RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TUI – BACKING WINNERS SINCE 1889 MAIDEN (2100 metres)
SHEZ GONNA GETCHA (H Andrew) – Jumped outwards at the start contacting OUR WONDER. Shied at the crossing near the 1600 metres and shifted out abruptly hampering CEAD MILE FAILTE and when being corrected shifted in and checked DUBLIN DAY. Gave ground rounding the home turn finishing some distance behind the field. When questioned rider reported the mare had hung throughout.	
STUNNING (M Tanaka) – Over-racing in the early and middle stages.	
OUR WONDER (T Allan) – Bumped at start. T Allan was reminded of his obligations regarding his use of the whip prior	

to the 200 metres.

MARJOLET (A Collett) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Hampered and forced over extra ground near the 200 metres. M Tanaka (STUNNING) admitted a subsequent breach of Rule 638(1)(d) (careless riding) and after submissions had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 3 March up to and including racing on Thursday, 15 March 2018 (7 national days).

Race 2	AGRICOM HANDICAP (1550 metres)

DARSCAPE PRINCESS (J Parkes) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

MELS EVIE (J Fawcett) – Raced keenly throughout.

SLIMLINE (A Shin) – Briefly held up passing the 400 metres.

Race 3	NUFARM 3YO MAIDEN (1200 metres)

IN SEGRETO (H Andrew) – Reared as the gates opened losing ground. Raced in restricted room bumping with MY CALENDAR GIRL over the final stages.

LODI (S Collett) – Slow away. Had to be steadied when in restricted room to the inside of BEAUDEN (C Johnson) which in shifted in momentarily prior to being straightened near the 800 metres. C Johnson was advised to exercise greater care.

XENIA ONATOPP (R Myers) - Awkwardly away.

LINCOLN RAIDER (M Tanaka) – Slow away.

MY CALENDAR GIRL (A Collett) – Raced greenly throughout resulting in the bit being pulled through its mouth and was unable to be ridden out fully in the home straight.

RAINBOW DUNDEE (T Johnson) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages when being restrained.

SUPER GIRL (J Parkes) – Shifted outwards making the turn near the 800 metres. When questioned regarding the performance, J Parkes could offer no excuses. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

Race 4	IPLEX PIPELINES MAIDEN (1200 metres)

TO SIR WITH LOVE (T Johnson) – Slow away.

DANA'S PROPHECY (S O'Malley) – three wide throughout.

INCASEITEL (S MacNab) – Made the final bend awkwardly and rolled out simultaneously as SABATICA was improving to its outside resulting in SABATICA having to be steadied abruptly.

CRAFTY CRIM (D Hirini) – Held up approaching the 400 metres gaining clear running near the 300 metres.

MISS CONTESSA (S Collett) – Lost the near front plate during the running.

Race 5	DONAGHYS MAIDEN (1400 metres)

LINCOLN STAR (A Collett) – Began awkwardly making heavy contact with the starting gate.

LATER ON (S MacNab) – Slow away.

ALL THE TALK (T Allan) - Raced ungenerously for a short distance passing the 1200 metres.

MOLIZLAD (C Johnson) – Raced three wide on the pace in the early stages. Lost the near side front plate during the running.

RELIABLY PERKY (S Collett) – Held up approaching the 350 metres gaining clear running near the 200 metres.

LEDGOWAN (J Fawcett) - Lay in under pressure in the home straight, racing in restricted room approaching the 100 metres.

VELOCE (D Bradley) – Three wide without cover throughout. Held up for a short distance prior to and early in the home straight. D Bradley advised the mare had little left after racing wide throughout.

Race 6	POWER FARMING MAIDEN (1550 metres)

OCEAN RULER (J Fawcett) – Jumped inwards at the start tightening KIWEKA which settled back. Over-raced in the back straight. Held up for a short distance entering the home straight having to be angled inwards to improve.

HYPATIA (S Collett) – Finished well back. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the filly had never travelled comfortably and may prefer easing of the track.

TOBY'S CHOICE (C-M Waddell) – Raced keenly and steadied near the 1000 metres, had to be straightened near the 150 metres.

REALM (D Bradley) – Steadied near 1000 metres.

BELLA NERO (C Johnson) – Steadied near 1000 metres.

WINEHOUSE (R Myers) – Steadied near 1000 metres.

KIWEKA (M Tanaka) – Steadied near 1000 metres.

OFF WITH HER HEAD (A Shin) – Steadied near 1000 metres.

DEEP BLUE (H Andrew) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

FOXY POROTENE (J Parkes) – Had to be restrained off heels near the 1000 metres when over-racing.

T Johnson (WORD SAVVY) was shown footage of his ride after steadying the pace passing the 1000 metres resulting in the following runners having to steady, FOXY POROTENE (J Parkes), OCEAN RULER (J Fawcett), REALM, BELLA NERO, TOBY'S CHOICE, WINEHOUSE, KIWEKA and OFF WITH HER HEAD. When assessing the incident, stewards took into account evidence from J Parkes who advised that his mount was wearing a cheek burr for the first time resulting in his mount tending to race ungenerously. It was also established that OCEAN RULER, which was racing in behind FOXY POROTENE, was over-racing prior to the pace slowing, nevertheless T Johnson was advised that he is expected to exercise greater care when easing the tempo of a race in future.

Race 7	MERIDIAN ENERGY HANDICAP (1400 metres)

KING OF SMARTS (A Shin) – Was not persevered with in the final straight after rider A Shin considered something amiss with the gelding. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed mild swelling to the left-fore fetlock.

KATE THE GREAT (R Hannam) – Slow away. Made contact with the rail near the 800 metres, tightened having to be restrained when PLATINUM DIVA lay out rounding the home turn.

SHOWING GRACE (T Allan) - Tightened shortly after the start.

SMOKEN' ACE (H Andrew) – Ran up onto heels passing the 800 metres and when steadied shifted out dictating KING OF SMARTS, DONALDSON and JOHNNY LINCOLN wider on the track.

PLATINUM DIVA (A Collett) – Lay out rounding the home turn then continued to lay out under pressure in the home straight.

MIKJENE (S Collett) – Rider dropped whip passing the 200 metres.

VEUVE CLICQUOT (J Fawcett) - Raced keenly in front in the early and middle stages.

NICOSHINE (Z Moki) – Got its head up when over-racing near the 1800 metres.

Z Moki (NICOSHINE) – Was issued with a warning regarding her use of the whip on a horse out of contention.

TERRACOTTA WARRIOR (T Johnson) - Steadied getting its head in the air passing the winning post on the first occasion.

POROTENE MAGNUM (C Dell) - Raced three wide without cover in the early stages.

ALLMOSTA (R Myers) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.
