SWEET CHASTITY (K Williams) – Began awkwardly.

FAIRLIGHT (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly, raced three wide without cover.

FLYTIME (K Mudhoo) – Lay out rounding the final turn and early in the straight.

RAWMATERIAL (J Laking) – Rider reported that the gelding had been most disappointing. A post race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate.

Race 5 SPEIGHT'S MAIDEN (1600m)

HARD BUT FAIR (BB Hong) – Slow to begin (4L). Trainer **D Crozier** was advised that a warning would be placed against the mare for its barrier manners.

BAL HARBOUR (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly and over raced in the early stages. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils, undergoing a veterinary inspection including an endoscopic examination and confirmed as a bleeder. Accordingly stood down from racing and training for the mandatory 3 months, with the connections advised that a veterinary clearance will then be required prior to racing next.

CINTO BAY (C Barnes) – Jumped away awkwardly.

ANCIENT (R Cuneen) – Hampered at the start when CHORISTER stepped inwards

JIN LU (J Lowry) – Raced wide in the early stages, steadied at the 100 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of BAL HARBOUR (T Moseley) which shifted outwards.

T Moseley (BAL HARBOUR) was issued with a warning for shifting ground at the 100 metres when insufficiently clear.

TATUM (S Collett) – Raced wide throughout.

CASTLE HILL (J Laking) Raced greenly shortly after the start when steadied shifting outwards .

Race 6 SONIA & GARRY THOMPSON RATING 75 (2000m)

HIGH IN DEMAND (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin, over raced when being restrained in the early stages.

HOT FUSS (C Barnes) – Buffeted between WHAT A DEEZA and PRODUCER leaving the barriers, raced three wide without cover.

LADY BEALEY (S Collett) – Jumped away awkwardly then having to be steadied when crowded.

SHARP ELLE (T Moseley) – Got its head up and raced keenly in the early stages, steadied when in restricted room and shifted wider by TRAVEL WISE (S Wynne) passing the 700 metres, steadied passing the 600 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of the tiring WHAT A DEEZA,

S Wynne (TRAVEL WISE) was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

PRODUCER (T Comignaghi) – Trainer P Rudkin reported that a more positive ride had been beneficial to the gelding and that the addition of blinkers had also helped.

Race 7 NZB SOUTH ISLAND SALE APRIL 20 RATING 65 (2000m)

OPIHI JADE (S Weatherley) – Jumped away awkwardly, shifted ground outwards passing the 300 metres and had to be straightened near the 200 metres when attempting to find clear running.

VIVIDREDSKY (K Gundowry) – Restrained to the rear on jumping.

MAJOR ISH CHOUX (S Wynne) – Raced wide in the early stages, shifted inwards near the 1400 metres.

ANYTHINGCOULDHAPPN (S Collett) – Raced keenly passing the 1600 metres and heavily restrained when awkwardly placed on the heels of MAJOR ISH CHOUX which shifted inwards near the 1400 metres, lay out throughout.

S Wynne (Major Ish Choux) - warned for shifting ground 1400 metres.

STONEMASON (T Moseley) – Had to steady near the 1200 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of MAJOR ISH CHOUX, placed in restricted room passing the 250 metres and held up for a short distance on the heels of the tiring ANYTHINGCOULDHAPPN.

SOUTHERN DANCER (G Jogoo) – Raced in restricted room for some distance passing the 250 metres only gaining clear running near the 175 metres.

J Lowry (PICKUP) admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 8 days effective 12 March to23 March inclusive.

Race 8 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE RATING 65 (1400m)

BRAVO SUPREMO was a late scratching at 5.00 pm when rider K Gundowry was stood down after being found to be unwell and no suitable replacement rider was available.

MADAM SWISS (A Collett) – Slow to begin.

DARK POPPY (S Wynne) – Over raced in the early stages, shifted outwards when awkwardly placed on the heels of WHY ME near the 200 metres causing ACRYLIC to steady. Rider dropped her whip near the 75 metres. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in one nostril, undergoing a veterinary inspection which revealed a laceration to the right nostril.

S Wynne (DARK POPPY) was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

KHORABELLA (R Cuneen) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages having to be heavily restrained off heels passing the 800 metres, steadied momentarily passing the 150 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of LAY OFF (T Comignaghi) which shifted inwards.

T Comignaghi (LAY OFF) was warned for shifting ground when insufficiently clear.

WHY ME (BB Hong) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

ACRYLIC (T Moseley) – Raced four wide without cover throughout.

LONGFORD (J Lowry) – Held up for a short distance on entering the home straight.

BB Hong (WHY ME) admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 6 days effective 12 March to 21 March inclusive.

S Weatherley (DON'T BE CHEEKY) was reminded of his obligations for whip use prior to the 100 metres.
