RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	
HOOPLA – Late scratched at 10.08am on veterinary advice.	
ISKANDER – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after Stewards being advised that the gelding had struck its head in the float and was cleared to race.	
DUKE STREET (J Nason) - Very slow to begin, raced ungenerously in the early stages.	

KING OF THE DANCE (J Bayliss) – Began awkwardly losing ground, dipped near the 100 metres when under pressure and then was not preserved with for the remainder of the race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

EVA LUNA (M McNab) – Raced in restricted room passing the 1800 metres to the inside of AIGNE which lay in also contributing was outward movement by ISKANDER, placed under pressure near the 800 metres and failed to respond, and was not persevered with, with rider unable to offer any excuses. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Stable representative stated that they would be looking to apply blinkers for the mare's next start and Stewards advised that a warning would be placed against the mare and that it must be more competitive in the future.

T K Allan – Issued with a warning for his whip use on AIGNE prior to the 100 metres.

Race 2

KATIE PERRIE (S Collett) – Slow to begin, shifted out into a marginal run near the 400 metres making contact with the hind quarters of I'M MURPHY, with both those runners coming together for a distance when racing in restricted room when GOLDCHI lay out and DIVINE ELITE shifted in, raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight. S Collett was dislodged shortly after the winning post after a gear failure (stirrup leather). S Collett was un-injured.

VERSES (J Nason) – Slow to begin, steadied when in restricted room to the inside of SOLDIER FIELD which improved into a tight run to the inside of WELLETSDOIT which shifted in slightly passing the 1200 metres, shifted in under pressure passing the 100 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of KATIE PERRIE which shifted out after being corrected by its rider with VERSES then being checked. Following the race the connections of the 5th placed horse VERSES were shown Stewards footage, electing not to proceed with the protest against the 4th place horse KATIE PERRIE.

HOOF HEFNER (M Hills) - Began awkwardly.

WELLETSDOIT (J Waddell) – Got its head up and raced ungenerously for a short distance when being steadied passing the 1300 metres.

SHOTGUN WILLIE (T Thornton) – Commenced to over race for a distance passing the 1200 metres.

WISHFUL (T Yanagida) - Raced wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

Race 3

RUSALKA (C Lammas) - Declared a late scratching at 2.18pm after refusing to enter the barrier stall. Trainer M Murdoch advised the Stewards that RUSALKA will now be sent for a spell and was further advised by the Stewards that the mare will be required to barrier trial to the satisfactions of the Stewards prior to racing again.

PEARLECA (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SECRETARIA (J Waddell) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

JEZIBABA (A Collett) – Slow to begin, could not be fully ridden out in the final straight due to the mare hanging outwards.

LA MIA STELLA (T Thornton) - Raced ungenerously for a distance when crossing over on the course proper near the 1400 metres.

When questioned into the performance of LUCETTA rider M Cameron was unable to offer any reason for the filly's performance.

Race 4

SHERRIF (L Innes) - Began awkwardly.

MATAURI (D Johnson) - Restrained leaving the barriers.

GO GO GOAL (T Thornton) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

ROCK ON WOOD (R Elliot) - Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 100 metres making brief contact with KONSTANTINA.

KONSTANTINA (M Cameron) - Inconvenienced passing the 100 metres.

Race 5

WONDER WOMAN (J Grob) - Began awkwardly.

NOTHINGLEFTTOLOSE (S Collett) - Slow to begin, steadied passing the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.

PAPPA RAGAZZO (M McNab) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied from near the 800 metres shifting back onto SUGGESTIVE HEIGHTS which had to be restrained.

CINEMATIC (A Collett) - Shifted in passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running and was then inclined to lay out when placed under pressure for the remainder of the race.

Race 6

POKER FACE (G Saejorhor) – Began awkwardly losing ground, became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1100 metres and steadied, held up passing the 300 metres and did not find clear running until shifting out near the 150 metres.

BLACKJACK MAN (M Cameron) - Raced wide without cover.

DON'T THINK TWICE (D Johnson) – Was unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the straight.

INDIAN MAID (L Satherley) - Had difficulty finding clear running early in the final straight.

I'MA SHYGIRL (T Thornton) – Held up for a distance passing the 300 metres.

CHADSDALE (O Bosson) - Lay in under pressure in the final straight.

ALVINS DREAM (L Innes) - Lay in under pressure having to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 300 metres.

Race 7

SERENITY (M Cameron) - slow away.

PERROQUET (M McNab) – Began awkwardly before being further hampered when crowded.

PRINCESS SAPPHIRE (S Collett) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with PERROQUET losing ground, made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.

TIA CELESTE (M Hills) – Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room near the 300 metres.

J Waddell was reminded of his obligations to ride his mount out to the finish of the race.

Race 8

PRINCE JABEEL (L Innes) - After being fractious in the barriers was removed and underwent a veterinary inspection and was passed fit to start, raced three wide without cover.

CEE SHARP (T Thornton) - Slow away.

EXECUTIVE POWER (J Waddell) - Raced wide without cover.

GRAND DUKE (M McNab) - Hung outwards rounding the bend.

MADURO (T Harris) - Held up entering the final straight and was unable to obtain clear running until shifting outwards across the heels of NOT USUAL TALENT near the 200 metres.

ANSWER BACK (M Vance) – Held up near the 250 metres having to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running.
