RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 STELLA ARTOIS 1300 (1300 metres)

CARAMIA (J Grob) – Escaped riderless from behind the gates but was quickly recaptured and passed fit to run following a veterinary inspection.

OBSESSIVE (T Thornton) – Jumped away awkwardly making contact with ABRAHAMS, losing ground, came together with ABRAHAMS on the turn when seeking a run, raced greenly in the home straight with both runners coming

together and bumping near the 300 metres.

ABRAHAMS (M Coleman) – Unbalanced when bumped leaving the barriers, checked passing the 1000 metres to avoid the heels of STRUT (T Allan), getting its head up and shifting out, racing ungenerously for a distance, came together with OBSESSISVE on the turn and again near the 300 metres.

T Allan (STRUT) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards passing the 1000 metres when not sufficiently clear of ABRAHAMS which was checked. After hearing submissions the JCA suspended T Allan's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 3 March up to and including racing on Monday 12 March (5 national days).

PASSING GLANCE (M Tanaka) – Slow away, when questioned regarding the run M Tanaka advised the filly raced greenly throughout. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed lacerations to the right hind pastern.

Race 2 PER INCANTO 3YO (1400 metres)

ALL IN MANA (C-M Waddell) - Over-raced in the middle stages shifting outwards to avoid heels approaching the 1000 metres, racing wide without cover to improve forward to sit outside the leader near the 700 metres and when shifting inwards was not fully clear of DETONATE (H Andrew) which was steadied. C-M Waddell was advised to exercise care.

DETONATE (H Andrew) - Steadied when placed in restricted room 700 metres.

SLOW HANDS (J Waddell) - Bumped near the 250 metres when DETONATE shifted inwards under pressure.

Race 3 TRINITY HILL 1200 (1200 metres)

VINNIE'S VOLLEY (S Collett) – Over-raced when being restrained in the early and middle stages, running wide going into the bend near the 800 metres, unbalanced when bumped passing the 600 metres and hung outwards rounding the final turn. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the filly had refused to settle when trying to obtain cover in the early and middle stages and had raced greenly, also being inclined to hang outwards. A post-race veterinary inspection found the filly to have a laceration in the mouth.

SOPHIA MAGIA (R Myers) - Began awkwardly making contact with TAVIJAZZ, shifted outwards when steadying away from the heels of TAVIJAZZ passing the 600 metres, making contact with VINNIE'S VOLLEY.

MORWEKA (J Fawcett) - Held up rounding the final turn and into the final straight before shifting outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 250 metres. When shifting outwards MORWEKA inconvenienced VINNIE'S VOLLEY with J Fawcett advised to exercise greater care in that she must stop riding and straighten her mount.

J Fawcett (MORWEKA) - Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

TAVIJAZZ (C Johnson) – Bumped start. Required veterinary treatment post-race, suffering from Thumps.

MISS OAHU (M Tanaka) – Briefly held up near the 150 metres having to steady and shift outwards across the heels of SOPHIA MAGIA to obtain clear running.

Race 4 TREMAINS STARTING GATES 2100 (2100 metres)

THE RIPPA (M McNab) – Blundered leaving the barriers and shifted inwards crowding HOIST on to WOODLOVETO and SOLESEIFEI.

HOIST (S Collett) – Crowded start

WOODLOVETO (J Bayliss) – Hampered start

SOLESEIFEI (J Parkes) – Hampered start. When questioned J Parkes was of the opinion the mare would be better suited to more rain affected going. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

DAYTONA RED (A Collett) - Slow away, steadied when crowded near the 700 metres, held up near the 300 metres and was unable to obtain clear running approaching the 100 metres.

ROYAL RUBY (C Johnson) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Race 5 KARAKA MILLION NOMINATIONS CLOSE 6 MARCH 1400 (1400 metres)

A Shin (HEMI) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards near the 1100 metres when not fully clear of LEWIS CARROLL, which was steadied.

LEWIS CARROLL (S McKay) – Steadied to avoid heels 1100 metres, required veterinary treatment post-race for a mild bout of colic.

MISS WILSON (O Bosson) – Over-raced in the middle stages, had to be firmly restrained when improving onto the heels of LEWIS CARROLL rounding the bend near the 450 metres, being unable to obtain clear running until inside the final 100 metres.

SON OF MAHER (S Weatherley) – Over-raced for a distance near the 1000 metres having to be steadied to avoid the heels of HENI, shifted outwards under pressure near the 250 metres forcing LA FILLE EN JEU outwards on to SHADOW FOX. S Weatherley was advised to exercise greater care.

LE FILLE EN JEU (M Tanaka) - Hampered 250 metres

SHADOW FOX (J Fawcett) - Raced three wide without cover, hampered 250 metres.

OCEAN EMPEROR (J Grob) - Inclined to shift outwards in the home straight having to be straightened.

M McNab (MONTOYA STAR) - Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 6 LIVAMOL 1300 (1300 metres)

CASAQUINMAN (C Johnson) – Slow away. Over-raced in the middle stages. Rider reported the gelding may be better suited to more rain affected going.

RUBY BLOOM (E McCall) – Bumped between runners leaving the barrier.

TRUDEAU (M Cameron) - When questioned into the run of TRUDEAU M Cameron advised that the gelding had been outpaced throughout with the fast tempo of today's race and may be better suited over more ground adding the gelding would also appreciate some further easing of the going.

Race 7 LITTLE AVONDALE LOWLAND STAKES, GROUP III (2100 metres)

SAVVY COUP (C Johnson) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages having to be checked when awkwardly placed on the heels of MILSEAIN, which was being steadied near the 1800 metres, held up early in the final straight before obtaining clear running near the 300 metres.

SWING NOTE (O Bosson) – Raced wide throughout being three wide without cover from the 1300 metres.

CARICATURE (L Innes) – Made contact with the running rail near the 1500 metres, held up passing the 300 metres gaining clear running passing the 200 metres.

ZA ZA GABOR (S Collett) - Raced three wide without cover until improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 1300 metres.

BELLE DU NORD (V Colgan) - Held up rounding the final turn and continued having difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the final straight.

HASAHALO (S Spratt) – Briefly held up entering the final straight and held up again over the final 100 metres going to the line untested.

TREASURE (M McNab) – Held up for a distance passing the 250 metres.

Race 8 LAND ROVER HOY IN HB 13-18 MARCH MILE (1600 metres)

BRILLIANT ACTION (M Cameron) – Crowded shortly after jumping away, losing ground.

JUST YOU (M Tanaka) – Made the first turn awkwardly when being steadied away from the heels of CHOUXPERB, hampering LISTOWEL near the 1400 metres.

LISTOWEL (S McKay) - Hampered 1400 metres.

LUEN YAT MIRACLE (A Collett) - Raced wide without cover.

BEAUTIFUL MAN (T Allan) – Steadied when improving on to the heels of BRILLIANT ACTION rounding the final turn near the 350 metres, unable to obtain clear running over the final 100 metres.

KAIPAWE (Riddell) – Inclined to shift ground under pressure over the final 200 metres.

VALOUR (H Andrew) – When questioned into the run of VALOUR, H Andrew reported the gelding may be better suited to more rain-affected going.
