RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	PHIL & CORIN MURFITT AND RAY & JILL COUPLAND RATING 75 (1600m)
<p>WHAT A DEEZA (T Moseley) – Underwent a veterinary inspection and cleared to race after being fractious in the barriers. Began awkwardly.</p> <p>IMPERIUM (M McNab) – Restrained to the rear on jumping.</p> <p>BRIDGET TOWN (A Morgan) – Raced wide in the early stages, straightened near the 100 metres when laying in under pressure.</p> <p>LOCALLY SAUCED (K Kwo) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages whilst leading.</p> <p>MONTRACHET (A Collett) – Raced in restricted room passing the 400 metres, obtained clear running near the 200 metres.</p> <p>RAWMATERIAL (C Johnson) – Held up for a short distance near the 400 metres, unable to obtain clear running late in the final straight. Rider C Johnson reported that although the gelding had been held up, in his opinion it had only battled over the concluding stages.</p>	
Race 2	FLEMING FAMILY MAIDEN (1400m)
<p>The start of this race was officially delayed 5 minutes on TAB request.</p> <p>DAMANAKA (M McNab) – Late scratched by the Stewards after bolting for a lap of the track on the way to the barriers.</p>	

LADY DAVONE (K Kwo) – Was fractious in the barriers, began awkwardly, hampered at the 1000 metres and got its head up and raced ungenerously, when continuing to over race near the 800 metres contacted a heel and blundered when racing in tight quarters between PENDLETON which shifted out marginally to avoid the heels of QUAINTELLE which was being steadied and JUST who was racing tight to the outside. This resulted in the trailing WHISKEY IN THE JAR being severely hampered, placed in restricted room near the 300 metres and had to shift ground outwards.

CITRUS (B Hong) – Slow to begin.

DREAM RICH (C Campbell) – Began awkwardly.

ADVENT (K Mudhoo) – Hampered shortly after the start.

DIRECTOR (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages, held up for a short distance early in the home straight.

JUST A JACKET (J Morris) – Raced fiercely in the early stages. Underwent a post race veterinary examination after being galloped on during the running which revealed minor lacerations to the left hind pastern.

RUBY MARIE (T Moseley) – Raced wide in the early stages.

PENDLETON (D Prastiyou) – Raced keenly in the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions, contacted the heel of QUAINTELLE which was taken inwards by BON SHOWVI (R Yatim) near the 1000 metres and blundered badly unbalancing the rider for a short distance. Apprentice rider **R Yatim** admitted a charge of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 2 days effective 10 September to 23 September inclusive. A post race veterinary inspection revealed PENDLETON to have suffered minor lacerations to the right hock.

FIRE LILY (K Williams) – Shifted wider on the track near the 1000 metres.

QUAINTELLE (P Shaikh) – Steadied near the 800 metres. Underwent a post race veterinary examination after being galloped on during the running which showed minor lacerations to the right hind pastern.

WHISKEY IN THE JAR (R Bishop) – Severely hampered near the 800 metres and then raced greenly for a distance passing the 750 metres.

DREAM RICH (C Campbell) – Held up early in the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 200 metres.

Race 3	MICK & MELBA MURFITT MEMORIAL METRIC MILE (1600m)
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The start of this race was officially delayed 5 minutes on TAB request.

PRINCESS BROOK (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

BELLE BOY (G Bourke) – Improved wide from the 800 metres.

Race 4	SHERRILL & GEOFF MORETON RATING 85 (1400m)
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The start of this race was officially delayed 5 minutes on TAB request.

TIMY TYLER (G Bourke) – Began awkwardly shifting outwards, raced wide in the early stages.

HOT TEMPO (R Yatim) – Hampered at the start and made contact with the rail after 100 metres.

TWOZNOTENOUGH (K Kwo) – Hampered at the start, held up for a short distance turning for home. Rider K Kwo reported that the mare had lay inwards throughout the running.

FIVE KINGS (K Cowan) – Got its head up when racing keenly in the early and middle stages, held up rounding the turn only obtaining clear running passing the 200 metres.

NOT AVAILABLE (D Prastiyou) – Raced wide throughout.

