Race 1	D R (JACK) GRAY PAINTERS MDN 1200M

BOY SOLDIER (R Hannam) – Slow away.

TWO EYE (A Jones) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

BLACK ANASTA (C Dell) – Slow away. Tightened having to be restrained approaching the 100 metres when attempting a marginal run.

FIFTYSHADESOFPINK (L Hemi) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

CRAFTY CRIM (D Hirini) – Dictated outwards approaching the home straight.

HABIT MY WAY (J Nason) – Hung out rounding the turn and commenced to give ground near the straight entrance. Checked when QUAFF (J Fawcett) shifted out dictating CRAFTY CRIM (D Hirini) into its line. When questioned J Fawcett advised that her mount hung outwards rounding the turn and shifted out more than anticipated, nevertheless J Fawcett was advised to exercise greater care. Also affected in the movement was BLACK ANASTA. J Nason reported HABIT MY WAY to be making abnormal breathing noises. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed a respiratory issue which will require attention.

Race 2 ELTHAM VET SERVICES MDN

TWILIGHT JEWELL (L Hemi) – Slow away.

ACANTABELLE (M McNelis) – Slow away.

JUST GEORGIE (C O'Beirne) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

SWIFT SAOIRSE (D Bradley) – Raced three wide in the early stages.

TRIFLE (A Collett) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Held up early in the home straight having to be angled across heels to gain clear running inside the final 200 metres.

Race 3 TRANSAG 3YO NDN

STARBRO (L Hemi) – Was late scratched after becoming fractious leaving the enclosure and dislodging rider L Hemi. Connections were advised that STARBRO must trial prior to racing next.

LEDGOWAN (D Bradley) – Reared dislodging rider. Both horse and rider were cleared behind the gates to start.

PLATINUM WILDCARD (A Collett) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Restrained off the heels of LALA LAND (M Vance) when the pace eased near the 1100 metres and when doing so shifted outwards inconveniencing IN SEGRETO.

Rider M Vance was spoken to regarding the manner in which she eased the pace.

TOUT SUR MOI (S McKay) – Awkwardly away settled back then raced keenly in the early stages.

IN SEGRETO (H Andrew) – Inconvenienced at the start then raced three wide throughout.

MISS SCANDINAVIA (S Rusof) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

LALA LAND (M Vance) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

Race 4 GRAINCORP 1400

ENGLISH LADY (R Hannam) – Slow away.

GET LUCKY (CM Wadell) – Raced three wide without cover.

SMOKEN HOT (T Johnson) – Got its head in the air when racing ungenerously.

HOW'S THAT GIRL (S Collett) – Held up for a short distance early in the home straight.

S Rusof (REMINGTON) – Warned under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that over the final stages his whip action exceeded shoulder height.

Race 5 RICH HILL STUD 2100

OCEAN BOUND (J Nason) – Knuckled at the start. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MORRELLMAC (D Bradley) – Slow away. Held up approaching the 500 metres having to be restrained off heels entering the home straight then angled back to the inside to gain clear running near the 200 metres.

POROTENE MAGNUM (C Dell) – Bumped with LISTOWEL shortly after the start. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

HAND IT TO JONESY (S Collett) – Raced very wide rounding the first turn before being allowed to improve to sit outside the leader near the 1400 metres.

OFF WITH HER HEAD (J Fawcett) – Held up for a short distance entering the home straight.

CHALLENGE (A Collett) – Bumped and forced outward when POROTENE MAGNUM shifted out in search of a run prior to entering the home straight. C Dell the rider of POROTENE MAGUM was shown footage of his ride and issued with a warning. Bumped with PERCY'S GEM near the finish when both runners shifted ground.

ALARMIST (J Parkes) – Was not persevered with in the home straight when out of contention. When questioned J Parkes advised the mare felt jarred up in front which was confirmed by a veterinary inspection.

Race 6 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES 1600M

PHYLLTHEPOWER (J Parkes) – Slow away. Was not persevered with over the final stages. When questioned J Parkes advised the filly had never travelled comfortably and appeared reluctant to gallop amongst other runners. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

DUELLICIOUS (S McKay) – Awkwardly away settling back.

COG KNISH (I Hemi) – Raced three wide throughout.

Race 7 PLACEMAKERS MDN

OUR JOCKO – Slow away.

UNDER THE BRIDGE (A Collett) – Slow away.

HEART OF FAME (A Jones) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

TINY TOT (S MacNab) – Restrained off heels near the 1100 metres. Briefly held up passing the 400 metres.

S Collett – Had no excuse for the disappointing run of AFTER FIVE.

Race 8 TREE AWARENESS 1600

KING'S VEE (T Johnson) – Underwent a pre race veterinary inspection at the start after the rider considered there may be something amiss with its action and was cleared to start.

BATTLE KAT (A Collett) – Raced three wide throughout.

SCUSA (R Hannam) – Held up for a short distance near the 500 metres.

THE COSSACK (H Andrew) Rider reported the gelding was unable to quicken when required and may prefer a longer distance

HANDSOME RETURN (C Dell) – Held up passing the 400 metres having to be angled wide across heels entering the home straight to improve.
