RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	BETAVET & EASTS OUTDOOR WORK & LEISURE MILE
BARE WITH (S MacNab) - Slow away.	
ARDENNE (D Hirini) - Slow away, over-raced in the middle stages.	
APEROL (T Allan) - Shifted outwards rounding the final turn making contact with RIPTYNE near the 350 metres.	

RIPTYNE (J Nason) - Bumped 350 metres.

LILLET ROSE (S Weatherley) - Shifted outwards under pressure near the 200 metres dictating **NABIAC** and **EXONERATE** wider on the track. S Weatherley was advised to exercise greater care.

NABIAC (R Elliot) - Dictated wider 200 metres.

EXONERATE (M Tanaka) - Dictated wider 200 metres.

TIPICAL (A Collett) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the tempo of the race had not suited her mount. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

R Elliot (**NABIAC**) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

M Tanaka (**EXONERATE**) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

S Weatherley (**LILLET ROSE**) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 2	PAK'nSAVE 1200

PINK GRAFFITI (M Coleman) - Jumped away awkwardly inconveniencing **MADAM MAFKI**.

MADAM MAFKI (A Jones) - Inconvenienced start, raced three wide without cover.

Race 3	THE GISBORNE HERALD 1200

WALKIN' BY (M Coleman) - Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages and after being crossed by **CONFESSIONAL** near the 800 metres shifted outwards across that runners heels.

Race 4	DONALDSON'S PLUMBING 1200

MAESTRO MAX (M Coleman) - Broke through the front of the barriers prior to the start but was quickly brought under control by its rider and passed fit to run following a veterinary inspection, slow away, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had been outpaced throughout and would be better suited by more rain affected footing.

LUEN YAT MIRACLE (A Collett) - Slow away.

ICHIBAN (R Myers) - Lay in leaving the barriers crowding **ST REGIS** onto **DEB**.

ST REGIS (J Grob) - Crowded start.

DEB (M Tanaka) - Crowded start.

MILLY MOO (S Weatherley) - Raced three wide without cover.

SUPAGILI (H Marzuki) - Raced four wide without cover.

FLAVOURING (J Nason) - Got its head up when being steadied approaching the 1000 metres.

ISLAND BAY (R Elliot) - Shifted inwards when struck with the whip near the 250 metres having to be corrected by its rider and continued to lay in under pressure for the remainder of the race.

Race 5	MATAWHERE WINES 2000

ENGLISH ROSE (R Myers) - Slow away (3L), held up near the 350 metres before shifting ground inwards to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.

KEEP THE MOMENT (D Hirini) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground, raced wide without cover throughout.

DEEJAY MAC (C Johnson) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with BEL RAGAZZO, over-raced in the early to middle stages, held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight before obtaining clear running near the 250 metres.

BEL RAGAZZO (A Collett) - Bumped start, had a tendency to race greenly throughout.

SACRED TONIC (M Coleman) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

DANGERMAN (S Collett) - Eased down over the final 200 metres when well beaten with the rider unable to offer any tangible excuse, a post-race veterinary inspection found the gelding to have a poor post-race recovery and to be suffering from heat stress.

Race 6	GISBORNE REFRIGERATION 2000

SACRED DAY (M Coleman) - Crowded start, got its head up when being steadied near the 1400 metres, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding which was still inexperienced may have struggled with the step up in distance from 1400m at this stage of its preparation but had been generally satisfied with the run.

SWEET TREAT (R Elliot) - Slow away.

GARFUNKEL (D Hirini) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages having to be steadied approaching the 1400 metres, made contact with the running rail when racing in restricted room approaching the 800 metres and ducked outwards making contact with WILIJONMCBRIDE which was forced onto IAGO.

IAGO (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages when racing three wide with cover, bumped near the 800 metres, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had been left flat footed when the pace quickened taking some time to respond to his riding but finding the line well over the concluding stages.

WILIJONMCBRIDE (T Allan) - Bumped near the 800 metres.

REAL BEACH (M Tanaka) - Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SACRED DAY near the 300 metres.

ESKIMO KISS (A Collett) - When spoken to regarding the improved performance trainer R Manning advised that after a break the mare had benefitted from its most recent run where he had not been overly satisfied with the ride adding that the mare was in foal and had been working well.

Race 7	VINTECH PACIFIC 1400
---------------	-----------------------------

LAVISH (A Collett) - Jumped away awkwardly hampering HONFLEUR.

HONFLEUR (M Coleman) - Hampered start, unbalanced when bumped passing 100 metres.

J Nason (DETERMINATION) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards crowding AL BE CIVICS, POLITELY and ALTENARI passing the 1200 metres.

AL BE CIVICS (H Marzuki) - Crowded passing the 1200 metres, raced three wide without cover from the 900 metres.

POLITELY (R Myers) - Crowded passing the 1200 metres, shifted outwards to obtain clear running making contact with HONFLEUR passing the 100 metres with both runners becoming unbalanced. R Myers was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

ALTENARI (C Johnson) - Crowded passing the 1200 metres.

LAVISH (A Collett) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

JEZIBABA (M Tanaka) - Held up rounding the final turn from the 500 metres and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 100 metres.

LADY ZERAPH (S Weatherley) - Held up for a short distance near the 200 metres.

Trainer **K Myers** - Issued with a warning after presenting OVERTHERIVER without an item of notified gear (blinkers).

SKYWEKA (M Coleman) - Dropped its head in the barriers and was very slow away (4L), rider advised that after its poor beginning the mare had got further back than intended and had been unable to recover.

CAN YOU HEAR ME (A Collett) - Raced three wide without cover.

SACRED EMPIRE (J Nason) - Went off stride when appearing to shy rounding the final turn near the 400 metres.

Race 9	GISBORNE FISHERIES MILE

COMMANDER (J Grob) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

VOXER (M Tanaka) - Slow away.

TERRA SANCTA (S Collett) - Crowded start and got back.

OKOTO (M Coleman) - Over-raced early and middle stages having to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of TAVIS STAR near the 800 metres with rider advising that after over-racing had been unable to finish the race off.

TAVIS STAR (T Newman) - Held up rounding the final turn until near the 350 metres, lay out under pressure inconveniencing the weakening SWISS EIRE near the 100 metres.

SWISS EIRE (R Elliot) - Hung outwards rounding the final turn, inconvenienced when weakening near the 100 metres.

EM KAY POPS (A Jones) - Held up rounding the final turn.

SCARLET PRINCESS (S Weatherley) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse advising that the mare had been disappointing, a post-race veterinary inspection found the mare to have a poor post-race recovery and to be suffering from heat stress.

CUTTING UP ROUGH (D Hirini) - When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer R Manning that the gelding had benefitted from the re-application of blinkers.