CLARA JANE – Rider C Johnson advised that in his opinion the sit and sprint nature of today's race did not suit the mare.	
Race 5	SHEARINGS, MORE THAN MOVING EARTH THREE-YEAR-OLD (1000m)
<p>RIVER RUN (R Cuneen) – Began awkwardly. When spoken to regarding the performance of this favoured runner, rider R Cuneen reported that the colt had not let down on today's track conditions.</p> <p>GREENPARK GEM (D Prastiyou) – Began awkwardly, lay outwards passing the 150 metres and made contact with AGE OF FIRE. Unbalanced at the 90 metres when again making contact with AGE OF FIRE.</p> <p>AGE OF FIRE (M McNab) – Got its head up when restrained after the start, bumped at the 150 metres, shifted inwards near the 90 metres making contact with GREENPARK GEM resulting in both runners becoming temporarily unbalanced. M McNab admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.</p> <p>SWING NOTE – Rider J Morris could offer no tangible excuses for the performance of this favoured filly.</p> <p>The connections of 2nd placed AGE OF FIRE lodged a protest against 1st placed GREENPARK GEM alleging interference within the final 200 metres. After hearing evidence and submissions the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.</p>	
Race 6	MAYFAIR POOLS, CANTERBURY RATING 65 (1000m)
<p>ARYACRAZY (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>MAUI MISS (K Cowan – Began awkwardly, raced wide throughout.</p> <p>GOODTAGO (H Bennet) – Began awkwardly, lay in passing the 150 metres and had to be straightened.</p> <p>RICHIE ROX (J Morris) – Hampered at the start and got back. Rider J Morris reported that the gelding was out paced throughout.</p> <p>KILLA QUESTION (A Morgan) – Hampered shortly after the start and got back, became awkwardly placed on heels near the 500 metres and had to steady.</p> <p>T Moseley (PREDICTION) – Reminded of his obligations regarding use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>MACY – Rider C Johnson reported that the mare only battled over the concluding stages and may be looking for wetter tracks.</p>	
Race 7	BARNESWOOD FARM OPEN SPRINT (1000m)
<p>The start was officially delayed one minute on TAB request.</p> <p>WIZE ACT (K Kwo) – Began very awkwardly unbalancing the rider for a short distance and got back, held up for a short distance entering the home straight, became awkwardly placed on the heels of ELECTRONIC MOTION near the 300 metres having to shift ground outwards passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>MR CONDUCTOR (K Mudhoo) – Raced keenly in the early stages, lay out under pressure passing the 200 metres and brushed with FAIRLIGHT.</p> <p>ELECTRONIC MOTION (D Prastiyou) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>RIDING SHOTGUN (A Collett) – Raced keenly for a short distance passing the 700 metres throwing its head in the air on a number of occasions, held up early in the run home only gaining clear racing room passing the 225 metres.</p> <p>DISTURBANCE (K Cowan) – Held up on entering the home straight obtaining clear running passing the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 8	SOTHYS RATING 65 (1800m)
<p>STANDREWS MASONIC (K Cowan) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>PAHAU (R Cuneen) – Raced keenly in the early stages, raced in restricted room for a short distance on entering the home straight.</p>	

SHAKTI (R Bishop) – Raced keenly for a distance in the early stages.

PASSAMAQUODDY (K Kwo) – Raced keenly in the lead.

REDESDALE (A Collett) – Raced wide throughout.

DREAM DIVINE (C Campbell) – Raced in tight quarters shortly after the start having to be steadied, held up in the early stages of the home straight, shifted outwards near the 300 metres and brushed with SWEET TIME, inclined to shift outwards in the final straight.

Race 9

BARNESWOOD FARM RATING 65 (1400m)

NOWHERE MAN (K Gundowry) – Began awkwardly, held up for a short distance on entering the home straight.

RADIANT (B Hong) – Slow to begin.

JUMEIRAH (J Morris) – Bounded at the start losing ground.

TOETWOTOE (A Collett) – Slow to begin, got its head up when restrained off heels near the 1000 metres and continued to race ungenerously for some distance thereafter.

SHOCKTILLYOUDROP (D Prastiyou) – Brushed with inside runner as the start was made raced fiercely through the early stages and got its head up when being continually restrained near the 1000 metres.

TIFFANY'S TIME (M McNab) – Bumped with outside runner shortly after the start, raced keenly in the early stages and placed in restricted room near the 1000 metres when awkward to the inside of SO BRAZEN which was taken in momentarily by SHARP ELLE.

BLUE PRINT (K Kwo) – Raced wide throughout.

SO BRAZEN (A Morgan) – Held up for a short distance on entering the home straight, shifted in near the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

SHARP ELLE – Rider T Moseley was reminded of his obligations when changing ground.

HEAVEN KNOWS (K Williams) – When spoken to regarding performance rider K Williams advised the mare had only battled on today's firmer track conditions and believes she may be looking for more ground at this stage.
