLISH ROSE. Contacted passing 600 metres.	

ENGLISH ROSE (C Lammas) – Contacted at start. Restrained off heels passing the 1200 metres. Briefly held up approaching the 600 metres.

SMILING ASSASSIN (R Elliot) – Raced ungenerously making the bend awkwardly approaching the 1600 metres.

AIGNE (T Allan) – Contacted **SILVER MISSILE** when angling for a marginal run passing the 600 metres, also dictating **PERFECTO** wider on the track.

KING OF THE DANCE (S Weatherley) - Raced up on to the heels of **ENGLISH ROSE** near the 300 metres and had to be steadied. **KING OF THE DANCE** was then angled outwards into a marginal run and bumped with **AIGNE**. S Weatherley was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d). Stewards took into account simultaneous outward movement from **ENGLISH ROSE** when assessing the interference. Also inconvenienced was **SILVER MISSILE**. Rider lost the use of his whip for a distance from the 150 metres.

Race 2	PROFRUIT 2000 (2000 metres)

REAL BEACH (M Tanaka) – Connections were advised that a warning is placed against the mare's barrier manners after being reluctant to load. Raced keenly throughout.

REAL SAVVY (S Weatherley) – Awkwardly away.

KIRKENES (R Myers) – Slow away. Raced keenly in the early to middle stages then improved three wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

TAUTU (D Turner) - Had to be restrained off heels passing the 800 metres.

SUFFICE TO SAY (R Elliot) - When questioned into the run of **SUFFICE TO SAY**, which finished well back, R Elliot advised the gelding may be better suited to rain-affected going.

Race 3	AWESUM ORGANICS 1200 (1200 metres)

MAESTRO MAX (M Coleman) – Awkwardly away.

SAIGNON (R Elliot) - Held up for a distance near the 300 metres having to be angled outwards to gain clear running inside the 150 metres.

Race 4	TUMU TIMBERS 1200 (1200 metres)

JUST GEORGIE (H Andrew) – Tightened at start settling back. Lay inwards under pressure near the 200 metres

POWNCE (S Collett) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages, running wide passing the 800 metres then raced three wide without cover.

ABRAHAMS (M Coleman) – Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

STRUT (D Turner) – Held up rounding the turn then again near the 350 metres having to be angled outwards across heels to gain clear running approaching the 200 metres.

JACQUES (J Nason) – Lay out passing the 800 metres.

Race 5	BOSTOCK NEW ZEALAND 1400 (1400 metres)

UNFAZED (M McNab) – Awkwardly away settling back.

McMcNab (UNFAZED) - As the field jumped away, UNFAZED threw its head back striking M McNab, who on returning to the enclosure reported the injury and after receiving attention from paramedics was stood down for his remaining rides. M McNab will require a medical clearance prior to riding next.

NESSUN DORMA (R Harris) – Slow away.

ICHIBAN (R Elliot) – Lay inwards under pressure in the home straight.

JUST YOU (M Tanaka) - Hung inwards in the home straight.

PINCANTO (D Bradley) Raced keenly in the early to middle stages, hung round the turn.

LADY AMADEUS (S Collett) – When questioned into performance rider advised the mare may have been feeling the track. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

Race 6	WAIMEA NURSERIES 1400 (1400 metres)

SACRED DAY – J Bayliss replaced M McNab.

DELGATIE PEARL (R Myers) – Tightened at start settling back.

EXONERATE (R Elliot) – Held up rounding the home turn gaining clear running near the 200 metres.

Race 7	ORORA KIWI PACKAGING 3YO (1300 metres)

PARVINA – A Collett replaced M McNab.

THE REVENANT (R Elliot Awkwardly away settling back.

CEAD MILE FAILTE (R Myers) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

PONSONBY ROAD (J Bayliss) – Held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres.

DETONATE (H Andrew) – Tightened having to be restrained approaching the 200 metres when attempting a narrow run to the inside of ETOILE D’AMOUR (M Tanaka) which shifted inwards. Rider M Tanaka was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) and advised that he is expected to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

Race 8	EVERFRESH TRANSPORT MILE (1600 metres)

LE SABLIER – S Weatherley replaced M McNab. Held up entering the home straight then shifted out abruptly when attempting a narrow run to the outside of REALM briefly inconveniencing CHAMPAGNE BRIDE near the 300 metres.

CHAMPAGNE BRIDE (S Collett) – Briefly inconvenienced 300 metres.

LA ESTRELLA (J Bayliss) – Slow away. Rider reported the mare may have been feeling the firm track conditions.

REALM (A Collett) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

OKOTO (M Coleman) – Had to be steadied going into the first turn when GATES TO RIO (D Turner) crossed when not the required distance clear. D Turner was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground. OKOTO raced ungenerously, getting its head in the air in the back straight so was allowed to roll forward approaching the 1000 metres to lead passing the 800 metres.

OUR WONDER (T Allan) - Raced keenly in the middle stages.
